

**Brief of projects of Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying inaugurated/ foundation
laid by Hon'ble Prime Minister**

Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Projects assisted under Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM), National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD), and Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) with a total outlay of Rs 947 Crore.

The details of these projects are as under:

Projects Inaugurated:

A. Rashtriya Gokul Mission

I. Establishment of IVF lab, Guwahati & Professional training Institute at Lakhimpur, Assam- Outlay Rs. 2893 lakh

Under this project, Central assistance of Rs. 2893 lakh has been provided for the establishment of an IVF Laboratory at Guwahati and a Professional Training Institute at Lakhimpur, Assam under the Rashtriya Gokul Mission. The IVF Laboratory is being developed as a state-of-the-art facility with a special focus on advanced reproductive technologies, particularly In-Vitro Fertilization (IVF), to enhance bovine breeding efficiency in the North-Eastern region. In addition, the Professional Training Institute at Lakhimpur will serve as a hub for capacity building and skill development of veterinarians, AI technicians, and farmers, promoting the adoption of scientific breeding practices and advanced technologies. Together, these initiatives are expected to significantly contribute to breed conservation, productivity enhancement, and livelihood improvement for dairy farmers in Assam and the entire North-Eastern region.

II. Artificial Insemination Training Center, Shalteng, Kashmir- Outlay Rs. 401 lakh

Under this project, Central assistance of Rs. 401 lakh has been provided for the establishment of an Artificial Insemination Training Center in Kashmir under the Rashtriya Gokul Mission. The Centre is envisioned as a hub for capacity building and skill development of veterinarians, AI technicians, and farmers, thereby promoting the adoption of scientific breeding practices. This facility is inaugurated and is expected to strengthen AI services and enhance bovine productivity in the region.

B. National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)

I. Mehsana Milk Union - 120 MTPD Powder Plant and 3.5 LLPD UHT Plant -outlay of Rs 460 crore (Loan Rs 400 Cr)

This project supported under AHIDF with 3% interest subvention will significantly enhance dairy processing capacity and enable strategic preservation of surplus milk in the form of stable commodities like milk powder and UHT products. This will ensure efficient stock management, strengthen value addition, and improve supply chain resilience in the cooperative sector.

II. Indore Milk Union Powder Plant (30 MTPD) - Outlay Rs 76.50 Cr (loan Rs 29.50 Cr)

This project supported under NPDD, component B (Dairying through Cooperatives-JICA Assisted) with loan at subsidized rate of interest (@1.5%). The new plant will help in converting additional 2 Lakhs litter of raw milk into milk powder. It will ease the pressure on existing powder plants during the flush season and will increase the efficiency of the Milk Union along with reduction in processing expenditure. trail run is going on.

III. Bhilwara milk union -25 TLPD UHT Plant – Outlay Rs.46.82 Cr (Loan Rs 42.14 Cr)

This project supported under NPDD, component B (Dairying through Cooperatives-JICA Assisted) with loan at subsidized rate of interest (@1.5%). The plant has a production capacity of 25,000 litres/day, with initial trials underway for lassi, buttermilk, and cream. Designed for future expansion into flavored milk, milk, and fruit juice packaging, the facility will enhance product diversification and shelf-life, supporting market outreach and strengthening the milk union's value-added portfolio. trail run is going on.

IV. Karimnagar Milk Producer Company – 150 TPD Curd Plant, Outlay ₹25.45 Cr (Loan ₹72.42 Cr)

This project supported under NPDD, component B (Dairying through Cooperatives-JICA Assisted) with loan at subsidized rate of interest (@1.5%). The greenfield plant at Nustulapoor, Karimnagar, will enhance curd production capacity by 150 TPD, enabling processing of an additional 2 lakh litres of milk daily. It will strengthen market supply across Telangana and adjoining regions, improve value addition, and support the growth of the cooperative dairy sector.

C. Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF)

Under the scheme, 10 projects with the total project cost of Rs 303.81 crore are inaugurated. These projects will generates direct employment of 400 and indirect employment to 2000 farmers. The project to be inaugurated are from MSME, Private Companies and FPOs. The categories of the project are Animal Feed, Poultry layer farm, 4 projects are for dairy and value addition and 1 project is for meat processing. The project will increase processing capacity of animal feed to 167760 MT/annum, milk processing capacity to the tune of 347296 LPD and meat processing capacity will increase to 17100 MT/ annum. Details of the projects is given at Annexure-I.

As part of the *Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan* stimulus package, the Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) worth ₹15,000 crores was launched in 2020. AHIDF facilitates investments in the establishment of infrastructure for dairy, breeding, meat processing, establishment of animal feed plants. Keeping in view of the success of AHIDF, the erstwhile Dairy Processing Infrastructure Development Fund has been subsumed with the AHIDF on 01.02.2024. Now total size of the fund is ₹29110 cr. Till date ₹ 2200 crore investment has been leveraged in 402 approved projects. Due to Government intervention, there has been increase in 2-5% in processing capacity for dairy, meat, animals feed.

Foundation Laid :

A. National Programme for Dairy Development

I. Shreeja Milk Producer Organisation-Integrated Dairy & Cattle Feed plant at Kuppam– Andhra Pradesh- Outlay- Rs. 219 Crore.

100% Women Led Milk Producer Organisation

Shree MPC is the biggest women owned and operated Milk Producer Company and have received Dairy Innovation Award from IDF at Chicago.

The proposed facility will be the ***first integrated plant*** with milk processing and cattle feed manufacturing facility **under Milk Producer Company**. This plant will benefit 1.20 Lakhs women dairy farmers spread across 1500 villagers procuring about 5.61 Lakh Litter per day.

Department of Animal Husbandry through NDDB Dairy Services has created 23 Milk Producer Organization operating across 11 states covering about 183 districts. These milk producer companies procure about 60 Lakh Liter Per Day and cater to about 12 Lakh farmers out of which 73% are women members. Out of the total 23 MPC, **18 MPC are women owned MPC.**
