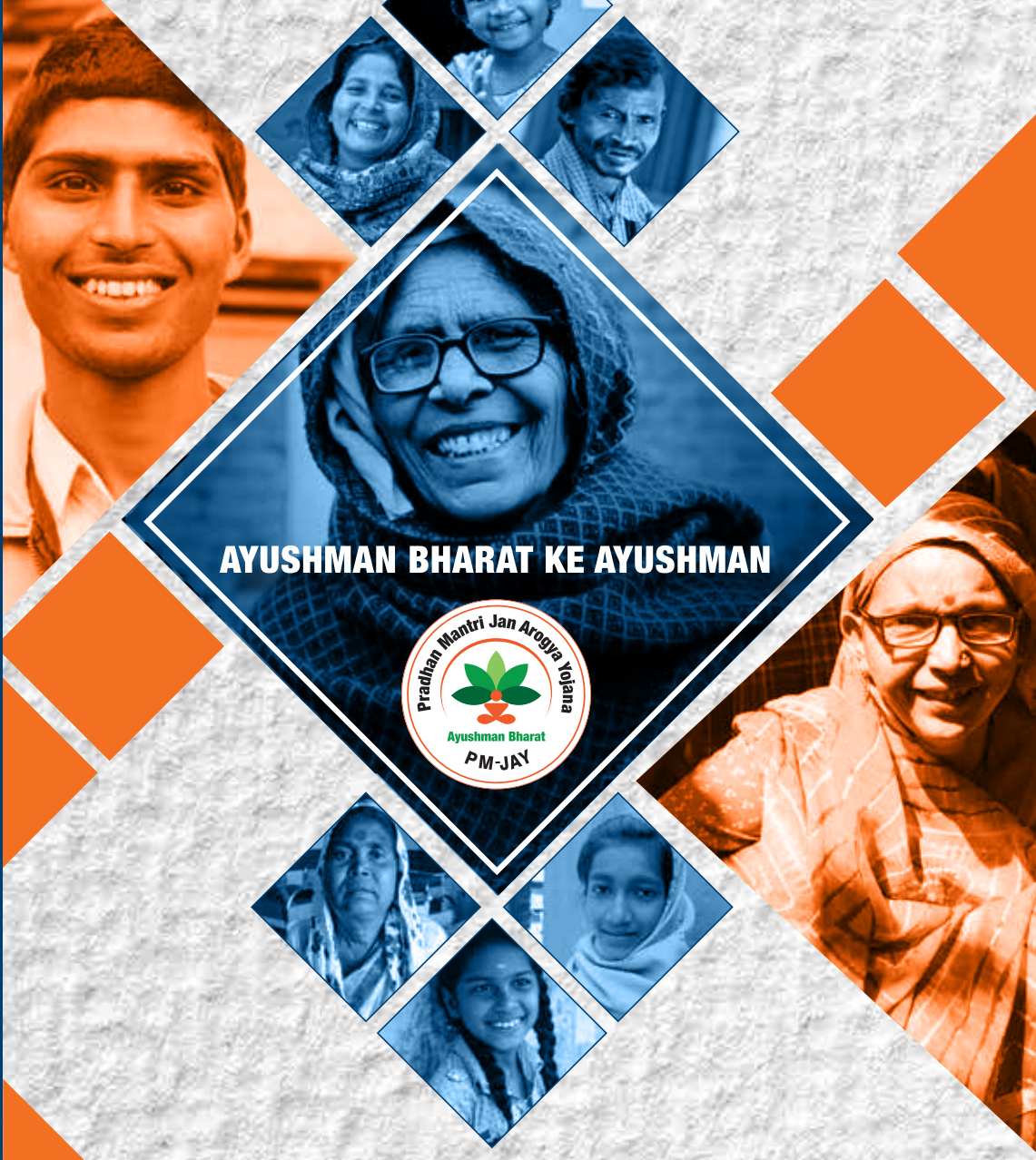

Medical Case Summary: Myocardial infarction/PTCA with stenting of LAD and RCA. The patient admitted with left sided chest pain with sweating at G B Pant Hospital, Port Blair. He also had Diabetes Mellitus. Investigations revealed Acute Anterior Wall MI. He was stabilized with medical management and later referred to cardiologist in mainland for further expert management.

