India's G20 Presidency

2nd Trade and Investment Working Group Meeting (Bengaluru, Karnataka – May 23 - 25, 2023)

The 2nd Trade and Investment Working Group Meeting (TIWG) under India's G20 Presidency was organized in Bengaluru from May 23 - 25, 2023. During this three-day meeting, over 100 delegates from G20 member countries, invitee countries, regional groupings and international organizations deliberated on reforming the multilateral trading system, integrating MSMEs in global trade, resilient Global Value Chains (GVCs), making trade work for growth and prosperity, and efficient logistics for trade.

Day 1: May 23, 2023

The first day of the TIWG Meeting witnessed a seminar on Trade and Technology as a side event. The <u>seminar on 'Technology & Trade'</u> was inaugurated by Union Minister of State for Commerce and Industry, Shri Som Parkash. Delegates discussed how technology is reshaping trade. They also deliberated on the transformative tools that can revolutionise manufacturing & trade. The discussions deliberated on the disruptive role of technology in driving inclusive growth and resilient trade.



The delegates were also presented with an elaborate showcase of sustainably-grown coffee, tea and spices of India. The potential of innovations and products by Indian Startups was also displayed.



Day 2: May 24, 2023

Kicking off Day 2, Union Ministers of State, Smt. Anupriya S Patel and Shri Som Parkash shared their remarks at the opening session at the 2nd TIWG Meet.



The subject of WTO Reform, which is one of the priorities pursued by the Indian Presidency, was taken up for discussion in a technical session. The emphasis of this session was on reaffirming WTO's foundational principles, as embodied in the Marrakesh Agreement and its multilateral trade agreements, thus recognizing the need for open, inclusive transparent and functioning of WTO.





Continuing with deliberations, the G20 India delegates focused on High-Level Principles for the digitalisation of trade documents. They also discussed an action plan to create Meta Information Portal for promoting MSMEs.

Day 3: May 25, 2023

On the third day of the meeting, the delegates focused on deliverables about the framework for mapping Global Value Chains, a compendium of best practices on Mutual Recognition Agreements & G20 Regulatory Dialogue.



Exploring the "The City of Gardens"
