Impact expected and action suggested due to Thunderstorm, lightning, gusty winds & hailstorm over Telangana, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Maharashtra on 14th; over Punjab and Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi on 16th; over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad on 15th & 16th; over Himachal Pradesh on 16th and over Uttarakhand and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 16th & 17th April, 2021.

Impact expected:

- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

Action suggested:

- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- Farming operations may be suspended during the event.

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
