
Current Temperature Status and Warning for next five days


Yesterday's Maximum Temperature Scenario:

Maximum Temperature: - Maximum Temperatures more than 40.0°C were recorded at most places over West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat Region, Marathwada and Vidarbha; at a few places over Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and Saurashtra & Kutch and at isolated places over East Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya


Yesterday, the highest maximum temperature of 43.4°C was reported at Jhansi (West Uttar Pradesh) and Akola (Vidarbha).





Warm Night:- Nil. Minimum Temperature:-

Minimum temperatures are **above normal (1.6°C to 3.0°C)** at **most places** over Gujarat Region; at **many places** over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, at **a few places** over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad,, Himachal Pradesh and Odisha; at **isolated places** over East Madhya Pradesh, Saurashtra & Kutch, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Kerala & Mahe and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.
