## 1.1 Introduction

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) provide a comprehensive global framework for achieving peace, prosperity, and sustainability for people and the planet. As a signatory to the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, India is committed to achieving 17 Sustainable Development Goals and their 169 associated targets. This commitment aligns with the Government of India's guiding vision of "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikaas, Sabka Vishwas, Sabka Prayas", which emphasises collective effort, inclusive growth, mutual trust, and shared responsibility in the development process. Central to this approach is the core principle of "Leaving No One Behind (LNOB)", ensuring that the benefits of development reach all sections of society, particularly the most vulnerable and marginalized.

Panchayats, as the third tier of government, play a pivotal role in ensuring good governance and advancing the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. Considering the importance of issues related to development in rural areas, Panchayats have to address critical development challenges such as poverty eradication, food security, health, education, gender equality, and access to safe drinking water and sanitation. Therefore, localizing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) at the Panchayat level is essential to ensure inclusive, need-based, and sustainable rural development.

Panchayat Advancement Index (PAI) is an instrument to measure the incremental progress of 2.66 lakh Gram Panchayats (GP) Equivalent to GP in the country on the various sectors of development in rural areas.

GP can assess its level of development through the PAI and compare its performance with other GPs of the Block, District within State. It is a significant tool for evidence based planning. By assessing gram panchayats across nine thematic areas, the PAI enables targeted interventions to achieve SDG targets by 2030.

### About Localization of Sustainable Development Goals (LSDGs)

Nearly 68% of India's population lives in rural areas. The achievement of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) at the national level will require concerted actions at the grassroots level through Panchayati Raj Institutions.

Ministry of Panchayati Raj has anchored the process of localization of sustainable development goals through thematic approach aggregating 17 Goals of Sustainable Development in collaboration with Union Ministries/ Departments, State Governments, UN Agencies, Academic Institutions and Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) embodying the spirit of Whole of Government and Whole of Society approach.

The thematic approach has been taken to cover most relevant SDGs in 9 themes so that Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) can easily relate to and comprehend the SDGs through those themes with Local Targets aligned to the National Targets & provide holistic vision for the Panchayats for planning. The progress of PRIs in attainment of LSDGs will, in turn, lead to attainment of SDGs.

## 1.3 Panchayat Advancement Index

With the landmark initiative of the Ministry of Panchayati Raj to localize the SDGs and work for their attainment through the FRIL, the measure of the progress on the LSDGs in rural areas through Panchayats needs to be assessed and measured at the local level. As of now, neither a local Indicator Framework (LIF), nor a Local level index is available to assess the performance of Panchayats. Thus, need has been felt to have such evidence based mechanisms for performance evaluation and progress assessment in achieving the LSDGs and ultimately SDGs and how far or close are our Rural Local Bodies from achieving the LSDGs and thereby SDGs.

Ministry of Panchayati Raj has developed Panchayat Development Index (PAI) – multi dimensional index to measure the incremental performance of the Gram Panchayats Equivalent to GP based on measurable local indicators across 9 themes of LSDGs. It is a tool designed to track the progress of Gram Panchayats based on thematic & composite scores achieved by GP across 9 themes of LSDGs.

Based on the PAI thematic & composite scores achieved by different Gram Panchayats, these GPs are grouped into one of the categories of performance - Achiever: (90+), Front Runner: (75 to below 90); Performer: (60 to below 75); Aspirant: (40 to below 60) and Beginners (below 40). The outcomes of the PAI, over time, will reflect incremental progress based on the scores achieved by Panchayats, highlighting their advancement toward realizing the LSDGs.

## 1.5 Significance of Panchayat Advancement Index

### Promoting Evidence-Based Planning

- PAI provides a data-driven approach to monitor and evaluate developmental progress. This approach ensures that resources are allocated effectively and that panchayats can identify and address specific developmental gaps.

### Encouraging Collaborative Efforts

- The necessity of collective and collaborative efforts among state-level departments, Panchayat Raj Institutions (PRIs), and other stakeholders. Such coordination is vital for the successful implementation of the PAI and for achieving the desired developmental outcomes.