Success Story: Since there is no treatment facility for Cardiology ailments in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, all the patients with Cardiovascular related treatment travel to mainland India and avail treatment in cities like Kolkata and Chennai. But for Ratan and his family, it seemed like a distant dream as they did not have enough money. However, the knowledge of cashless insurance scheme brought a new ray of hope in Ratan's life, who was then able to get the prescribed treatment for free.

2. STATE: Andhra Pradesh

Medical Case Summary: The patient complained of chest pain and dyspnea. The family rushed him to a hospital where investigations (Angiogram) revealed blockage in the coronary arteries of the heart. He underwent a coronary bypass surgery at the hospital.

Success Story:

Suribabu hails from a poor family in the rural area of East Godavari in Andhra Pradesh. Even though the investigations revealed the problem, his family didn't have enough money for his treatment. As soon as the family came to know about PM-JAY, Suribabu was able to avail the scheme benefits. He underwent a complex surgery at no cost. He is now in a stable condition and is very grateful that PM-JAY exists.

Medical Case Summary: Patient had a history of head injury. At the time of admission, he was in agonizing pain and semiconscious. He was admitted at GMCH, Kamrup Metro Hospital. Post detailed investigations he was diagnosed with Subdural haematoma which was operated (Neurosurgery>Cranioplasty–Exogenous Graft) successfully.

Success Story: Kalita is a Paddy farmer by occupation. He had suffered a head injury and needed surgery. Since his economic condition was not too strong, it seemed impossible for his poor family to bear the treatment expenses. He was later informed about PM-JAY under which he could undergo the prescribed treatment for free. He feels that the scheme is a blessing for poor people like him.

4. STATE: Bihar

Medical Case Summary: Patient fell down from the roof and injured her head, left shoulder and arm. She was in agonizing pain and was unable to move at the time of admission. Post detailed investigations she was diagnosed with Subdural haematoma, which was operated upon successfully.

Success Story: Saloni, a 16-year-old patient fell from the roof of her house in her village and suffered from serious head injury. Initially, she was admitted in Sadar Hospital, Buxar, however was soon shifted to Patna Medical College and Hospital (PMCH) as she developed complications. She initially did not get the attention in the Neurosurgery department. The case was then brought to knowledge of State Health Agency (SHA) and with SHA's intervention, PMCH immediately took cognizance and performed neurosurgery for brain hematoma on the patient. The surgery was successful, and it also became a success story for the hospital.

5. STATE: Chandigarh

Disease Name: Electrical contact burns: Low voltage - without part of limb/limb loss; Includes TBSA, skin grafting, flap cover, follow-up dressings etc. as deemed necessary; Surgical procedures were required for deep burns that are not amenable to heal with dressings alone.

Medical Case Summary: Electricity burn near umbilical area.

Success Story: Karamvir, alongwith his family was living in Kacchi Colony no.4 in Chandigarh. One day he got electrocuted and fell unconscious. He was rushed to the nearby hospital where he was given first aid and referred to GMSH-16. At GMSH, after initial treatment, the doctors referred him to PGIMER. The incident came as a big blow to the family which had recently lost their 26 year old son. Timely and free treatment provided to Karamvir at PGIMER under PM-JAY prevented more out of pocket expenditure which the family would have otherwise incurred.

Medical Case Summary: Sanjay Vargem 21 years old, male patient was admitted on 14/02/2019 of Chest pain, Palpitation, Vertigo, Cough and shortness of breathing due to excretion for 1-2 years, patient was thoroughly investigated and diagnosed as severe AS/AR and double valve replacement done on 18/02/2019.

Success Story: Sanjay was suffering from severe body when he visited the hospital. After examination, he was diagnosed with heart ailment and was advised surgery. Since he belonged to a very poor family, he could not afford the treatment prescribed by the doctor. As a result, he and his family returned to their village and lost hope. But soon after they returned, they got to know about PM-JAY, which came as a boon to Sanjay and his family. The surgery which would otherwise cost him 2 Lakh Rupees was conducted for free under PM-JAY. He is now relieved from the pain and is leading a happier and healthier life.

7. STATE: Dadra and Nagar Haveli

Medical Case Summary: The patient had an episode of severe chest pain with uneasiness and discomfort. On examination, he was diagnosed with a cardiac disease for which angioplasty was advised. The procedure involved relieving the blockages in the heart vessels. It was performed successfully on the patient.

