- Sewerage treatment plants with capacity of 2,360 million litre per day added
- 350 projects grounded and around 4100 hectare of green space and parks developed
- AMRUT 2.0 launched on 1st October, 2021 with the aim of making cities 'water secure'

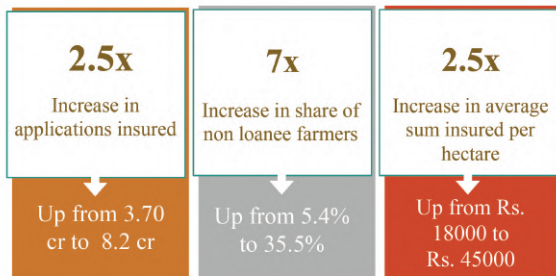

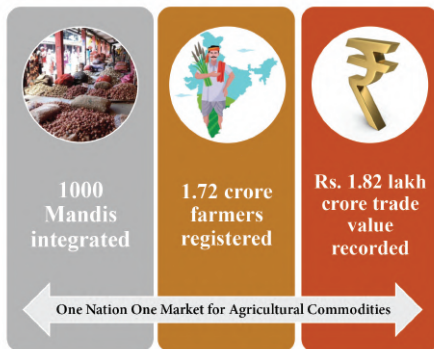

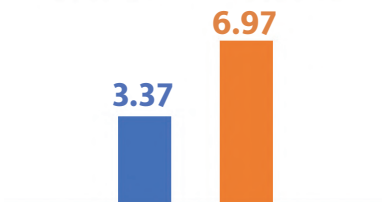

Total Expenditure Doubled since 2013-14

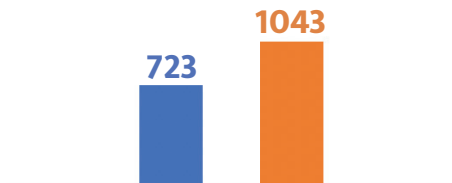

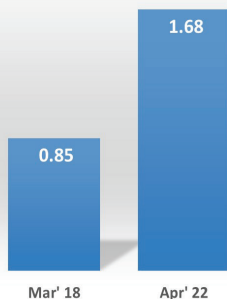
Fastest growing despite pandemic

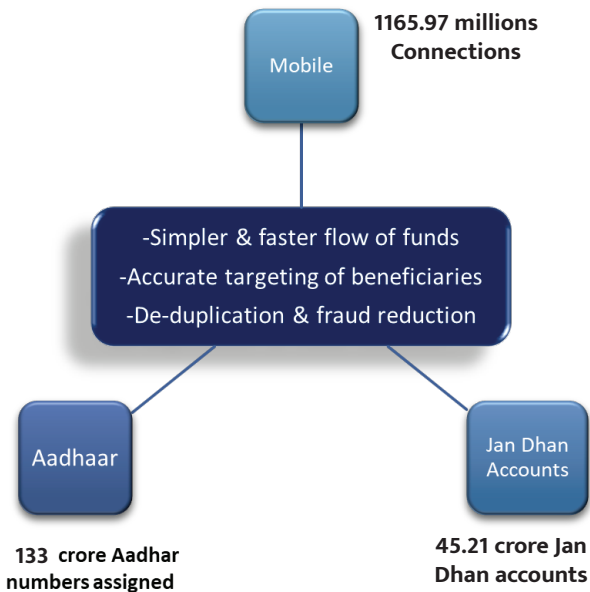

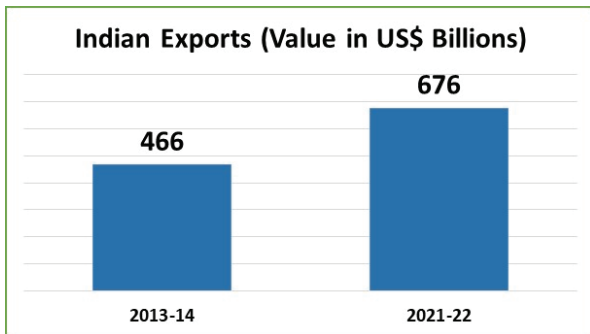

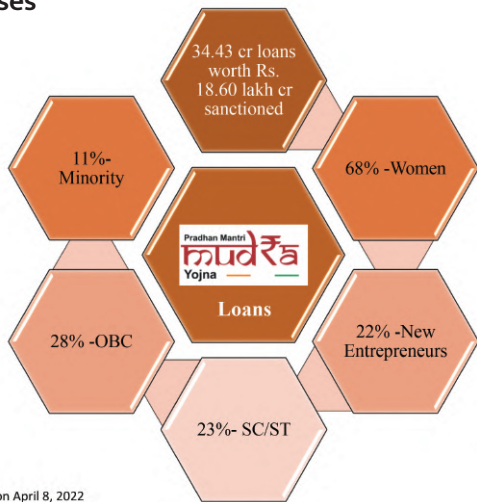

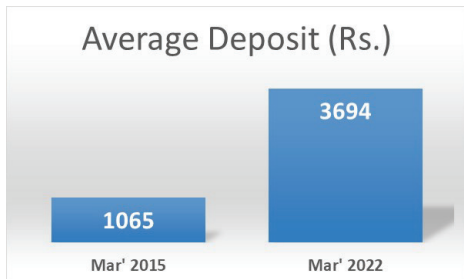

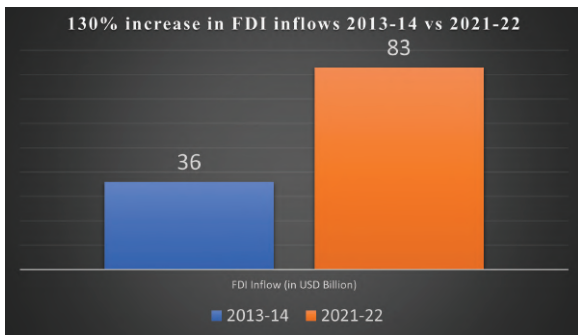


#EODBINDIA

