


The Goals of W20 are:

WOMEN 20 – INCEPTION MEETING MEETING, AURANGABAD, MAHARASHTRA | FEBRUARY **27 - 28, 2023**

Pursuit of Gender Equality, Equity and Dignity for Women-led Development

The two-day Women-20 (W-20) Inception Meet was held at Aurangabad, Maharashtra from February 27-28, 2023. In this meet, around 150 women dignitaries from member countries, guest countries, and special invitees participated.

The Women-20 (W-20) India inaugurated its inception meeting in Aurangabad on February 27, 2023, in the presence of Union Women and Child Development Minister Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani, Union Minister of State for Finance Dr. Bhagwat Kishanrao Karad, Union Minister of State for Railways, Coal & Mines Shri Raosaheb Danve Patil and G-20 India Sherpa Shri Amitabh Kant. W-20 India Chair Dr. Sandhya Purecha, Founding Chair of W-20 Ms. Gülden Türktan and W-20 India Chief Coordinator Smt. Dharitri Patnaik were also present.W-20 Chair Dr. Sandhya Purecha welcomed the delegates to "**The Land of Vedas**" and reiterated India's vision of establishing a world of equity, equality, and dignity.

Addressing the delegates at the Inaugural Ceremony, Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani spoke about the five priority areas of W20 under India's Presidency, namely, Women's Leadership at the Grassroots, Female Enterprise and Female Prowess in the Agriculture Sector, Bridging the Digital divide, Education and Skill Development and Women and Girls as Changemakers in Climate Resilience Action.

Day 1 of the W20 inception meeting concluded with a special session on "Women-led Development in India".

Day 2: February 28, 2023

Day-2 of the inception meeting today started with a special session on the theme **''Breaking the Barriers: The Stories of Unconventional Women''.** Rajya Sabha MP Dr. Sonal along

with Dr. Sandhya Purecha launched a coffee table book called ' Avvaya'', highlighting the contribution of women to the heritage city of Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar.

The session also saw the participation of bravehearts from Indian Navy - Shazia Khan, Disha Amrith, Tavishi Singh, and Swati Bhandari who rose above the social fabric to quash the patriarchal ideas that restrict women from entering certain sectors.

Zubedia Bibi, a Jammu &



Kashmiri Rural Livelihood Mission member, expressed how the Administration's initiative under the Union Government has helped women in rural areas economically empower themselves and provide for their families.

The sixth session of the W-20 Inception Meet, titled 'Enablers of Women-led Development: Policy and Legal Framework' focused on the role of policy and legal framework as enablers of women-led development and economic empowerment.

The event began with an enchanting cultural performance by Mahagami, emphasising the rich and diverse cultural heritage of India.



SECOND WOMEN 20 INTERNATIONAL MEETING, JAIPUR | APRIL 13-14, 2023

Women-Led Development: Leveraging Women's Untapped Potential to Accelerate Inclusive & Sustainable Future

The delegates arrived for the meeting on April 12. A session was held on the same day on the theme of 'Jan Bhagidari: The Women's Journey of Women Empowerment', with Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, Minister of State, Culture, Government of India as the Chief Guest.

Day 1: April 13, 2023

The first day started with registration followed by the Inaugural Session. Addressing the inaugural session, Sherpa of India in G 20 Amitabh Kant said that women-led development is the key priority of India because we see women as drivers of prosperity and inclusive development.

The session was addressed by notable figures such as Dr. Shamika Ravi, Member Economic Advisory Council of Prime Minister of India, Shri. Indevar Pandey, Secretary, Ministry of Women



and Child Development, Government of India, Shri Amitabh Kant, Sherpa, G20 India. The inaugural session concluded with the launch of the 'Call to Action'-W20 Initiative: MISSION DIGITAL WOMEN- Financial & Digital Literacy and Skilling Programme.

The day concluded with an **Art Workshop** under the Department of Tourism, Government of Rajasthan followed by a **Cultural Evening and Gala Dinner**.



Day 2: April 14, 2023

The second day witnessed an early start with an event - Leadership Development of Women through YOGA by Pujya Sadhvi Devapriya, Patanjali University.



This was followed by a **Plenary session on Grassroots Leadership and Entrepreneurship**. This session had welcome remarks by Dr Sandhya Purecha, Chair W20 and Keynote Address by Smt. Darshana Jardosh, Union State Minister of Railways and Textiles with Vote of Thanks by Ms Dharitri Patnaik, Chief Coordinator, W20. The objectives of this session was identifying challenges and pathways to ensure equal participation by girls and women in political and public leadership at the grassroots level and discussing policy recommendations to promote women-led entrepreneurship.

On April 15, excursions for the delegates were organised to the City Palace, Jantar Mantar, Albert Museum and Hawa Mahal and a tour of the local markets such as the Bapu Bazaar and the Johari Bazar.



The second meeting of the W20 reiterated India's commitment to gender equality and equity as part of the country's G20 Presidency. This meeting held in Jaipur witnessed insightful deliberations and discussions in relation to women's development and empowerment in view of how gender considerations can be incorporated at the centre of the wider G20 agenda of sustainable growth and inclusive development. The meeting also witnessed a reiteration of the specific goals of the Women-20 group of the G20 that has been created with the aim of ensuring dignity for women and removing all barriers to their growth and empowerment.
