Pucca House to Tap Water: How Life Changed for Arunachal's Lakar Paleng Recounts his experience of Government Schemes with the Prime Minister

Amidst the scenic hills and misty valleys of Namsai, Arunachal Pradesh, a story of gratitude unfolded. Shri Lakar Paleng, a resident of this remote corner of India, found himself face to face with none other than Prime Minister Narendra Modi, not in person but through the magic of video conferencing during the ongoing Vikasit Bharat Sankalp Yatra.
