Online Application for Renewal of PIB Accreditation Cards for 2023

All accredited journalists having valid PIB accreditation card-2022 and wishing to renew the same for the year-2023 are requested to fill the online form for Renewal of Accreditation for the year 2023. The applicant should log on to the online system (accreditation.pib.gov.in) with the existing user ID and password to submit the application.

The following requirements of the system may please be noted: -

- 1. Accreditation is limited to residents of Delhi and its vicinity (Noida, Greater Noida, Faridabad, Bahadurgarh, Ghaziabad and Gurugram).
- 2. Online submission of renewal application will be open from **10.10.2022 to 15.11.2022.**
- 3. The essential documents have to be uploaded **online only** while submitting the application. Any wrong/irrelevant documents uploaded along with the application may cause the delay in processing or even rejection of the application form. Any request to consider the alternate documents instead of essential documents will not be entertained at any stage.
- 4. Editor's recommendation letter in original has to be submitted in Room No. 12 A, Ground floor, National Media Centre at the time of collecting PIB card.
- 5. Please keep username and password in safe custody. In case of misuse of your account inform PIB immediately.
- 6. All correspondence relating to accreditation will be sent to you on the email given by you in the online application form.
- 7. In case of any difficulty during the filling up of the e-form, kindly call at 23488123, between 11 AM to 1 PM & 2.00 PM to 4.00 PM on working days. You may also send any queries through e-mail at pre-pib@nic.in.
- 8. PIB has the right to ask for supporting or any other documents in physical/online form at any stage, if found necessary. The decision of Pr. DG, PIB in this regard shall be final.
