Success of Modi Government against Narcotics

- A zero-tolerance policy has been adopted against narcotics.
- Under the "Whole of Government Approach," the Indian government has successfully fought against narcotic substances through inter-departmental coordination.
- NCORD: A four-tier NCORD mechanism was established for coordination and collaboration.
- NCORD Portal: Functions as a data integration and knowledge management system.
- A Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) was formed for detailed investigations.
- A dedicated Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) was set up.
- National Narcotics Canine Pool (NAR-K9) was established.

- From June 2022 to June 2024, more than 15 lakh 96 thousand kilograms of narcotic substances, worth approximately ₹15 thousand crore, were disposed of by burning.
- Participation of over 3 crore youth and more than 2 crore women in the Nasha Mukt Bharat campaign, reaching over 10 crore 71 lakhs people across India.
- MANAS Portal: Used for sharing information related to drug trafficking and providing facilities for de-addiction and rehabilitation of victims.
- A national toll-free MANAS helpline 1933 is being operated for assistance related to drug addiction.
