Jal Jeevan Mission: Progress in Telangana

All Rural Households (53.98 lakh) have Tap Water Connections in Telangana
Over 38.29 lakh rural households (70%) provided with tap water connections since launch of JJM
100% households in three aspirational districts provided with tap water connection

Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) is a flagship program of the Government of India aimed at providing tap water connection to every rural household by 2024. It was announced by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on August 15, 2019. At the time of the launch of Mission, out of 19.41 crore rural households in India, only 3.23 Crore (16.65%) had access to tap water. In a short span of just four years, the country has crossed a major milestone in the journey towards 'Har Ghar Jal', with over 12.75 Crore (65.69%) rural households provided with tap water supply as on August 06, 2023). The overall financial commitment for Jal Jeevan Mission is INR 3600 billion (US \$ 43.80 billion), making it one of the largest welfare programmes in the world. Jal Jeevan Mission follows 'bottom up'




approach where community plays a vital role from planning to implementation, management, operation and maintenance.

JJM: Progress in Telangana


Jal Jeevan Mission has made remarkable strides in the state of Telangana where it has successfully achieved 100% coverage, i.e., all the rural households in Telangana (53.98 lakh) have tap water connections.

This achievement is particularly noteworthy when compared to the initial figures recorded on August 15, 2019, where only 15.68 lakh households (29.05%) had access to tap water connections. Since the launch of the mission, **over 38.29 lakh (70.95%) households** have been provided with tap water connections, ensuring the availability of water for the remaining households of the state.

The triumph of the Jal Jeevan Mission in Telangana underscores the effectiveness of this initiative spearheaded by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, showcasing his steadfast commitment to delivering water to the doorstep of every citizen.



Major highlights of JJM in Telangana:

- 22,832 schools (99%), 27,248 Anganwadi Centres (99%) and 13,281 Gram Panchayats/Community Health Centres (100%) in Telangana have tap water supply.
- Currently, there are **76 water testing laboratories** in Telangana where citizens can get their water samples tested at nominal rates.
- In addition, **7,330** out of 10,452 villages have formed **Paani Samitis/Village Water and Sanitation Committee (VWSC)**.
