## Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) - Chhattisgarh

(Ministry of Health and Family Welfare)

Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY) is a pioneering initiative of Prime Minister Modi to ensure that the poor and vulnerable population is provided health coverage. This initiative is part of the Government's vision to ensure that its citizens – especially the poor and vulnerable groups have universal access to good quality hospital services without anyone having to face financial hardship as a consequence of using health services.

Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) was <u>launched on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2018</u>. The salient features of the scheme and its progress across the country in 33 States/UTs are as follows:

## Salient Features of AB-PMJAY

(1)	World's largest Government funded health insurance scheme targeting more than 50 crore beneficiaries.
	Health insurance of up to Rs.5 lakh per family per year for secondary and tertiary healthcare hospitalizations.
	A completely cashless and paperless scheme with benefits portable across the country.
	There is no cap on family size, or age or gender.
1444	The beneficiary families under the scheme have been identified from the Socio-Economic Caste Census (SECC) of 2011 across rural and urban areas.


Under the scheme, over 5.43 crore hospital admissions, amounting to Rs. 66830.34 crores, have also been authorized through a network of over 27,548 hospitals.

## Progress of Ayushman Bharat (AB-PMJAY) in Chhattisgarh

Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) has been a monumental effort by the central government to provide healthcare access to the underprivileged population in Chhattisgarh.

- ➤ Over 2 crore Ayushman cards were created to ensure access to quality medical services.
- ➤ Over **40.68 lakh hospital admissions** are authorized to cater to the state's vulnerable population. Out of these hospital admissions, **over 22 lakh admissions have been authorized for females.**
- The authorization of hospital admissions worth **Rs 4460 crore** ensures that financial constraints do not prevent citizens from availing of quality healthcare.
- ➤ The extensive network of **1574 empanelled healthcare providers**, including 553 private hospitals, reflects the government's comprehensive approach to involve both the public and private sectors.
- The Centre has released an amount of **Rs 1,168 crores** to Chhattisgarh from the date of the launch of the scheme.

AB-PMJAY has positively impacted the overall health and well-being of countless individuals and families in Chhattisgarh.
