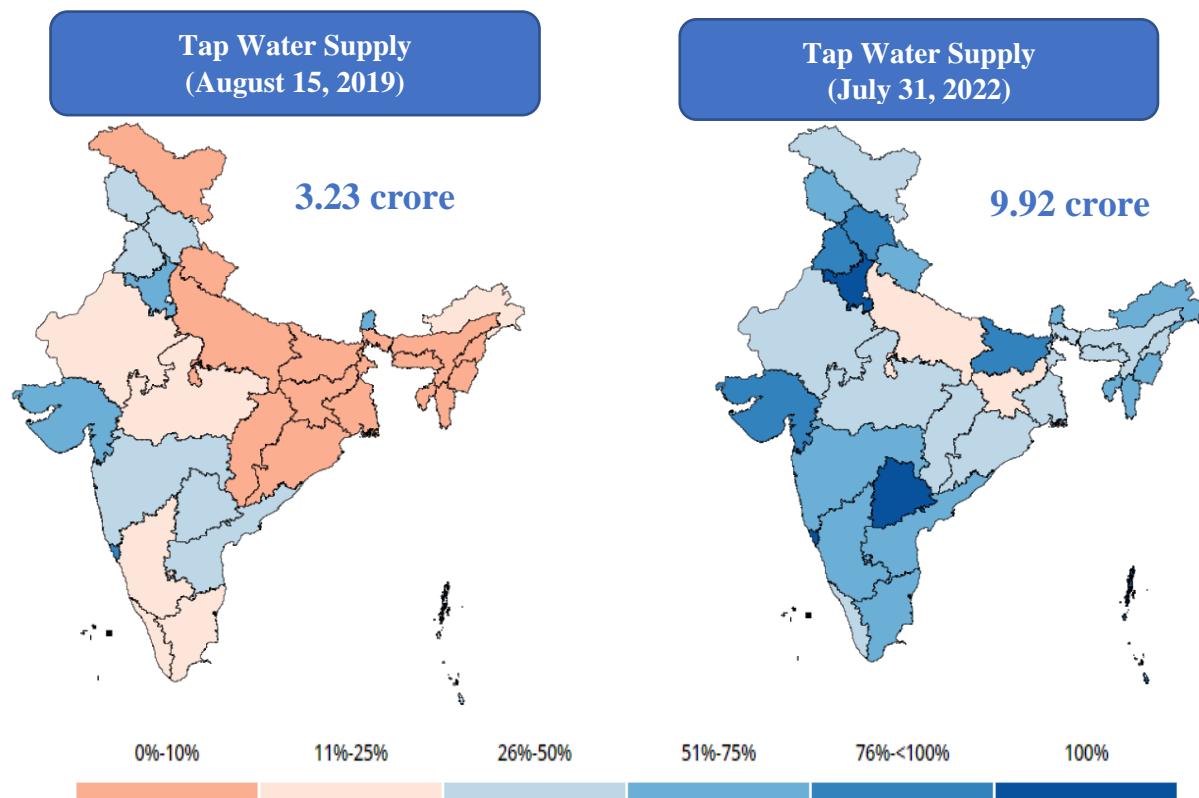

Introduction

Jal Jeevan Mission: Har Ghar Jal was announced by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on August 15, 2019, with an aim to ensure piped water supply to every rural home by 2024.

Jal Jeevan Mission is a decentralized, demand-driven community-managed water supply programme that seeks to empower the local village community, which means the **local village community is to play a central role in the planning, implementation, management, operation and maintenance** of their own in-village water supply system.



Jal Jeevan Mission: Achievements (as of July 31, 2022)

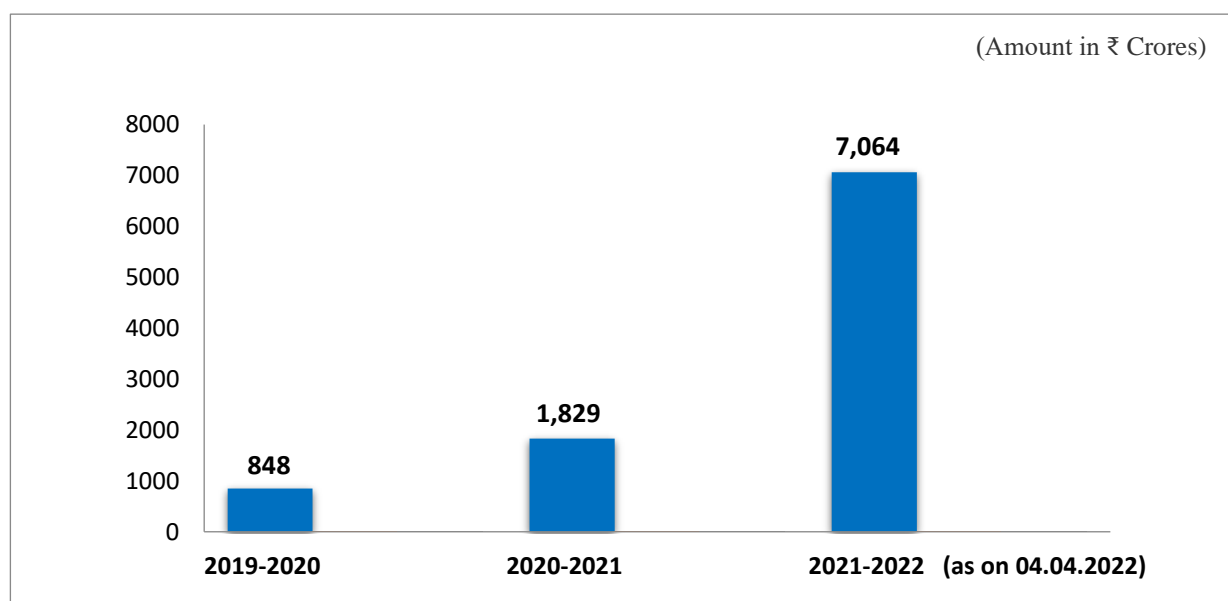
Following the Prime Minister's vision of 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas and Sabka Prayas', in a short span of 35 months, the following are the major accomplishments Jal Jeevan Mission:

