Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation: Progress in Telangana

5.53 lakh water tap connections and 88,000 sewer connections provided in Telangana
8.25 million litres per day Sewage Treatment Plant capacity developed in Telangana
84.52 acre of Green Space area developed in Telangana

The Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on June 25, 2015 in selected 500 cities and towns across the country. The Mission focuses on the development of basic infrastructure in the sectors of water supply, sewerage and septage management, storm water drainage, green spaces and parks, and non-motorized urban transport.

AMRUT 2.0 was launched on October 01 2021 to **make around** 4.700 towns/cities 'water secure'. It will build upon the progress of AMRUT to address water needs, rejuvenate water bodies, better manage aquifers, reuse treated wastewater, thereby promoting circular economy of water. The total outlay of AMRUT 2.0 is ₹2,97,000 crores, including central share of ₹76,760 crores. AMRUT 2.0 aims to provide 100% coverage of water supply to all households in around 4,700 ULBs, by providing 2.68 crore urban household tap connections and 2.64 crore sewer connections/septage connections.



AMRUT: Nationwide Progress

Financial Performance (as on July 2023)

- State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) amounting to ₹77,640 crore including committed
- Central Assistance of ₹35,990 crore have been approved for projects in all States/ Union Territories (UTs)
- Central Assistance amounting to Rs. 33,110.41 crore has been released to States/UTs.
- 4,972 projects worth ₹38,654 crore have been completed
- 916 projects worth ₹43,983 crore are in progress

Physical Progress (as on July 2023)

- 172 lakh water tap connections (new/ serviced) provided against target of 139 lakh
- 135 lakh sewer connections (new/ serviced) provided against target of 145 lakh
- 3,342 Million Litre Per Day (MLD) Sewerage Treatment Capacity (STP) developed
- 3,289 Million Litre Per Day (MLD) Water Treatment Capacity (WTP) developed
- 1,073.02 km length of drains constructed resulting in eliminating 3,319 numbers of water logging points
- Development of 4,556.38 acres of Green Space
- 419.85 km pedestrian/ walkway and 37.82 km of cycle track developed.

AMRUT: Progress in Telangana



Physical Progress (as on July 2023)

- 5.53 lakh water tap connections provided under AMRUT & convergence
- 88,000 sewer connections/ household septage coverage provided under AMRUT & convergence
- 18.25 Million Litres per Day (MLD) Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) capacity developed
- 84.52 acre of Green Space area developed.



Financial Performance (as on July 2023)

- Rs. 832.60 crore of Central Assistance (CA) have been allocated under AMRUT Mission.
- 66 projects worth Rs. 1,663 crore have been grounded, out of which 60 projects worth Rs. 1,543 crore have been completed.
- Completed projects include 26 Water Supply projects worth Rs. 1,310 crore, 4 Sewerage and Septage Management projects worth Rs. 203 crore and 30 green spaces & parks projects worth Rs. 30 crore.
- One Water Supply project worth Rs. 114 crore and 5 Green Spaces & Parks projects worth Rs. 6 crore are currently under progress.