In last 8 years an all-out effort of Government of India ensured ease of doing of business in the country. There has been a paradigm shift through simplification of various laws and regulations with emphasis on transparency and reducing compliance requirements.

- **Freedom from the Burden of Laws:** 2007 trade-related laws or barriers abolished. 25,000 compliances were terminated.
- **Decriminalisation of Company Law:** In 2017, Company Act was amended and several provisions were decriminalized and treated as civil errors.
- **Reduced tax burden on companies:** Direct tax in domestic companies has been reduced from 30 percent plus surcharge to 25.17 percent with surcharge and cess.

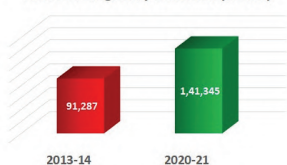

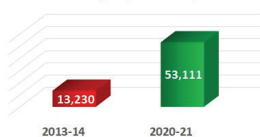

National Highway Network (in KM)



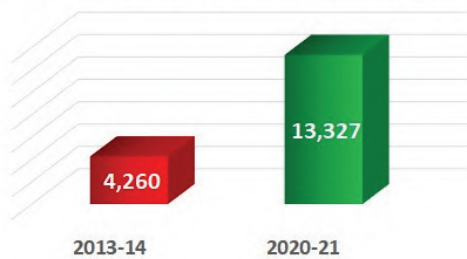

Capital Expenditure on Road & Bridges (in Crores)



