

Youth-20 group's Inception Meet

As part of India's G20 Presidency, the Youth-20 (Y20) group's inception meeting was held at Guwahati from February 06-08, 2023 to engage with the youth of the nation on ideas for a better tomorrow and draft an agenda for action on five identified Y20 themes.² This was the first of the various summits to be held on the five Y20 themes at different Universities across the Indian States in a run-up to the final Youth-20 Summit in August 2023.³

In the [run-up to the event, 10,000 youth in around 36 colleges of Assam participated in seminars, debates, workshops, and quiz competitions on Y20](#). Over 10 lakh students from around 4000 schools also participated.

During the inception meeting, 21 foreign delegates and 200 Indian delegates participated in the main events.⁴

Background - Hosting the Youth Summit

Started in 2012, the Y20 is the youth version of the G20 Summits and it is the only officially recognized platform for young people to engage with the G20. It is one of the most influential international diplomatic forums for young leaders. It is also one of eight official engagement groups under the G-20 umbrella.

The G20 rotating Presidency bears the responsibility of hosting the youth summit, which usually takes place some weeks before the traditional forum to engage with the youth and know their views and vision of the future to incorporate them into the policy proposals. It is an attempt to create a connecting point between G20 governments and their local youth.⁵

Youth 20 Engagement Group - Inception Meeting

Day-1

The **second day** of the Inception Meeting of Y20 began at the sprawling campus of IIT Guwahati. In the 'Youth Dialogue with Youth Minister' session, Shri Anurag Singh Thakur stated that the Y20 India Summit would exemplify the youth-centric efforts and showcase policy measures ideated by the youth. He stated that India's demographic dividend is uniquely poised to usher in an era of rapid social, economic, environmental, and technological innovation and advancement.⁷

While remarking on the opportunities for youth in the Amrit Kaal of Indian democracy, the Minister stated that Amrit Kaal is *Adhigam Kaal* - an era of leap forward, *Awsar Kaal* - an era of opportunities and *Kartavya Kaal* - an era of duty to the nation.


