

YES-TECH (Yield Estimation System Based on Technology) ensures remote sensing based accurate yield estimation, while CROPIC (Collection of Real-time photos and Observations of Crops) uses geotagged photos to verify crops for precise damage assessment. This tech integration empowers farmers and streamlines insurance operations.

With 56.96 crore applications insured since its inception in 2016-17, the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) has demonstrated substantial impact, paying out Rs 1,54,469 crore in claims.