### Data-Driven Governance for Informed Decisions

- PAI compiles quantifiable metrics across nine SDG-linked themes such as poverty, health, education, sanitation, and governance. This data allows panchayats to identify strengths and weaknesses and plan interventions based on factual ground realities, not assumptions.

### Localized Development Priorities

- It helps tailor development initiatives to specific local needs. For instance, if a GP scores low on sanitation or water availability, the Gram Panchayat can prioritize these sectors in its annual action plan.

### Performance Monitoring and Impact Evaluation

- PAI enables tracking progress over time. Panchayats can assess whether their plans are delivering desired outcomes and adjust strategies accordingly, a core element of evidence-based governance.

### Resource Optimization

- By highlighting development gaps, PAI aids in better allocation of resources (financial, human, and infrastructural) where they are needed most, ensuring cost-effective and impactful utilization. Further, PAI insights guide higher-level policymakers to understand ground-level trends, allowing for better scheme convergence (e.g., MGNREGS, Swachh Bharat Mission, Jal Jeevan Mission) aligned to actual grassroots needs.

## 1.6 Stakeholders of Panchayat Advancement Index

Panchayat Advancement Index will be an important statistical tool to capture the structured progress in different key sectors based on identified development gaps through PAI score and help to witness the assessment of the Central Scheme, State Scheme, local actions of PUKs, and other key stakeholders involved at the Panchayat level.

Stakeholder analysis is essential for effective planning and implementation of the Panchayat Advancement Index emphasizing the role of stakeholders/agencies connected in the Panchayat. The important stakeholders include Panchayats, PUKs, Central Government, State Government, Academic & Research Institutes, UN agencies and other Knowledge Partners.

This broad stakeholder involvement assures through coverage and effective implementation of PAI, enhancing its utility in assessing localized SDGs progress.

### 1.8 Release of Panchayat Advancement Index 1.0

Ministry has released the PAI 1.0 Baseline Report FY 2021-23 on 9th April 2023 through Press Release. Total 29 States/UTs have submitted validated PAI Data in the dedicated Portal ([www.pai.gov.in](http://www.pai.gov.in)) covering 2.16 lakh Gram Panchayats Equivalent to GPs across India. Data for 11,712 Gram Panchayats from five States/UTs (Meghalaya, Nagaland, Goa, Puducherry, and West Bengal) were not included in 1.0 due to pending validation of data. List of States/UTs on-boarded in PAI 1.0 is placed at Annexure I.

Snapshot of PAI 1.0 FY 2021-23: Total 699 Gram Panchayats are graded under A category, followed by 77,196 Gram Panchayats in B category, 1,32,392 Gram Panchayats in the C Category, and 5,896 Gram Panchayats are categorized in the D category.

### 1.9 Collaboration with Union Ministries/Departments

In the exercise of PAI, Ministry has collaborated with Union Ministries /Departments namely Ministry of Rural Development, Department of School Education & Literacy, Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation and Ministry of Women & Child Development for auto-porting of data from different national portals to ensure data standardization and reduce the effort of data entry by the GP. Total 137 & 59 data points are auto ported in the exercise of PAI 1.0 and 2.0.

## 2.1 Framework & Methodology used in PAI 2.0

PAI 2.0 comprises 150 indicators where 119 is unique indicators, each varying in terms of their units of value, nature, and significance.

