Smart Cities Mission

100 cities selected under the Smart Cities Mission, are developing 8000 multi-sectoral projects, as per their local needs amounting to Rs. 1,65,000 crore. These projects can be categorized into ICCC, smart mobility, smart energy, WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene), Vibrant Public Spaces, Economic Infrastructure, Social Infrastructure, Smart Governance among others.

Physical progress: 91% of total projects (7,352 projects worth Rs. 1,47,366 Cr.) have been completed and around 714 projects worth Rs. 17,303 Cr are under implementation across 100 Smart Cities.

Financial progress: Out of the total allocated budget of Rs. 48,000 crore, GoI has released Rs. 46,419 Cr. to the cities under the mission, of which Rs. 44,545 Cr. has been utilized by Smart cities.

Some of the key achievements of the Smart Cities Mission include:

- Integrated Command and Control Centres (ICCC): All 100 smart cities have operational Integrated Command and Control Centre (ICCC) which are utilizing data to make data-based decisions. The use of technology towards urban management has increased.
- **Public Safety and Security:** More than 83,000 CCTV surveillance cameras have been installed in 100 smart cities which helps in crime monitoring. 1,884 emergency call boxes, 3,000+ public address systems, and traffic enforcement systems for red light violations, automatic number plate recognition, etc. have improved public safety.
- **Vibrant Public Spaces:** 1200+ projects on public spaces have been developed across 84 smart cities, including 318 km of waterfront development by 62 smart cities. 55 smart cities have completed conservation of 484 heritage monuments, while 58 cities have undertaken market redevelopment projects.
- Water Supply: More than 17,000 kms of water supply system are being monitored through SCADA in 31 smart cities, reducing the non-revenue water and leakages.
- **Solid Waste Management:** 48 smart cities are using their ICCCs to monitor door-to-door solid waste collection in conjunction with 9,000 RFID-enabled vehicles, resulting in improved route management and efficient collection.
- Streetlights: 16 Lakhs of Solar/LED Streetlights have been installed across 79 smart cities
- **Mobility:** 1,700 km of Smart roads with universal accessibility, utility ducts have been constructed across 84 smart cities. 23,000 public bicycles, 1,500+ buses procured, 2,000+ bus stops have been developed. 35 cities are monitoring traffic through the ICCCs.
- Affordable Housing and Shelter: 35,000 affordable housing units built by 23 smart cities.
- Smart Solutions: 9,400 number of Wifi hotspot locations created and more than 83,000 CCTV cameras installed.
- **Education**: More than 9,400 smart classrooms have been developed across 2,300 government schools in 71 smart cities. 38 Digital Libraries and 1,600+ Anganwadis have been developed.
- **Health**: 30 smart cities have supported 165 hospitals. Additionally, 172 e-health centers and clinics have been developed (without dedicated beds) and 155 health ATMs installed.
- **Sports infrastructure**: 59 smart cities have developed around 300 sports facilities that include integrated sports complexes, stadiums, and indoor sporting facilities.
- **Economic Hubs**: 17 incubation projects, 29 skill development/vocational training centres, and have been developed. These projects have helped 1,400+ startups and 20,000+ vendors.
- **PPP:** 50+ cities are successfully implementing 199 projects with Public Private Partnership (PPP) projects worth ₹ 9,200 crores.