Success Story: It was a sudden pain in chest, when Rajnikant Patel, resident of Kudacha, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and an auto driver by profession was taken to Shri Vinoba Bhawe Civil Hospital, Silvassa where he was diagnosed with Myocardial infarction. Doctors suggested referral to higher center for angioplasty. But due to his family condition and high cost of treatment, all family members were worried. Fortunately, he had Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana e-card with him. After being referred to Tristar Hospital, Surat, he got admitted and underwent angioplasty which was covered under PM-JAY.

Medical Case Summary: The patient came with a history of Chest pain. He was advised a Coronary Angiography (CAG) which revealed Triple vessel disease. He was then advised to undergo a Coronary Artery Bypass Graft (CABG) and was admitted for this procedure.

Success Story: Ravindra, a resident of Daman, is a retired person with no income and is dependent on his son. He suffered from anginal pain and was admitted to Government Hospital where on further investigation, he was referred to a private hospital at Surat for Angiography. It was found that he had severe blockage in all the three major coronary arteries and would need surgery. He and his family were worried about the expenses they would have to bear for his treatment. Under PM-JAY, his treatment was done free of cost. Had he not been a PM-JAY beneficiary, his family would have gone under debt to get him the required treatment. He and his family feels that the scheme is a savior for them and for many others like them.

Medical Case Summary: Patient had a history of hypertension. She complained of sudden chest pain on 24/5/19 & was admitted in U. N. Mehta Hospital. She underwent angiography and was diagnosed with triple vessels blockage and weak heart valves.

She was operated for Cardiac Bypass surgery with Mitral valve repair in the hospital.

Success Story:

Shakriben Sharma, a widow and a mother of two, had hypertension and was under medication to keep a check on her health. Her two labourer sons did not have a regular income and so visiting a hospital and getting a proper treatment was never an option. It was only after an ASHA Worker of Gujarat, Renaben met her family & got the family enrolled under AB PM-JAY, that Shakriben and her sons became a little medical conscious. So when Shakriben complained of sudden chest pain, she was rushed to U N Mehta Hospital in Ahmedabad district, where she underwent Bypass Surgery. She had never imagined that it would be such a seamless process.

Medical Case Summary: Patient has had non-healing mouth ulcers since a long time. He was taken to a hospital where he was diagnosed with oral cancer. He underwent radiation therapy and chemotherapy as a part of the treatment.

Success Story: Jagatsingh Lalsingh Chauhan, a resident of Aravalli district, Gujarat, received his PM-JAY e-card during the village level Health Camp. He had been suffering from a lot due to ulcers in his mouth for a long time. Getting card gave him the confidence to visit the hospital for further investigations. At Apollo hospital in Gandhinagar, the doctor informed him that he had Oral Cancer.

Since his family did not have enough savings and cancer is an expensive treatment, he almost gave up hope but then he remembered that PM-JAY card may offer free chemotherapy treatment. He was delighted to get prompt help that saved him and gave him a new life.

Success Story: Kavita had been suffering from lower abdominal pain and on hospitalization was advised to undergo Laparotomy. Since, she belonged to a very poor family and had limited financial resources, it was almost impossible for her to undergo the prescribed treatment. However, as soon as she got know about PM-JAY, she went to the hospital and underwent Omentomy with Bilateral Salpingo-oophorectomy.

Medical Case Summary: The parents of the child belong to a rural family of Haryana. At full term she was taken to the hospital, however due to certain complications at the time of delivery, the doctor advised to undergo Caesarean delivery to save mother and child.

Success Story: Karishma was about to be born in a small family in Haryana, when doctors realized that delivering her was getting complicated. As a result they advised her parents to undergo caesarean deliver. Since the family was very poor and did not have enough money, the doctor informed them about the recently launched PM-JAY scheme. As a result, the father immediately made efforts to check his entitlement for the benefits under the scheme. To his relief, he was a beneficiary. Karishma was born as a healthy baby. PM-JAY came as a savior to both Karishma and her mother. Karishma was the first child birth under PM-JAY. The family is thankful to the PM for supporting them through this novel scheme and giving them a new life.

Medical Case Summary: Patient was a known case of symptomatic sick sinus syndrome (SSS) (cardiac arrhythmia). The earlier pacemaker that she had, showed End of Life indicators on examination in the hospital. She was therefore admitted for her pacemaker replacement. A permanent pacemaker implantation was done.