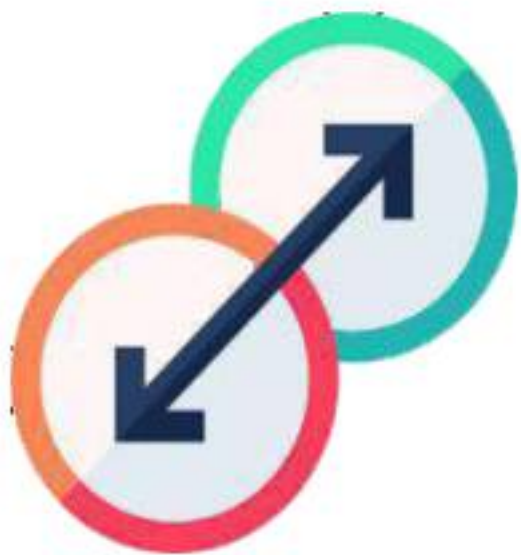

2.4. PAI Scoring Matrix

The scoring system categorizes performance into five levels: "Achiever" (90-100, grade A+, blue), "Front Runner" (75-90, grade A, green), "Performer" (60-75, grade B, amber), "Aspirant" (40-60, grade C, orange), and "Beginner" (0-40, grade D, red).

## 3.1 Paradigms shift from PAI 1.0 to PAI 2.0

Rationalisation of indicators and data points, focus on reducing from 316 indicators and 794 data points to 150 indicators and 250 data points to create simpler forms

Measurable indicators aligned with actual data availability at the field level

Data points have been simplified to make them easy to understand and use at the Gram Panchayat level

A single integrated data entry form has been introduced, replacing multiple fragmented Data Collection Formset (DCF) sheets

Soft data validation checks have been incorporated at the data entry stage to minimise human errors

A cross data validation mechanism has been provided to ensure better data consistency and reliability

Improved convergence has been achieved with Union Ministries/Departments to facilitate auto-porting of datasets

The user interface has been enhanced with real-time dashboards for intuitive navigation and better decision-making

Mandatory validation through Geospatial has been incorporated to ensure transparency and accountability

Focus on more accuracy in data

A dynamic and automated workflow has been established from Gram Panchayat to Block, District, State, and Centre levels

Vernacular language support has been provided to improve accessibility and usability at the local level to interpret the data points clearly

Integration with Panchayat Nitray application has been enabled for identifying the critical gaps in various themes and support the GP in undertaking Sankalp for evidence based & thematic GPCP

Indicators have been standardised and equally weighted to ensure uniformity and comparability across States

## 4.1 Panchayat Advancement Index 2.0

Before initiating the next round of the Panchayat Advancement Index (PAI) exercise for the year 2023-24, Ministry decided to undertake a comprehensive review of the PAI 1.0. Accordingly, a Committee for the rationalization of local indicators of PAI under the Chairmanship of the Additional Secretary, PR has reviewed the local indicator framework of PAI 1.0; assess the availability of data at the panchayat level, examine the feasibility of auto-porting data from various national portals, and simplify indicators along with their corresponding data points. Members of the Committee from concerned Union Ministries/Departments, State Governments, NITI Aayog, and MoSPI had appraised the entire structure of the framework of LIF and recommended 150 local indicators and 130 data points for PAI 2.0 in comparison to 516 local indicators and 794 data points used in PAI 1.0 across 9 themes of LSDGs.

The rationalization exercise facilitated standardization of the Local Indicator Framework, ensured uniformity in data sources, and enhanced data accuracy. Subsequently, the Committee also recommended a refined set of 119 unique local indicators and 165 unique data points for implementation.

The transition from PAI 1.0 to PAI 2.0 reflects a focused refinement of the framework, with a more relevant and representative set of local indicators and data points to improve usability, increase better participation of GP and to enhance the efficiency of Gram Panchayat operations by simplifying workflows and enabling automatic data standardization from different National Portals. The PAI Portal has also been enhanced by providing an integrated data entry form & imposing soft validation checks at the level of entry of data to ensure accurate & quality data entry. The theme wise comparison of Local Indicator counts of PAI 1.0 and 2.0 is placed at Annexure II.

Ministry has commenced the exercise of Panchayat Advancement Index (PAI) 2.0 for FY 2023-24, focusing on rationalizing local indicators across nine LSDG themes to improve data accuracy and quality. It aims to enhance Gram Panchayat Equivalent to GPs efficiency through simplified workflows and automatic data integration from national portals of relevant Ministries and Departments. PAI 2.0 FY 2023-24 has been launched on 26-27 May 2023 at New Delhi.

