Swachh Bharat Mission - Urban

“Swachh Bharat Mission” (Urban) was launched on 2nd October 2014 for a 5-year period with the objective of achieving 100% open defecation-free (ODF) status and putting in place systems to achieve 100% solid waste management in all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in the country.¹

After the success of the mission, Prime Minister launched Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban 2.0 on 1st October 2022 with the overall vision of creating ‘Garbage Free Cities’. The SBM-Urban 2.0 has introduced Used Water Management as a newly funded component for towns with less than 1 lakh population.² The progress made by the nation as on July 13, 2023, is as follows:

Swachh Bharat Mission – Urban: Progress in Madhya Pradesh

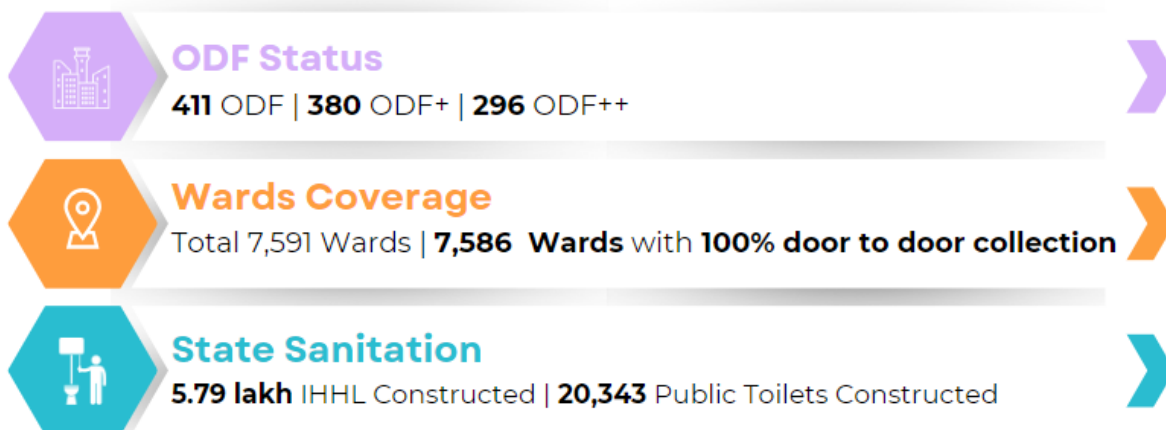
Madhya Pradesh has taken the key objectives and transformed **itself** into one of the leading states in best practices and a pioneer in Municipal Solid Waste and Faecal Sludge Management. **This drive to transform the state by introducing innovative techniques has made Madhya Pradesh one of the top-ranking states.** The mission has been effective in instilling clean habits into the people of Madhya Pradesh.³ Brief highlights of the progress

made by Madhya Pradesh under Swachh Bharat Mission – Urban is as follows (data as on July 12, 2023):^{4,5}



Prominent Achievements

- The state is among top 10 states list with one of the highest numbers of toilets constructed with
- **Madhya Pradesh** had emerged as the ‘**Cleanest State**’ in the “More than 100 Urban Local Bodies” category in Swachh Sarvekshan 2022.⁶
- In an impressive display of sustainability and good governance, Indore was tagged with the **Cleanest City** title for the **sixth consecutive year**, in the ‘more than 1 lakh population’ category in Swachh Survekshan 2022.
- **Under** Swachh Survekshan 2022 **Indore** further cemented its position by emerging as **India’s first 7-star Garbage Free City while Bhopal earned 5-star Garbage Free** certifications.
- **Hoshangabad (Madhya Pradesh)** emerged as the ‘**Fastest Mover City**’ (in the ‘more than 1 lakh population category’) with a jump of 274 ranks from **361st position in the 2020 rankings to 87th position in 2021, thus securing a place among the top 100 cities.**⁷

The development and achievements of Madhya Pradesh are a result of the Government’s commitment to **improving** the overall Used Water Management ecosystem in Urban India.
