Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Ensuring Housing in Himachal Pradesh (State Series)

(Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs & Ministry of Rural Development)

<u>India is home to nearly 1.3 billion people</u>¹. While those who have better resources can afford to have a decent living, others who are socially and economically backward were finding it difficult to do the same. Crores of people had been living under conditions beneath human dignity. For almost 70 years, there has only been a marginal improvement in the situation.

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana

With the rising population, the absolute number of families living in huts/shacks has continued to grow. To address this issue, the government launched the **Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana** –

Gramin and Urban to build and provide pucca houses to change the living conditions of poor people in both rural and urban areas.

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G) was launched on November 20, 2016² and Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) was launched on June 25, 2015.


PMAY-Gramin: Achievements³

Under PMAY-G, more than two <u>crore</u> houses have been completed⁴ as on August 03, 2022. Under PMAY-G, beneficiaries are provided financial assistance of Rs. 1.20 lakhs in plain areas and Rs. 1.30 lakhs in hilly States, difficult areas and Integrated Action Plan (IAP) districts.

Under PMAY-G, households are also provided water, LPG and electricity connections in convergence with other relevant schemes.


PMAY-Urban: Achievements⁵

Under PMAY-U. <u>62.79 lakh houses have</u> been completed⁶ as on September 19, 2022,



and central assistance of Rs 1.23 lakh crores has been released to the states. The ownership of the PMAY houses is in the name of a female member or is in joint ownership⁷.

All the houses constructed under PMAY-U have the facility of a toilet, a kitchen, electricity and water.




PM-Awas Yojana Achievements in Himachal Pradesh

The Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) aims to provide affordable housing to both the rural and urban poor in Himachal Pradesh. These houses contain all the basic facilities such as toilets, LPG cylinders, tap water connections, electricity connections, etc.

PMAY-Gramin


Under PMAY-G, 15,356 houses have been sanctioned in Himachal Pradesh and 10,706 houses have been completed⁸ as on September 28, 2022. Central assistance of Rs. 192.88 crores has been allocated for Himachal Pradesh out of which Rs. 183.04 crores has been utilized.






PMAY-Urban

Under PMAY-U, 13,266 houses have been sanctioned in Himachal Pradesh and 7,985 houses have been completed as on September 19, 2022. Central assistance of Rs. 240.92 crores has been allocated for Himachal Pradesh out of which Rs. 172.41 crores has been utilized.

Angikaar Campaign

As the Scheme moved ahead, there was a need to address life transformation issues that arise out of moving into a new house and neighbourhood. To address the same, Angikaar, a campaign for social change management was initiated by 'Housing for All' (HFA) Mission on August 29, 2019.

It has helped build the capacities of PMAY–U beneficiaries in Himachal Pradesh, among other states, in adapting to change though door-to-door awareness on best practices in water & energy conservation, health, hygiene, sanitation and financial literacy. Further, an enabled environment was created through convergence with various Urban Missions and schemes of



other Central Ministries. It is a unique initiative in the urban housing sector that embraced and brought into its fold welfare-oriented schemes of the State and Central Government.

Himachal Pradesh State Rural Housing Schemes

Swarn Jayanti Aashray Yojana⁹

The State Government is implementing various schemes for the welfare of the weaker sections of the society. The **Swarn Jayanti Aashray Yojana** is being implemented to help realize the dream of a home for poor families belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes. Under the Swarna Jayanti Aashray Yojana, a budget of Rs.51,34,50,000 had been allocated to the State for the year 2020-2021 and 3,419 houses had been constructed in the State during the said period.

Mukhaya Mantri Awaas Yojana (MMAY)¹⁰

The State Government had announced this scheme for all categories of persons Below Poverty Line (BPL). A planned budget provision of Rs. 20.93 crores was set aside for the year 2021-22 and 1,257 houses of all categories were proposed to be constructed in the State.