### 4.2 Key Improvements in PAI 2.0:

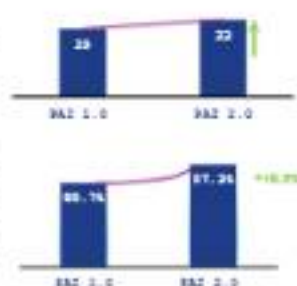
- Substantial rationalization of indicators, reduced from 516 indicators and 794 data points in PAI 1.0 to 150 indicators and 130 data points, ensuring sharper focus and better usability
- Data points have been simplified to make them easy to understand and use at the Gram Panchayat level
- Adoption of measurable and field-level feasible indicators aligned with actual data availability
- Introduction of a single integrated data entry form, replacing multiple fragmented data collection formats
- Soft validation and cross-data validation mechanisms to enhance data accuracy and reliability
- Enhanced auto-porting of data from national portals of social Union Ministries and Departments
- Mandatory Gram Sabha validation to promote transparency and accountability
- The user interface has been enhanced with real-time dashboards for intuitive navigation and better decision-making
- A dynamic and automated workflow has been introduced from the Gram Panchayat to Block, District, State, and Centre levels
- Embedded vernacular language support and integration with the Panchayat Nimitz application for evidence based Gram Panchayat Development Plan

The revised framework ensures standardized, comparable, and equally weighted indicators, strengthening the linkage of PAI with National Panchayat Awards and other incentive mechanisms.

### 4.3 Coverage and Participation

PAI 2.0 recorded wide national participation, with 33 out of 36 States and Union Territories taking part in the exercise. This included 27 out of 28 States (except West Bengal) and 6 out of 8 Union Territories (excluding Delhi and Chandigarh, which do not have Gram Panchayats).

A total of 2,19,867 Gram Panchayats Equivalent GPs, representing 97.30% of the total 2,66,999 Gram Panchayats across participating States/UTs, submitted validated data on the PAI portal. This marks a significant improvement over PAI 1.0, which recorded 80.79% participation. State/UT wise count of GP Equivalent to GP submitted data to Central Logic of PAI 2.0 is placed at Annexure III.



PAI 2.0 FY 2023-24 has been calculated using 112 unique local indicators & 153 unique data points in comparison to 435 unique local indicators & 566 data points used in PAI 1.0 FY 2022-23. A total of 7 local indicators have been excluded from the computation of PAI 2.0 due to mismatched in LGD codes; data represented a particular period etc. Total 52 out of 59 auto-purged data points from Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Women and Child Development, Department of School Education & Literacy, Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation and MoPR were used in the PAI 2.0. The auto-purging of data helps to reduce the manual entry of the GPs; and ensure the data standardization.

