Introduction

In 2018, Government of India launched Ayushman Bharat - one of the most ambitious health missions ever to expand universal health coverage, especially in rural and vulnerable populations. Ayushman Bharat is an attempt to move away from a sectoral and segmented approach of health service delivery to a comprehensive one.

Ayushman Bharat: Progress in Karnataka

1. Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY)

Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) was launched on September 23, 2018, and provides financial protection and a benefit cover of Rs. 5 lakh per family per year to poor, deprived rural families and identified occupational categories of urban workers' families. It is the world's largest government-funded healthcare program targeting more than 50 crore beneficiaries.

- Over **1.36 Crore Ayushman cards** have been created.
- Over **35.88 lakh beneficiaries** have availed of free treatment under the scheme amounting to over **Rs. 2982 crores**.
- Total number of hospitals empanelled -3,444 (Public -2906 and Private -538)

2. Ayushman Bharat-Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) in Karnataka

<u>Ayushman Bharat – Health & Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs)</u> deliver Comprehensive Primary Health Care, that is universal and free to users, with a focus on wellness and the delivery of an expanded range of services closer to the community.


As on <u>February 28, 2023</u>, a total of **9,285 AB-HWCs** have been **operationalized in Karnataka** to deliver Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC) that includes preventive, promotive, curative, palliative and rehabilitative services which are universal, free, and closer to the community.




3. Ayushman Bharat - Digital Mission


Ayushman Bharat – Digital Mission was launched on September 27, 2021 to create a seamless online platform that will enable interoperability within the digital healthcare ecosystem.

As on March 19, 2023, **1.62 Crore Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts** have been created in Karnataka. Further, a total of **77.31 lakh Health records** have been linked.

4. Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM)

Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM) was launched on 25th October 2021 with an outlay of about Rs. 64,180 Crore (till FY 2025-26). The scheme aims at strengthening health systems and institutions in order to provide a continuum of care at all levels, namely primary, secondary and tertiary, as well as preparing health systems to respond effectively to current and future pandemics and disasters.

The total <u>Central Release under PM-ABHIM to Karnataka</u> is **Rs. 11.25** Crore in FY 2021-22, and the total Central Allocation under PM-ABHIM to Karnataka is **Rs. 135.34** Crore in FY 2022-23.