- **Over 6.68 crore** rural households in the country have been provided with tap water connection since the launch of the Mission.
- **111 districts, 1,266 blocks, 74,966 Gram Panchayats and 1,56,915 villages** have become 'Har Ghar Jal'.
- **8.66 lakh schools (84%) and 8.95 lakh (80%) Anganwadi centres** across the country have been provided with potable tap water supply for drinking & cooking mid-day meals, hand-washing, and use in toilets.
- **1.52 crore households (47%)** in Aspirational Districts and **1.35 crore households (47%)** in JE-AES affected regions are getting access to clean tap water.
- **Three States – Goa, Telangana and Haryana and three UTs – A&N Islands, D&N Haveli & Daman & Diu and Puducherry** have provided 100% tap water coverage to its people.

Jal Jeevan Mission: Progress in Maharashtra

Maharashtra is one of the leading states in the country in implementing the Jal Jeevan Mission. Maharashtra has 1.45 crore rural households, out of which more than **1.02 crores (71%)** are now getting tap water supply.

Budgetary allocation for Maharashtra under Jal Jeevan Mission

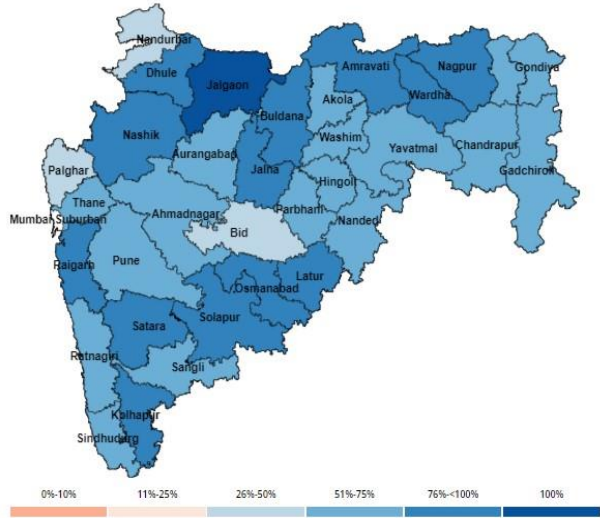
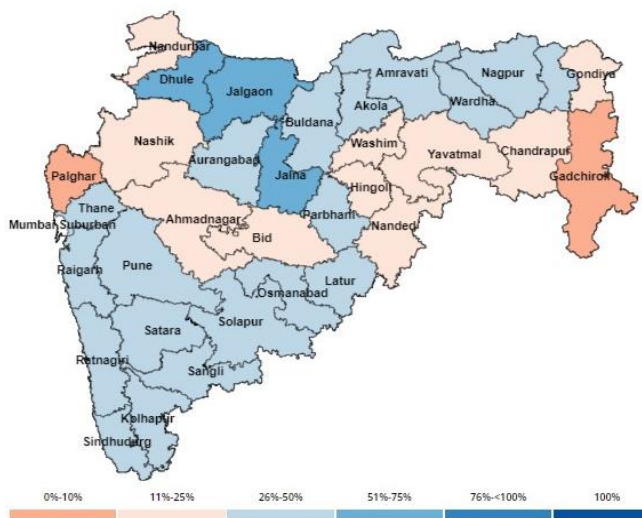

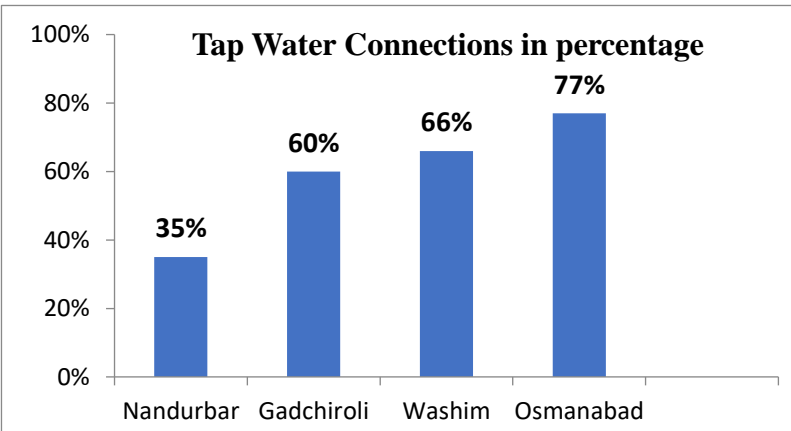
Achievements (as on July 31, 2022)

- **54.23 lakh (37.42%) rural households** in Maharashtra have been provided with tap water connection since the launch of the mission.
- **One district, 21 blocks 8,246 Gram Panchayats and 13,032 villages** has become 'Har Ghar Jal'.
- Under Jal Jeevan Mission Aspirational districts - Nandurbar, Gadchiroli, Washim, Osmanabad, have been given priority in Maharashtra.
