More than 6.5 lakh recruited in 10 editions of National Rozgar Mela

(Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship)

To give impetus to the employment initiatives in the country, the <u>National Skill Development</u> <u>Corporation (NSDC)</u> under the aegis of the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Government of India has been organizing Rozgar Melas across the nation to provide suitable job opportunities in the private sector to the unemployed youth.

Rozgar Mela¹

A Rozgar Mela is a half-day event where several employers and job seekers come together for the purpose of applying and interviewing for jobs. It is an employment strategy to fast-

track the meeting of job seekers and employers. For the execution of Rozgar Melas, NSDC seeks support from the respective Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) and the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs) for sourcing the employers i.e. private companies for the Rozgar Mela.

These Rozgar Melas generally cater to the youth in the age group of 18-35 years with an academic qualification covering 8th/10th/12th Pass. Diploma, ITI, Graduates, etc. including the trained and candidates conforming certified to National Skills Qualifications Framework.

The jobseekers for the Rozgar Mela are sensitized and mobilized through various

channels including Print Advertisement, Bulk SMS, social media, and workshops at the College and University level in and around the districts of the Rozgar Mela.

The Rozgar Melas are generally accompanied by other activities including:

- Counselling Sessions for the jobseekers & their parents,
- Kaushal Melas for the registration of youth under fresh skill development training (PMKK/PMKVY), and
- Mudra Loan Facilitation Counters & Skill Exhibition (where SSCs demonstrate the training model, equipment, and job roles of their respective sectors)

In addition to the NSDC Rozgar Mela, the concerned agencies of NSDC like Sector Skill Councils, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna Training Partners also conduct Rozgar Mela of varying scales and magnitude for the youth in the age group of 18-35 years on pan-India basis.

Goals of Rozgar Mela

- Empowering the youth
- Providing opportunities for the youth to contribute to the nation's development
- Fast-tracking the meeting of job seekers and employers
- Reflecting the Prime Minister's vision that development should reach all parts of the country equally

Contribution of Rozgar Mela

- Rozgar Mela gives an opportunity for job seekers to learn more about potential employers and various employment opportunities available, including entrepreneurship.
- It also offers a platform for organizations to meet potential employees in an informal setting.
- It brings skilled candidates in direct contact with recruiters, HR managers, admission officers, and advisory bodies/training providers.

National Rozgar Mela at a Glance

Rozgar Mela was launched by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on October 22, 2023 via video conferencing, announcing recruitment for 10 lakh personnels in the Central Government.

1st Edition of National Rozgar Mela | October 22, 2022

During the ceremony, appointment letters were handed over to more than 75,000 new recruits during the function.²



2nd Edition of National Rozgar Mela | November 22, 2022

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi released the second tranche of about 71,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits in more than 45 cities via video conferencing.³



3rd Edition of National Rozgar Mela | January 20, 2023

71,000 appointment letters were distributed by the Prime Minister to newly inducted recruits in Government departments and organizations via video conferencing.⁴

4th Edition of National Rozgar Mela | April 13, 2023

In the 4th edition of Rozgar Mela, held in Thiruvananthpuram, about 71,000 appointment letters for various posts in 45 departments were distributed at 45 locations across the country.⁵



5th Edition of National Rozgar Mela | May 16, 2023

Over 71,000 appointment letters were given out at the 5th edition of Rozgar Mela organized in Mumbai, Pune, and Nanded in Maharashtra.⁶

6th Edition of National Rozgar Mela | June 13, 2023

About 70,000 appointment letters were distributed in the 6th Rozgar Mela held in Guwahati.⁷



7th Edition of National Rozgar Mela | July 22, 2023

Over 70,000 appointment letters were distributed via video conferencing by Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the 7th session of Rozgar Mela held in Goa. 44 places across the country were connected with the Mela during the Prime Minister's address.⁸



8th Edition of National Rozgar Mela | August 28, 2023

Prime Minister Narendra Modi distributed more than 51,000 appointment letters through video conferencing in 8th edition of Rozgar Mela, which was held at 45 locations across the country.⁹ Through this Rozgar Mela event, Ministry of Home Affairs recruited personnel in various central armed police forces (CAPFs) such as Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Border Security Force (BSF), Shashtra Seema Bal (SSB), Assam Rifles, Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Indo Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) and Narcotics control Bureau (NCB) as well as Delhi Police. The new appointees were called 'Amrit Rakshak' of Amrit Kaal by the Prime Minister.

9th Edition of National Rozgar Mela | September 26, 2023

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the 9th edition of Rozgar Mela via video conferencing and distributed about 51,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits, selected from across the country. The Rozgar Mela took place at 46 locations across the country.¹⁰



10th Edition of National Rozgar Mela | October 28, 2023

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the 10th National Rozgar Mela via video conferencing and distributed more than 51,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits in various Government departments and organizations.¹¹



The newly inducted appointees are also getting an opportunity to train themselves through Karmayogi Prarambh, an online module on iGOT Karmayogi portal, where more than 400 elearning courses have been made available for 'anywhere any device' learning format. Further, all Ministries and Departments are working to fill existing vacancies against
