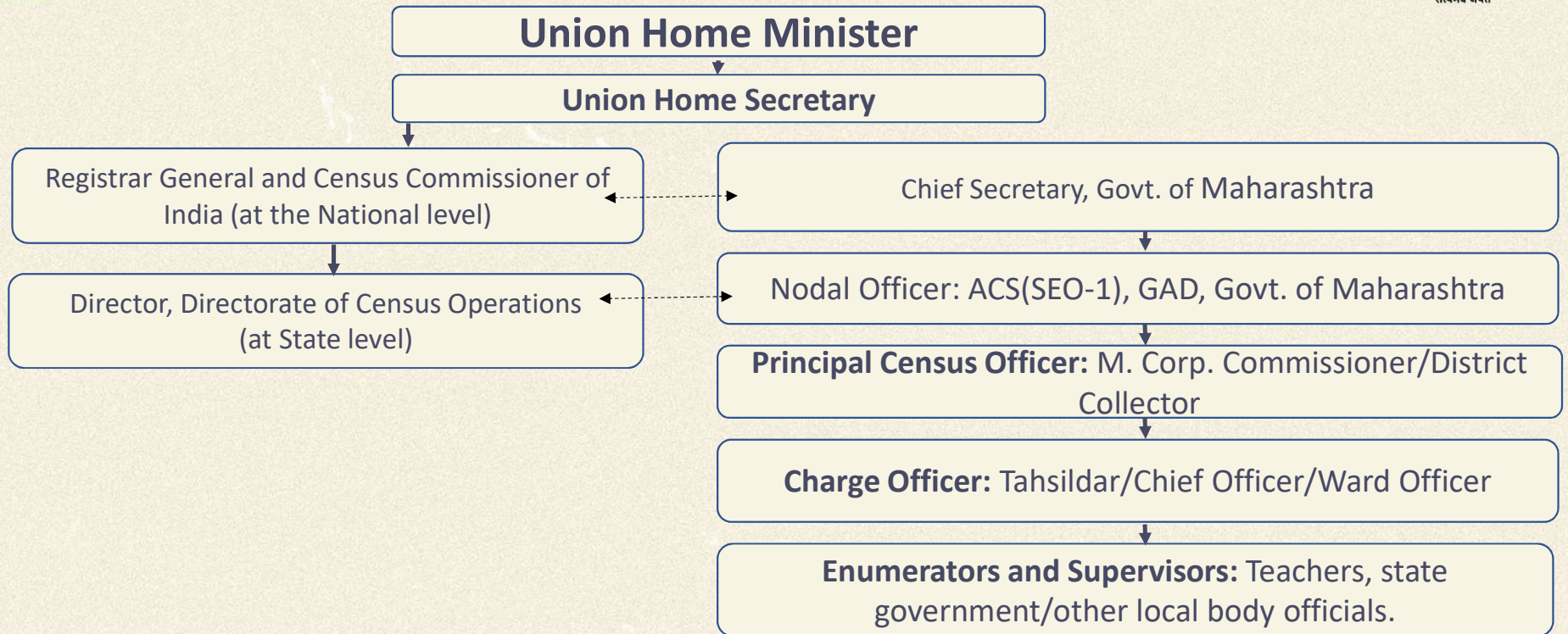
Census – Background



- Census is a Union subject and is listed at serial number 69 in the Seventh Schedule of the Constitution
- Legal framework: Census Act, 1948 and the Census Rules, 1990
 - Individual data is kept confidential under section 15 of Census Act
- Census is conducted in collaboration with State Government of Maharashtra
- Last Census conducted in 2011
- Census 2027, 16th Census in the series and 8th since independence

Reference Date and Phases of Census 2027



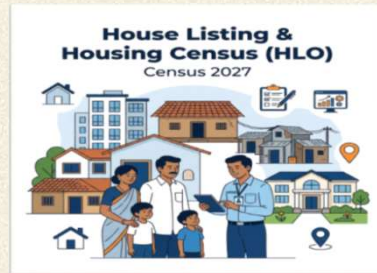
Census Reference Date: 00:00 hrs. March 1, 2027 (For UT of Ladakh and Snow-Bound areas of UT of Jammu & Kashmir and States of Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand, **00:00 hrs. October 1, 2026**)

Census – 2027 will be conducted in two phases:

Phase 1: House Listing and Housing Census (HLO)

Self-Enumeration: 1st May to 15th May, 2026
House-listing Operations: 16th May to 14th June, 2026

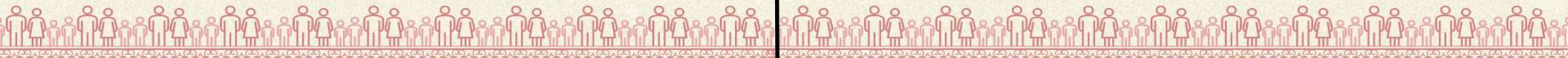
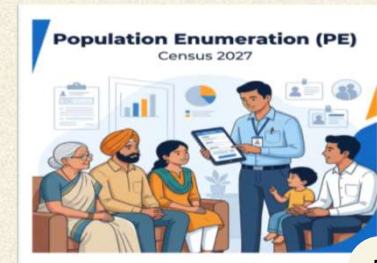
Provides data on housing conditions, amenities available and assets possessed by households. Provide frame for Phase 2 of Census



Phase 2: Population Enumeration (PE)

Self-Enumeration: To be notify later
Population Enumeration: February, 2027

Provides data on various demographic, socio-cultural and economic parameters along with migration and fertility characteristics of individuals from each household.

