# SEVEN YEARS OF PRADHAN MANTRI UJJWALA YOJANA (PMUY)

LPG coverage improves to 105.4% in 2023 as compared to 62% in 2016 Over 9.59 crore deposit-free LPG connections distributed under PMUY (Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas)

# LAUNCH

PMUY was launched on **May 01, 2016**. Ujjwala 2.0 was launched on **August 10, 2021**.

## AIM

To safeguard the health of women and children by providing them with clean cooking fuel, so that they don't have to compromise their health in smoky kitchens.



Deposit-free LPG connection is given to the eligible household with the financialassistance of **Rs 1,600 per connection** to cover the cost of a cylinder, pressure regulator, LPG hose, consumer card and installation charges.

# TARGET

- The initial target was to provide LPG connections to 5 crore women members of BPL households. Subsequently, the scheme was expanded and the target was revised to 8 crore LPG connections. This target was achieved in September 2019, seven months ahead of the scheduled date.
- To cover the remaining households under PMUY, Ujjwala 2.0 was started on August 10, 2021, on pan India basis to provide an additional one crore LPG connections. Based on a large number of applications, Government further extended the scheme with 60 lakh more connections under Ujjwala 2.0.



#### ACHIEVEMENTS

As on March 1, 2023, the total <u>number of connections released under PMUY is</u> <u>9.59 crore.<sup>1</sup></u>

The active domestic LPG consumers have increased from <u>14.52 crore in April 2014</u> to <u>31.36 crore as of March 2023<sup>2</sup></u>.



On March 24, 2023, Union Cabinet approved a subsidy of Rs.200 per 14.2 kg cylinder for up to 12 refills per year for the beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY).

- As part of Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package, more than 14 crore free LPG refills were provided to the PMUY beneficiaries during COVID-19.
- Under the Give-It-Up initiative, more than <u>One crore people themselves gave up</u> the subsidy on LPG, which benefited the needy people.

## **GLOBAL RECOGNITION OF THE SCHEME**

- ➤ International Energy Agency said it is a "major achievement" in improving the environment and health of women.
- WHO report (2018) said that Ujjwala Yojana has provided 37 million women, living below the poverty line, with free LPG connections to support them to switch to clean household energy use.

## TOP STATES WITH MAXIMUM CONNECTIONS UNDER PMUY

All <u>LPG connection are released in the name of adult woman</u> of the poor family. Women in the states of **Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan** have been the biggest beneficiaries of PMUY.
