- The International Film Festival of India (IFFI) aims to provide a common platform for filmmakers from around the world to showcase their talent and showcase the best of cinema from around the world. As the country commemorates the 75th anniversary of its hard-won independence with *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav* flags swaying in every state, 75 film poster designs from across the country have been chosen to be displayed at the 53rd International Film Festival of India 2022 for the audiences in a unique exhibition of the legendary Satyajit Ray.
- The Jury, comprised of renowned artists from the fields of art, cinema, and painting, selected the 75 best film posters from a total of 635 submissions. The entire process, including the Jury's evaluation, was conducted online. The top three winners will receive cash prizes, as well as a souvenir created from the winning film poster designs, which will be presented to dignitaries during the 53rd IFFI. - 1. The International Film Festival of India (IFFI) has always lived up to its legacy of embracing global culture, evident from its international programming and keeping with this spirit the 53<sup>rd</sup> edition of the Festival will play host to a diverse group of international media.
- 2. IFFI and its business vertical Film Bazaar showcase to the international media India's growth story in the audio-visual sector and the Government's efforts at promoting India as a global content hub.
- 3. It is also an opportunity for the world media to see India's cinematic and cultural diversity and how India is welcoming to filmmakers from across the world.

### **Partnership with Variety International**

- 1. NFDC has entered into a partnership with respected Hollywood trade publication Variety for production of E-Dailies during the festival.
- 2. Variety will be producing exclusive E-show dailies on November 21, 23, 25, 27 and 28, 2022 and handle digital distribution of the dailies.
- 3. Variety will share the IFFI news on their website and their official Twitter id. The E-dailies would be sent to 4,30,000 Variety subscribers along with all registered delegates of IFFI and Film Bazaar. The Variety Twitter Handle has 2.8 million followers.

### **International Trade Journalists**

In addition to Variety, the 53<sup>rd</sup> edition of IFFI shall also have the presence of senior trade journalists from reputed international trade publications namely Screen Daily and Deadline.

## Film Bazaar in its 16th Edition in 2022

*Market side of the film festival* Film Bazaar is focused on discovering, supporting and showcasing South Asian content and talent in the realm of filmmaking, production and distribution.

#### **Books to Box-office**

This new Book Adaptation Program has been introduced as an initiative to bridge the gap between good stories printed in books and good films that can be made by adapting books. The response is overwhelmingly positive with 30 Publishing houses / literary Agencies / Authors as confirmed participants.

#### **Co-Production Market**

The Co-Production Market is a platform for curated projects from south Asian countries with South Asian themes to find financial and artistic support. These projects are seeking co-productions. The co-production market this year selection includes 20 projects from 11 countries in 11 languages. The selected projects will have one-on-one meetings with producers, distributors, sales agents, and festival programmers.

### **Viewing Room**

The Viewing Room (VR) is a video library platform to showcase films seeking finishing funds, world sales, potential distribution partners and looking to travel to film festivals. Viewing Room received a record number of 248 film submissions from across the regions. From all these entries, 104 are Debut features. Film Bazaar will be presenting these debut filmmakers for the very first time in the Viewing Room. There are 33 spoken languages in the films that are being presented. Some of the rare languages showcased in the film in Viewing Room this year are Kodava, Kullvi, Tangkhul, Santhali, Bodo and Chittagonian

### Work-In-Progress Lab

Work-in-progress Lab - The Work-in-progress Lab (WIP) gives selected filmmakers a chance to screen the rough cut of their film to an eminent panel of International Advisors, which include a film festival director, producers, world sales agent and an editor. From the 54 entries received, 5 films have been selected and these projects will receive comprehensive one-on-one feedback on their films.

### **Market Screenings**

Films looking for distribution and sales exhibit their finished films for the Market delegates and special invites by the producer of the film. A total of 50 slots are booked by film entries from India, US, UK and Russia for Market Screenings in 3 theatres. The films being screened would cover a mix of Feature Length Films, Short Films, Documentary Films and Animation Films.