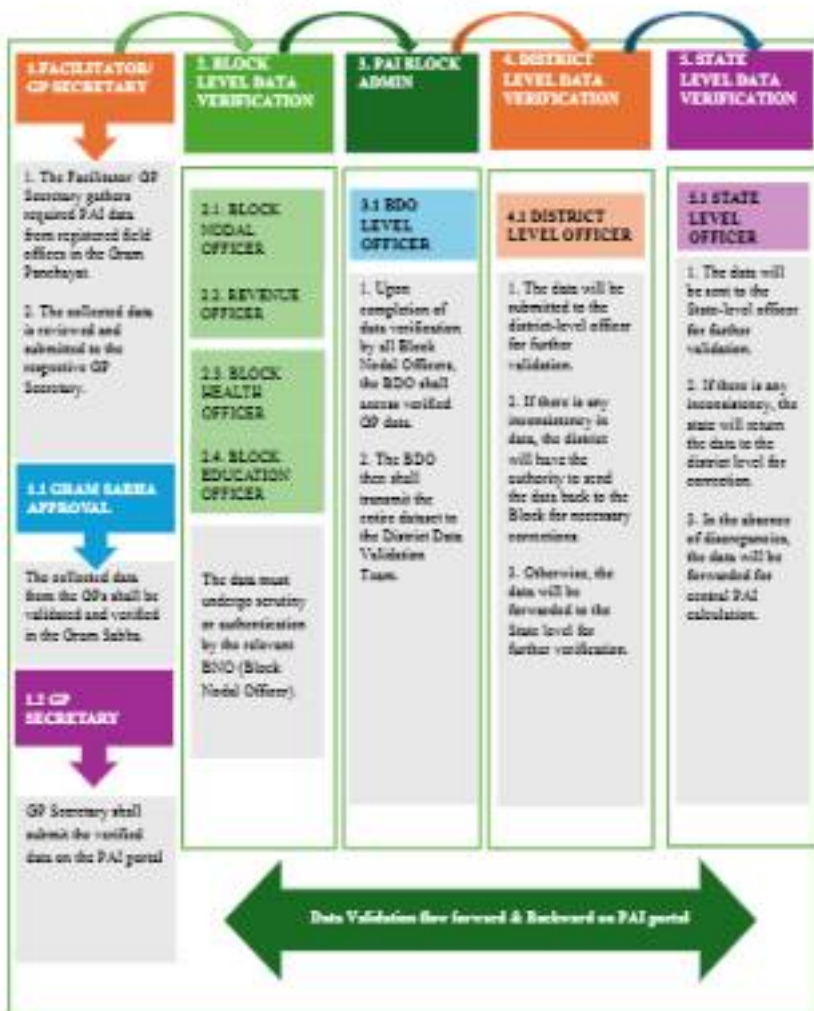

## 5.1 PAI data collection and Validation Workflow

The PAI process starts with data entry at the Gram Panchayat level and sequentially progresses through Block, District, and State levels, culminating in national submission via PAI portal. A feedback mechanism at each stage allows for the correction and resubmission of any discrepancies before proceeding.

