

## **The historic occasion of the Hon'ble Prime Minister serving the country for the longest tenure as an elected Prime Minister**

Today, June 10, 2026, marks a historic and inspiring milestone in the journey of Indian democracy. **Today, Shri Narendra Modi Ji has become the Prime Minister to serve the country for the longest continuous tenure as an elected Prime Minister.** He has set a record of continuous service of 4,399 days as an elected PM—a feat achieved for the first time in the history of independent India. Earlier, Shri Jawaharlal Nehru had held this post continuously for 4398 days from 1952 to 1964.

**This occasion symbolizes the strength of India's democratic consciousness, public trust, and people's participation.** When a public representative lives by the resolve of 'Nation First', when he makes truth, integrity, hard work, honesty, and probity in life his guiding principles, and remaining steadfastly dedicated to serving the people—then the public bestows its blessings upon him in the form of unprecedented support. Today's historic moment is a reflection of that same public blessing.

This historic milestone of June 10, 2026, coincides with other significant achievements. The NDA government has completed 12 years under the Hon'ble Prime Minister's leadership. After taking oath as Prime Minister in 2014, he called himself “Pradhan Sevak” in the Central Hall of Parliament. He had described the country's Constitution as a holy book and also said that his government is dedicated to the poor. Making the mantra of Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas as the motto of the government, the last 12 years have been an expression of these resolutions.

**Under the leadership of the Prime Minister, India has placed the welfare of the poor at the centre of governance.** For the first time, facilities like concrete houses, electricity, gas connections, pure drinking water, toilets etc. reached crores of people of the country on such a large scale. For the first time, bank accounts were opened for

For the first time, more than 80 crore citizens got the facility of free ration and for the first time, more than 60 crore poor people got the assurance of free treatment up to Rs 5 lakh. The result of this was that more than 25 crore people were able to overcome poverty.

**The Prime Minister considers youth power as India's biggest asset.** Under his guidance, skill development, Startup India, innovation, digital economy, sports, entrepreneurship and fitness have received unprecedented thrust. In the last 12 years, India has become the third largest start-up ecosystem in the world and now our country is also emerging as a major sports power in the world. India has also showcased its growing scientific capabilities to the world by hoisting the tricolor on the south pole of the Moon under Mission Chandrayaan.

**Inspired by the Prime Minister, a new chapter of women-led development has been added to India's development journey in the last 12 years.** Under his guidance, the government has consistently placed the nation's women at the core of its policies. Be it toilet facilities, smoke-free kitchens, financial assistance during pregnancy, Mudra Yojana, PM Awas in the name of women, Lakhpati Didi Abhiyan, a complete support system has been developed for the women of the country at every stage of life, from birth till the last moments of life. By providing 33 percent reservation to women in the Lok Sabha and Legislative Assemblies, an effort has been made to further increase their participation in the policy making of the country.

Our farmers constitute one of the key pillars of the 'Viksit Bharat' (Developed India) envisioned by the Honorable Prime Minister. In the last 12 years, many such steps have been taken like providing new variety seeds to farmers, completing many incomplete irrigation projects, giving PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, increasing MSP and increasing government procurement. Unprecedented work has been done, particularly for small farmers, animal herders, and fishermen. Lakhs of people are benefiting from the Hon'ble PM's decision to extend Kisan Credit Cards to animal herders and fishermen. Today, India's agricultural exports have increased from Rs 2 lakh 60 thousand crores in the year 2014 to Rs 4 lakh 40 thousand crores. Today India's agricultural exports have crossed the Rs 5 lakh crore mark. **This is a clear impact of the Hon'le PM's policies related to farmer welfare.**

**The Prime Minister has given a new dimension to national security, has given it a new height. The credit for taking firm measures against terrorism goes entirely to his leadership.** For the first time, surgical strikes were carried out on cross-border terrorist camps. Due to the efforts of the Prime Minister, more than 170 countries united and the United Nations declared June 21 as International Yoga Day.