Census 2027- GoI Notifications



- Gazette Notification for intent of Census-2027 issued on 16.06.2025
- The notification for the period of 1st phase issued on 07.01.2026
 - Houselisting Operations – 30 days between April - September, 2026
 - Self Enumeration: 15-day time period just before Houselisting Operations of 30 days
- Questions of 1st phase notified on 22.01.2026
- Notifications for the period and questions of the 2nd Phase will be published in due course
 - Caste Enumeration will be done during second phase of Census



Census 2027- GoM Notifications



- Gazette Notification for intent of Census-2027 republished on 30.06.2025
- Census officers appointed at all Administrative levels of the State vide General Administration Department's GR dated 23.12.2025. Gazette notification also published on this matter on 23.12.2025.
- Questions of 1st phase notified on 16.02.2026
- The notification for the period of first phase issued on 26.02.2026
 - **Self Enumeration**: 15-days between 01.05.2026 to 15.05.2026
 - **House-listing Operations** – 30 days between 16.05.2026 to 14.06.2026

Census 2027 - Preparations



- Union Cabinet approved a total outlay of ₹11,718.24 crore for the Census on 12th December 2025
- [Administrative units](#) frozen as on 01.01.2026
- Pre-test for Phase-1 was conducted in all States/UTs in November 2025
- State Level Census Coordination Committee meeting held under the chairpersonship of Hon'ble Chief Secretary, Govt. of Maharashtra on 3rd February, 2026
- State Government of Maharashtra has appointed Census officers at all administrative levels vide its GR dated 23rd December, 2025.



Census 2027 - Preparations



- Instruction manuals for Phase-1 prepared in 3 languages viz. Marathi, Hindi and English for the State.
- Training of Census Functionaries in progress. As per the training cascade, 1st phase of state-level training i.e. 141 Master trainers' training is completed at YASHADA, Pune and these Master Trainers imparted training to 3,850 Field Trainers in the next stage. At the last phase of training, Enumerators & Supervisors training is under progress at Charge level in which Field trainers will be imparting training and it is completed by 8th May, 2026.
- Methodology and guidelines in the form of Circulars issued to Census functionaries to maintain uniformity and smooth conduct of Census across the State
- Time bound calendar of activities for intensive monitoring

Census 2027 is being conducted through digital means

- Data will be collected through Mobile App
- Option for Self-Enumeration will also be there for the public
- A web-based portal to manage and monitor various activities of Census-2027
- House Listing Block (HLB) Creation through web mapping application



Data Collection Through Mobile Apps



- Mobile Apps Both Android and iOS
 - [Marathi, Hindi and other 14 languages](#)
 - Provision for offline data collection
- Enumerators/Supervisors to use their own mobile devices
- In-built data validation checks

Self-Enumeration (SE)

<https://se.census.gov.in>



- SE portal will be available in 16 languages
- Respondent logs into the SE Portal by entering the Mobile Number & other details
- Once the respondent has filled all the questions, SE ID will be generated and sent to the registered mobile number of the respondent
- This SE ID is to be handed over to the enumerator during the field visit by the Self Enumerated household
- After confirming the self-enumeration data, the enumerator will include it in the original database.

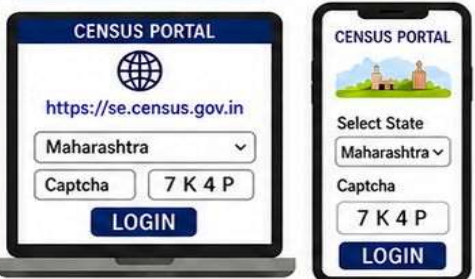

- Select Maharashtra and enter the captcha to log in.

- Census Enumerator will visit your home (16th May - 14th June, 2026)
- Share your SE ID with them.

ID MATCHING OUTCOMES

- If details match → data is confirmed
- If not → enumerator will collect data again

- Use accurate and final information (some fields cannot be edited later).
- Keep your mobile phone handy for OTP.
- Carefully mark your exact location on the map.
- Review everything before final submission.
- Your information is secure and used only for Census purposes.



Census 2027 - Data Security



- End to End data security - on mobile; during data transmission and at server level
- Secure data protection mechanism
- Security audits by reputed agencies
- Data Centres declared as Critical Information Infrastructure (CII)
- Data Centers ISO/IEC 27001:2022 certified



Training of Census Functionaries



- Critically important for ensuring quality of data
- Training of State, District, Charge Officers and Enumerators/Supervisors for both phases separately
- More than 5,000 training batches across the state for each phase