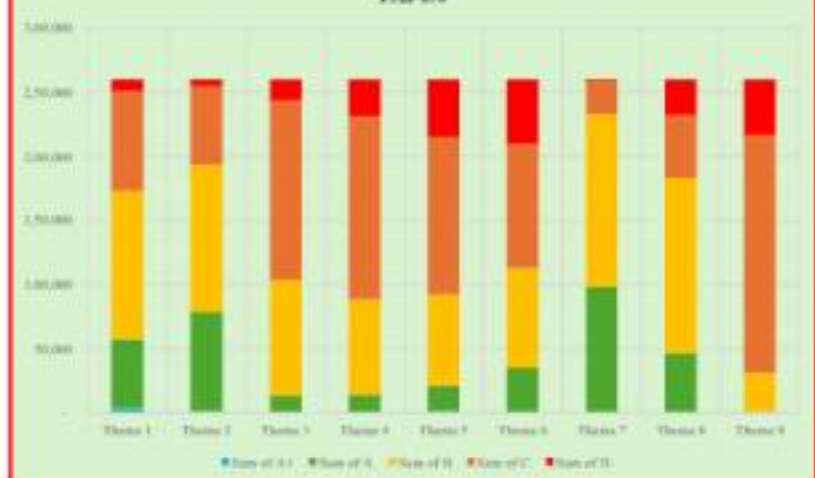

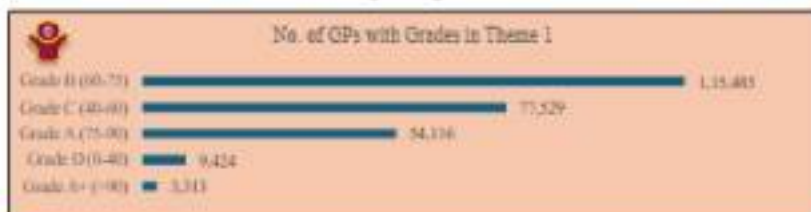

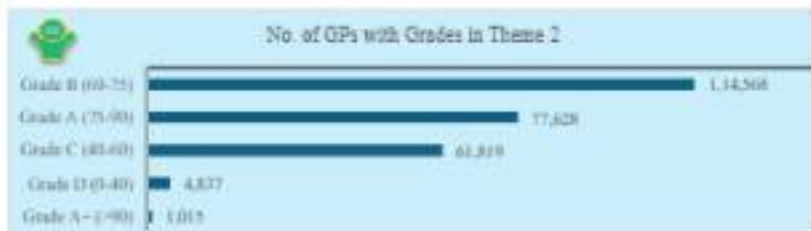

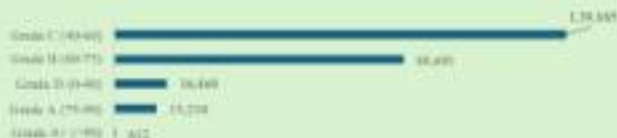

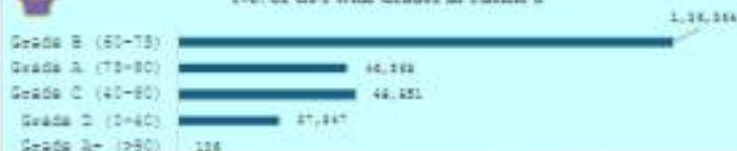

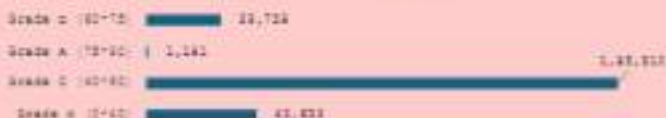

## 7.1 Panchayat Advancement Index Portal



The PAI Portal (<https://pai.gov.in>) is a digital platform designed to streamline workflows and enhance collaboration among the Ministry of Panchayati Raj (MoPR), state governments, and Panchayats at all levels - Gram, Block, and District. It allows stakeholders to access, contribute to, and analyze data from approximately 2.6 lakh Gram Panchayats, facilitating verification and validation with relevant line departments to ensure accuracy. The user-friendly portal serves as a comprehensive repository, enhancing accessibility to essential data, indicators, and thematic views while efficiently computing PAI scores.



PAI Portal features State Dashboard, Thematic Score Card, Gram Panchayat Score Card with the top performing Gram Panchayat/equivalent to GP within the State and best performing GP/equivalent to GP in 9 themes of LSDGs for public view & at different levels (State, District, Block, and GP). These features help the Gram Panchayat to analyze the status of different themes of LSDGs and empower the Panchayats for evidence based planning for rural development. The scorecard and other features also support in the policy level changes at different level.

### 8.1 Dissemination of PAI 1.0 FY 2022-23

Series of State Level Workshop/ Training have been organized with State Nodal Officers, State Nodal Departments, District & Block Officials, Technical Officers and State Master Trainers on significance of PAI for measuring the progress towards the attainment of SDGs; role of different stakeholders; flowchart of validation mechanism of PAI Data and functionality of PAI Portal. Intensive hands-on sessions are also provided to the States/UTs.

Ministry has issued advisories to the States/UTs for organizing dissemination workshops with Gram Panchayat, frontline workers of the line departments, officials of FRIs and other stakeholders at State, District and Block levels. The workshops focused on disseminating the PAI scores to the stakeholders of PAI and also to build the capacity of the Gram Panchayats (Equivalent to GPs) on analyzing the scores achieved in different themes of LEDGs and also developing understanding on the data accuracy at grassroots levels. States/UTs also advised to display the Score Card of GP in the Panchayat Bhavan, score card of best gram panchayats within block and district for wider dissemination of the PAI 1.0. During the dissemination workshops, Gram Panchayats have been felicitated by the State District for their performance in PAI 1.0.

### 3.2 Workshop for PAI 2.0 FY 2023-24

The Ministry has initiated Panchayat Advancement Index (PAI) 2.0 for FY 2023-24, focusing on rationalizing local indicators across nine LSDG themes to improve data accuracy and quality. It aims to enhance Gram Panchayat efficiency through simplified workflows and automatic data integration from national portals of relevant Ministries and Departments. PAI 2.0 FY 2023-24 has been launched on 26-27 May 2023 at New Delhi.

