

IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED due to very heavy rainfall/extremely heavy falls over Kerala & Mahe on 08<sup>th</sup> & 09<sup>th</sup>; Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Coastal & North Interior Karnataka during 08<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

#### **Impact Expected**

- ➤ Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- > Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- ➤ Localized Landslides/Mudslides/landslips/mudslips/landsinks/mudsinks.
- ➤ Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- > It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

## A. Action Suggested

- ➤ Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- ➤ Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

#### **IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED due to Heat Wave Conditions:**

#### Orange alert Areas:

- ➤ High temperature & increased likelihood of heat illness symptoms in people who are either exposed to sun for a prolonged period or doing heavy work.
- ➤ High health concern for vulnerable people e.g. infants, elderly, people with chronic diseases.
- ➤ Avoid heat exposure- keep cool. Avoid dehydration.
- Drink sufficient water- even if not thirsty.
- ➤ Use ORS, homemade drinks like lassi, torani (rice water), lemon water, buttermilk, etc. to keep yourself hydrated.

#### Yellow alert Areas:

- Moderate temperature & heat is tolerable for general public but moderate health concern likely for vulnerable people e.g. infants, elderly, people with chronic diseases.
- ➤ Avoid heat exposure.
- Wear lightweight, light colour, loose, cotton clothes.
- Cover your head, use a cloth, hat or umbrella.

Impact expected and action suggested due to thunderstorms, lightning/squall/gusty winds/Hailstorm over Madhya Pradesh during 08th-09th June, 2024.

#### Impact expected:

- > Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ➤ Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

#### **Action suggested:**

- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- > Immediately get out of water bodies.
- ➤ Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

# Agromet advisories for Heavy Rainfall, Gusty winds, Hail Storms and Heat Wave likely over various parts of the country:

- Drain out excess water from crop fields to avoid water stagnation in Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Maharashtra and Sub Himalayan West Bengal.
- Apply light and frequent irrigation to standing crops to avoid heat stress; provide mulching to conserve soil moisture and minimise evaporation in Uttar Pradesh, Odisha, Jharkhand and East Madhya Pradesh.
- ➤ Use hail nets or hail caps in fruit orchards to prevent mechanical damage and provide mechanical support to horticultural crops & staking to vegetables in West Rajasthan and West Madhya Pradesh.
- Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops & Department of the prevent damage from gusty winds.
