Dear officers of Indian Ordnance Factories Service,

India now exports a wide range of defence products, including aircraft like the Dornier-228, Brahmos Missiles, PINAKA rockets & launchers, radars, simulators, etc. The global demand for India's indigenous products, such as the LCA-Tejas, Aircraft Carriers, and MRO activities, is also increasing. Dear young officers, it is imperative that while discharging your duties, you actively participate in the development programmes and facilitate the process of making India a defence manufacturing hub.

Dear officers of Indian Defence Accounts Service,
