Background: Sathiyan Gnanasekaran was born into a middle-class family of elite academicians. His parents couldn't afford to pay his school fees till 3rd standard, however, he managed to complete his school education. He hails from Chennai and started playing Table tennis as a hobby. Sathiyan's talent was spotted by former Indian paddler Subramanian Raman, who tempted him to pursue the sport seriously. In May 2019, Sathiyan attained his career best World ranking of 24 and became the first Indian paddler ever to break into the World Top-25 ITTF rankings. Sathiyan holds a degree in Information Technology from the St Joseph College of Engineering, Chennai. He became national champion for the first time in 2021 beating ten-time champion Sharath Kamal. He received the Arjuna Award in 2018.

Achievements:

- Won Gold in Men's team, Silver in Men's Doubles and Bronze in the Mixed Doubles at the Commonwealth Games 2018.
- Won the Bronze Medal in the Men's team event at the Asian Games 2018.
- Won the Mixed Doubles event at WTT Contender Budapest 2021.
- Bagged two golds and two silvers at the South Asian Games 2016.