Similarly, Workshops/Seminars were organized at State, District and Block Levels on PAI 2.0. The workshops/training focused on the new features embedded on Portal, soft and validation checks; revised framework of local indicators with sources, granularity of data at Panchayat level etc. Training was provided to Functionaries, Technical Officers, and Officials of Line Departments of Gram Panchayat, Block and District Levels to improve the data accuracy and quality.

In the same line, a State-level Workshop was organized with respective State Nodal Officers from line departments, explaining the availability of the data at various field offices, its sources, and field verification officers of different line departments. The workshop aimed to configure the data points with concerned field offices of line departments.

**UTILITY OF PAI IN  
STRENGTHENING PRIs**

Recognizing its immense potential to transform grassroots governance, States/UTs have proactively institutionalized the use of Panchayat Advancement Index (PAI) as a central tool for local planning, monitoring, and performance assessment. PAI scores are being widely disseminated among stakeholders through structured workshops and capacity-building initiatives at the block, district, and state levels, enabling deeper understanding and adoption across tiers of governance. In a significant step towards transparency and citizen-centric governance, many Panchayats are publicly displaying their PAI scorecards outside office premises, fostering awareness, accountability, and community participation. Further, deliberations on PAI performance have been integrated into the agenda of Gram Sabha meetings, thereby strengthening participatory decision-making and social audit mechanisms.

States/UTs are increasingly leveraging PAI as an instrument for incentivization and targeted development. Several States/UTs have initiated the use of PAI scores for need-based allocation of additional financial and technical resources to Panchayats, ensuring that developmental gaps are addressed in a focused and equitable manner. Across the country, PAI is emerging as a critical enabler of evidence-based decentralized planning, assisting Panchayats in identifying priority sectors and aligning their Gram Panchayat Development Plans (GPDs) with measurable outcomes.

In a progressive move towards institutional learning and peer exchange, high-performing Gram Panchayats are being developed as Panchayat Learning Centers, facilitating exposure visits and knowledge sharing among Panchayat Raj Institutions (PRIs). This approach is fostering a culture of healthy competition, replication of best practices, and continuous improvement. Additionally, several States/UTs have integrated PAI performance with recognition frameworks, awards, and incentive mechanisms, further motivating Panchayats to enhance their developmental outcomes.

PAI is sustainable because it is embedded in regular Panchayat governance processes rather than functioning as a stand-alone IT intervention. Integration of PAI indicators with the evolving GPD framework will further enable weak indicators to be directly translated into planning actions, strengthening anticipatory and outcome-oriented governance.