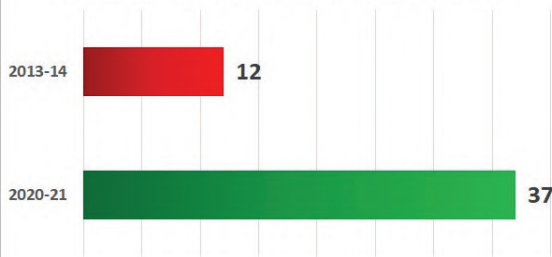

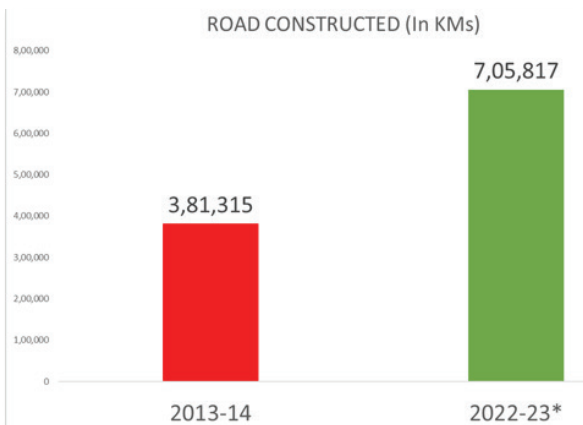

Boosting Infrastructure in the Northeast

- Prime Minister Development Initiative for North East (P M - D e v I N E) announced in the 2022-23 budget; Initial allocation of Rs 1,500 crore made.



- Ro-Ro service started on the Brahmaputra river between Dhubri and Hathsingimari, Nematia and Kamalabari and Guwahati and North Guwahati.
- 121 tunnels with length of 146.559 km are under construction and 25 tunnels with the length of 18.628 km are under operation in the NER.
- Boguebil Rail-cum-Road Bridge over river

Brahmaputra near Borgeebil with link lines on North & South Banks (Length-73 km) – in the State of Assam- was completed in December, 2018- at an estimated costs of Rs. 5920 crore.

- The North East has been kept as a priority area under RCS-UDAN. Under the scheme various RCS route like Imphal-Dimapur; Shillong-Kolkata; Dimapur-Guwahati; Kolkata-Lilabari; Guwahati-Lilabari; Shillong-Kolkata etc. commenced.
- A number of Hydro Electric Power Projects like Tuirial, Pare and Kameng have been constructed in various places in the NorthEast.

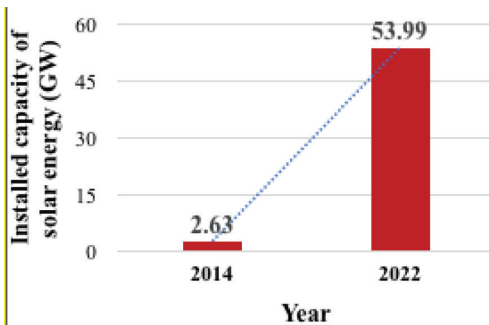


Massive Increase in Renewable Energy

- Renewable energy (RE) installed capacity increased 286% in last 7.5 years
- India now at 4th position globally for installed RE capacity

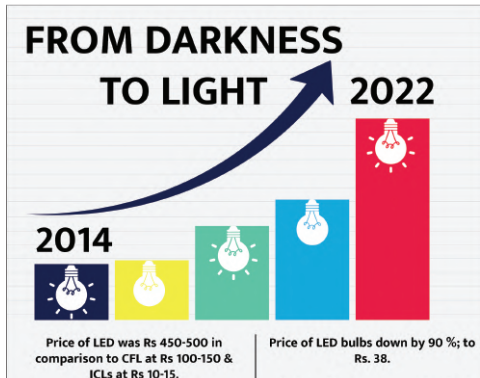
- Solar capacity increased from 2.6 GW to over 53 GW between 2014 and March 2022; solar park scheme doubled from 20 GW to 40 GW; record low solar tariff at Rs 1.99/unit achieved
- National Hydrogen Mission launched on August 15, 2021 to aid production of 5 million tonnes of green hydrogen fuel by 2030

