- The Budget allocation under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA has steadily risen. The budget allocation for the financial year 2006-07 was Rs 11,300 crore which increased to Rs 33,000 crore in 2013-14 and now stands at Rs 86,000 crore during FY 2024-25 at Budget estimate stage.
- Achievements on some important parameters under scheme is as under:

- The participation of women has increased steadily from 48% in FY 2013-14 to 58.19% during the FY 2024-25.
- Around 97.81% of fund transfer orders (FTOs) are being generated on time by the states/UTs ensuring timely wage payment.
- More than 86.98lakh assets have been created in FY 2024-25, reflecting the scheme's role in strengthening rural infrastructure.
- Approximately 44.14% of total expenditure has been incurred on Agri and allied activities which indicates focus on agriculture in the rural areas.
- Targeted interventions in Natural Resource Management (NRM) and agriculture-related activities have yielded a substantial reduction in water-stressed blocks. From FY 2017-18 to FY 2023-24, the number of such blocks has declined from 2,264 to 1,456. This reflects MGNREGS's success in transitioning from water scarcity to water security.
- As on date, about 97% of active workers have been linked with Aadhaar Payment Bridge system.
- All the assets being created under the scheme are geotagged. More than 6.26 crore assets have been geotagged till date.
- National Mobile Monitoring System (NMMS) App: To ensure more transparency in the implementation of Mahatma Gandhi NREGS in the States/UTs, a provision of capturing of attendance at worksite through National Mobile Monitoring System App (NMMS App) with two-time Geotagged photographs of the beneficiaries in a day had been started for all the worksites (except Individual Beneficiary Scheme/Project) and made these attendance in public domain which increases citizen oversight of the programme besides potentially enabling faster processing of payments.
- The regional trainings on Yuktdhara, a GIS-based planning portal developed by NRSC-ISRO are being carried out to facilitate holistic and scientific planning of Mahatma Gandhi NREGS activities at the Gram Panchayat (GP) level.

- The Ministry initiated many good governance initiatives like Job Card verification/ updation, adoption of 7 Registers in place 22 registers, emphasis on Social Audit and Internal Audit, proactive inclusion of landless households dependent on manual casual labour for livelihood, Citizen Information Board.
- Convergence initiatives under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA with 13 Ministries which also includes Construction of Anganwadi Centres, construction of Gram panchayat building and providing all-weather road connectivity to border areas in convergence with BRO etc.
- Mission Amrit Sarovar: Under the mission, the construction and rejuvenation of over 68,000 Amrit Sarovars has been completed. The mission is to be continued for construction and rejuvenation of water bodies as AmritSarovar.