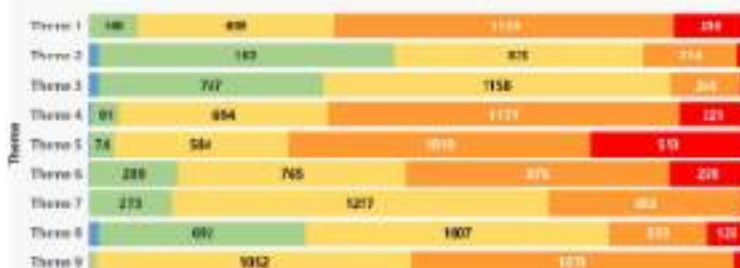

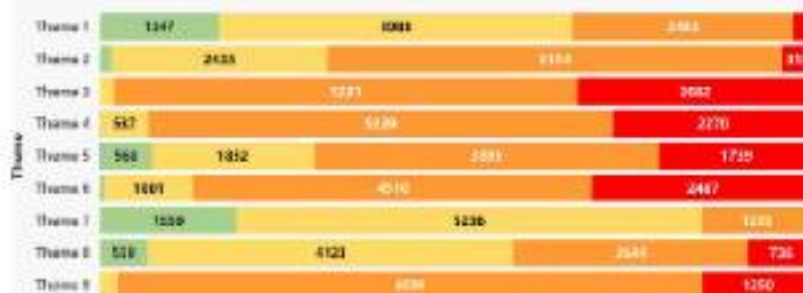

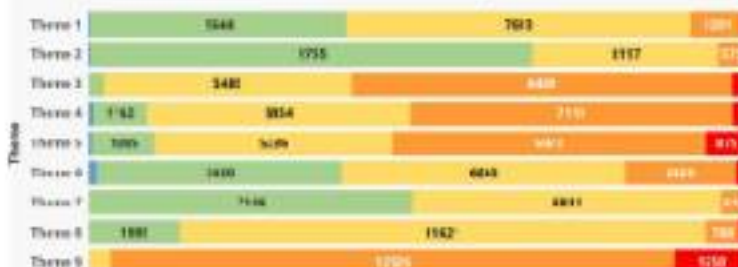

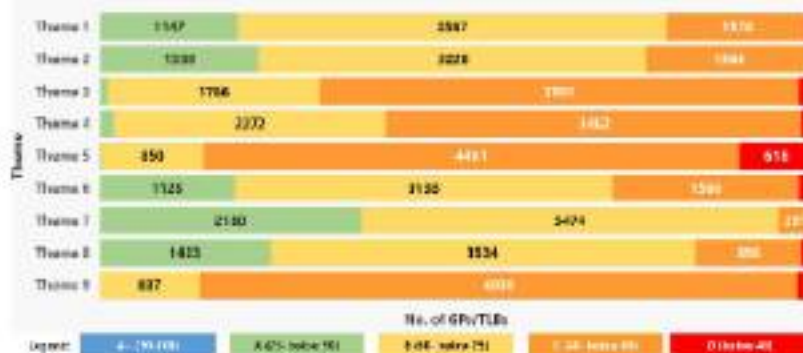

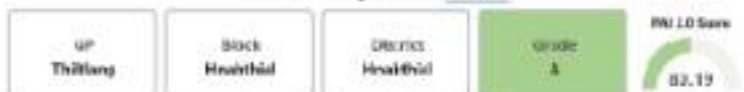

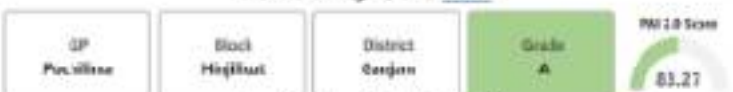

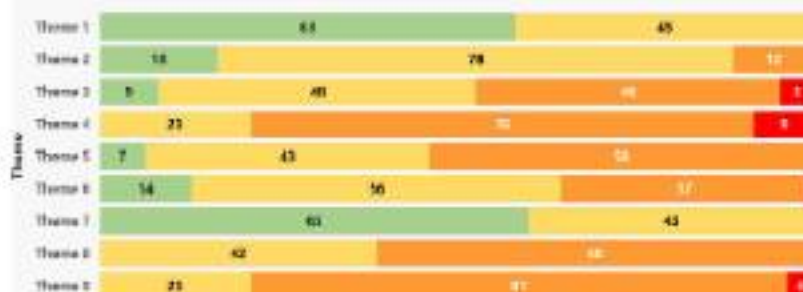

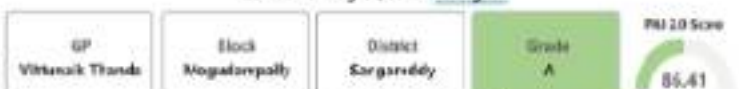

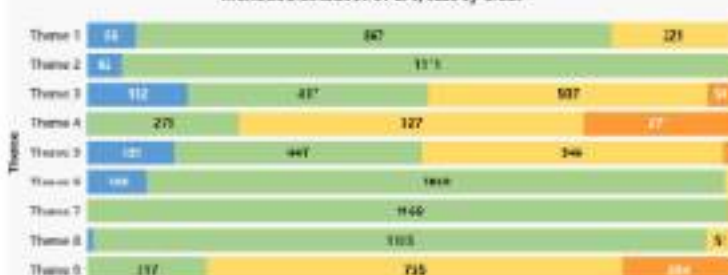