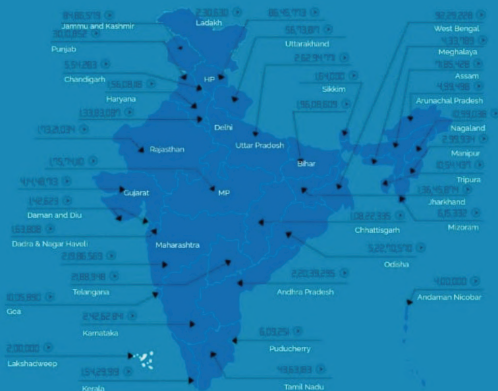

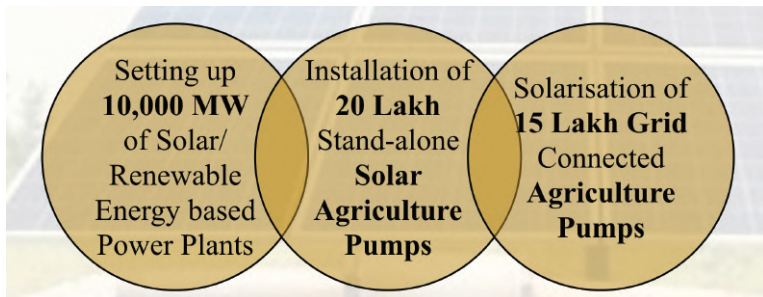

- Providing energy to 35 lakh+ farmers by solarising agriculture pumps

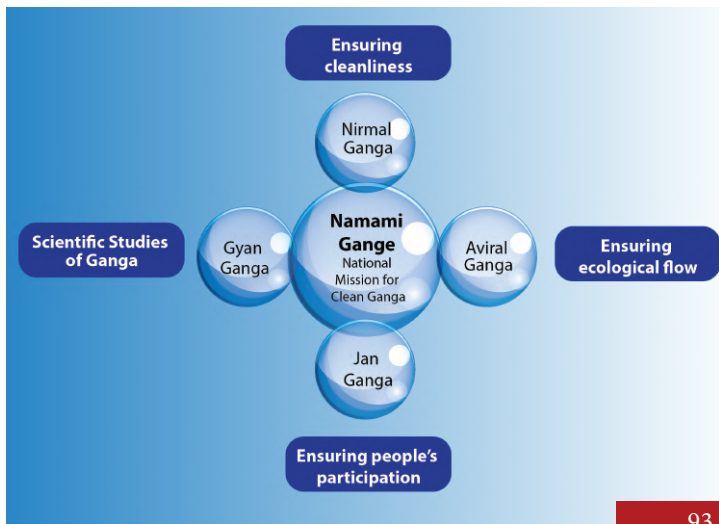


One Sun, One World and One Grid

- India pledges to become a net-zero emitter in terms of carbon emissions by 2070
- International Solar Alliance launched in November 2015, to increase deployment of solar energy technologies in 108 countries
- Installed solar capacity is 53.99 GW as of March 31, 2022
- Efforts are on to create a global grid to realize the concept of One Sun, One World, and One Grid

Namami Gange

- Launched in 2014 for effective abatement of pollution, conservation and rejuvenation of National River Ganga
- So far a total of 364 projects have been sanctioned at an estimated cost of Rs 30,853 crore; 183 projects completed and made operational

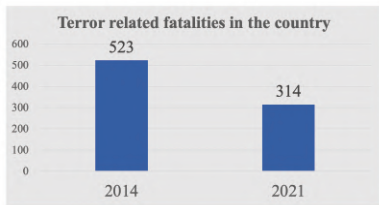
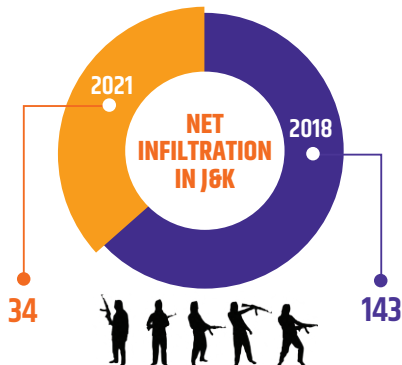

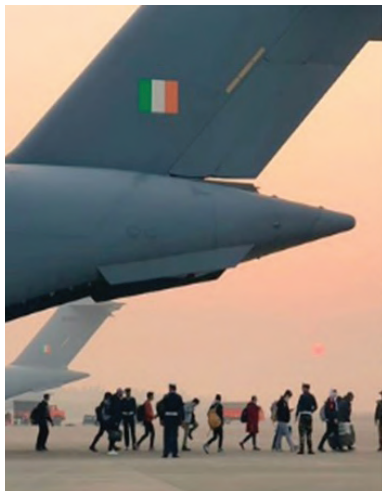
