Introduction

The <u>Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana</u> - <u>National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM)</u> aims at mobilizing about 9-10 crore rural poor households into Self Help Groups (SHGs) in a phased manner and provide them long-term support such that they diversify their livelihoods, improve their incomes and quality of life. DAY-NRLM has been supporting women-led and managed enterprises in farm and non-farm sectors. 3



Progress of DAY-NRLM



DAY-NRLM is being implemented in all the States and Union Territories, except Delhi and Chandigarh. As on June 30, 2022, about 8.39 crore rural poor women have been mobilized into more than 76.94 lakh SHGs⁴.

The Mission is also working on the social development front among the rural poor, creating greater awareness on issues like nutrition, health, sanitation and gender etc. It is also facilitating their access to entitlements available to them under various Government programmes/schemes.


More Initiatives for the Benefits of SHGs under DAY-NRLM

- DAY-NRLM organized "UdyamitaPakhwara" across the Country from July 01 to 15, 2022⁵. The objective of UdyamitaPakhwara was to highlight the importance of enterprise growth and entrepreneurship development under non-farm livelihoods in rural areas across the country.
- DAY-NRLM organised a National Discourse on Food, Nutrition, Health and WASH
 (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) on March 29, 2022⁶. The subject of the discourse was
 'Leveraging DAY-NRLM's Women Collectives for strengthening Health Seeking
 Behaviour among SHG households for improved health outcomes'.
- DAY-NRLM and the World Bank organized a virtual learning event on **February 24**, 2022⁷ on how to integrate ultra-poor women into the Mission's programmes.
- DAY-NRLM also observed 'Agri Nutri Garden Week' from January 10 to 17, 2022⁸ through an awareness campaign aimed at encouraging the establishment of 'Agri Nutri Gardens' in rural households.

A women's Self-Help Group, coming together on the basis of mutual affinity, is the primary building block of the DAY-NRLM community institutional design. These SHGs are required to practice <u>'Panchasutras'</u> i.e. regular meetings; regular savings; regular inter-loaning; timely repayment; and up-to-date books of accounts, in order to avail loans.

Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana in Himachal Pradesh

Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) is being implemented across <u>Himachal Pradesh in 86 blocks</u>¹⁰. A statement showing <u>year-wise funds allocated under the mission in Himachal Pradesh</u> during the last three years and the current year (as of 30.06.2022) is given below.

<u>Incentives Being Provided to the Women SHGs in Himachal Pradesh under</u> DAY-NRLM

Interest Subvention

All DAY-NRLM women SHGs are eligible for interest subvention on credit up to Rs. 3.00 lakhs at seven per cent per annum. For the implementation of this scheme, districts have been segregated as follows:

Category 1 Districts:

Kangra, Mandi, Shimla and Una (under Government of India)

Category 2 Districts:

Bilaspur, Chamba, Hamirpur, Kinnaur, Kullu, Lahaul & Spiti, Sirmaur and Solan (under State Government i.e HPSRLM).



Financial aid through Revolving Fund and Community Investment Fund

Under NRLM, SHGs and Higher-level Federations (village organizations and cluster/block level federations) of poor women have been formed. On performance basis, three months after the formation, SHGs are provided with Revolving Fund (RF) amounting to Rs. 15,000 if the group regularly holds meetings, keeps records of savings, inter-person loans and repayments.

HPSRLM has disbursed RF amounting to Rs. 32.10 crores to more than 17,939 SHGs in the state.



Start-Up funds

All SHGs are provided Rs. 2500 and Voluntary Organisations (VOs) are provided Rs. 45,000 on Start-Up fund instantly after formation. HPSRLM has started disbursing Start-Up Funds from 2018-19 and as of December 2021, Rs. 4.40 crores has been disbursed to 17,784 SHGs and 2.40 crores to 532 VOs.

Revolving Fund (RF)

Revolving Fund of Rs. 10,000–15,000 would be provided to those SHGs who have been practising Punchsutra for the last three months and <u>as of December 2021, Rs. 32.10 crores</u> has been disbursed to 17,939 SHGs.

Community Investment Fund (CIF)

A Community Investment Fund of Rs. 50,000 would be provided to each SHG that has adopted regular internal lending of savings and revolving funds to the members by way of small loans for the last six months. These funds will be routed through the VOs to the SHGs in the shape of loans. 458 VOs, who are performing well, are covered under this scheme and are given additional funds amounting to Rs. 12.28 crores as CIF from NRLM.

Him Ira SHG Shops

To provide a sustainable livelihood opportunity to the SHG members and market linkage to the product produced by Self-Help Groups, Himachal Pradesh opened the Him Ira SHG Shops managed and operated by the women SHG member, in every Assembly Constituency. The Rural Development department has decided to open 100 Him Ira SHG shops in the State.

From April 2021 to November, 2021, the total sale recorded of 40 operational Him Ira SHG shops is Rs. 45.00 lakhs. In addition, the department is organizing Him Ira weekly markets in 58 Development Blocks and total sale recorded amounted to Rs. 44.18 lakhs from April to November 2021.
