
Jal Jeevan Mission: Making Clean Tap Water a Reality for Chhattisgarh Over 24.71 lakh rural households provided tap water connections under JJM 27.90 lakh rural households have tap water connections in Chhattisgarh

Jal Jeevan Mission is a flagship program launched in August 2019 that aims to provide all rural households with tap water supply in adequate quantity & of prescribed quality by 2024.

Before the launch of the Jal Jeevan Mission, **only 16.67%** (over 3.23 crore) of rural homes in India had access to tap water supply. However, over the last 4 years, despite the challenges posed by the Covid-19 pandemic and lockdown disruptions, the Government of India managed to make significant progress by providing tap water connections to **65.81%** (**12.77 Crore**) of households across the country (as of August 09, 2023).

Since the launch of the JJM scheme until March 9, 2023, a total expenditure of approx 1.42 lakh crore rupees has been made.¹


For the implementation of the mission in 2023-24, a Gross Budgetary Support (GBS) of Rs.70,000 Crore has been proposed, which is Rs.15,000 crore higher than the budgetary provision of Rs.55,000 crore for 2022-23.

Major Highlights of JJM in Chhattisgarh:

- Chhattisgarh has crossed 55% coverage under Jal Jeevan Mission.
- The state has around 50.12 lakh rural households, out of which around 27.90 lakh (55.68%) have tap water supply.
- In the year 2022-23, out of the total allocated Rs. 2223.98 crore of the central share, **Rs.** 2097.06 cr. was spent on JJM in Chhattisgarh.
- Chhattisgarh plans to provide around <u>29 lakh new tap water connections in FY 2023-24</u>.
- Since the launch of JJM, over 24 lakh rural households have been provided with tap water connections.
- **43,974 schools** (86.78%), **41,719 Anganwadi Centres** (83.39%), and **11,658 Gram Panchayats** in Chhattisgarh have tap water supply.
- Currently, there are **74 water testing laboratories** in Chhattisgarh where citizens can get their water samples tested at nominal rates.