Success Story: Leela was suffering from cardiac complications and was unable to avail quality tertiary treatment from a reputable hospital. The cost of permanent pacemaker implantation and pulse generator replacement was very high which she couldn't have afforded. PM-JAY supported her in availing free treatment for this procedure which was necessary as her earlier device showed end of life indications. The treatment has drastically improved her quality of life. She is thankful to PM-JAY for empowering her to avail free of cost quality treatment.

14. STATE: Jammu & Kashmir

Medical Case Summary: Patient Vikas Kumar was admitted at AIIMS, New Delhi on 27.02.2019. He was a known case of Osteosarcoma (Bone tumor). The doctor advised him an X-ray and MRI of Right Knee with thigh. Later as per the investigation reports, the surgeon decided to perform Tumor resection surgery & Endoprosthesis for the treatment of the patient. The patient underwent the surgery on 02.03.2019 and was later discharged in a stable condition from the hospital on 08.03.2019.

Success Story: Vikas Kumar from Jammu hails from a very poor family. He was diagnosed with Bone Tumor in his right leg and was advised by the doctors in Jammu to undergo surgery. However, due to his family's poor financial status and the high cost involved in the surgery, he was not able to undergo treatment. One day an ASHA worker of his village informed his father about the AB PM-JAY scheme. Once he came to know about the scheme, he immediately went with his son Vikas to one of the empaneled hospital to inquire about the scheme and also about whether he is eligible for treatment under the scheme. Upon confirmation of his eligibility, he was immediately issued a card. Post issuance, Vikas got admitted in AIIMS, New Delhi to undergo surgery for Bone Tumor in his leg. The surgery and treatment cost for his ailment, borne by the government under PM-JAY scheme, was more than Rs. 1 Lakh, something which Vikas and his family would not have been able to afford on their own.

Medical Case Summary: She was suffering from pain in lower abdomen, it was a sudden onset of progressive pain. Ovarian tumor was diagnosed after investigation (USG & CT scan). The patient was admitted on 15 June 2019 in Ganga Memorial Hospital & Research Centre, Jamshedpur and procedure of Ovarian Cystectomy was conducted. She was discharged on 27 June 2019. The patient was treated for a tumor weighing 39.6 kilograms.

Success Story: Dasi Karmakar was carrying a tumor weighing 39.6 kilograms inside her, though she herself weighs only 35 kilograms. She has been carrying this tumor for 22 years. As the size of the tumor increased, it became difficult for her to carry out basic household activities. She visited many hospitals in the past, however, the treatment was unaffordable. After the launch of Ayushman Bharat, a neighbor informed her of the scheme and she was finally admitted in Ganga Memorial Hospital & Research Centre, Jamshedpur, where she underwent surgery. She is now healthy and recovering.

Medical Case Summary: The patient belongs to Udupi district of Karnataka. He was suffering from early fatigue and was having difficulty in breathing. He complained of chest pain and was taken to Kasturba hospital, Manipal. At the hospital he underwent investigations including Angiography. He was diagnosed with coronary artery disease and advised PTCA. He underwent Coronary Angioplasty with two Drug Eluting Stents. The patient recovered well and was discharged in a stable condition.

Success Story: Gajanana had a sudden episode of chest pain and was diagnosed with coronary artery disease at the hospital after appropriate investigations. Given the cost of the treatment and his poor financial state he could not have afforded it in a private hospital. As soon as he came to know of his eligibility for free treatment under PM-JAY, he underwent surgery. All his investigations, treatment and medications were covered free of cost under PM-JAY.

Success Story: 68 years old Leelamma Jose from Attappadi rural area of Palakkad district, one of the most backward rural areas, in Kerala, was suffering from severe pain and disability in her knees for the last two years. Her movements were restricted because of the pain, she was unable to sit, stand or walk for long. She was diagnosed with Bilateral knee osteoarthritis. After getting the KASP/AB PM-JAY card she approached Government Tribal Specialty Hospital, where she consulted a doctor who performed Total Knee Replacement to bring her back to a normal life. The surgery was successfully performed and now she is completely relieved from knee pain and discomfort. Overall quality of Leelamma's life has improved with the support of PM-JAY/KASP.

Medical Case Summary: The patient had Dysnoea on Exertion (difficulty in breathing) class IV. He was admitted in Chirayu Cardiac Centre (Chirayu Medical College & Hospital, Bhopal) on 18-02-19 and ECHO was performed. ECHO showed Rheumatic Heart Disease with severe Aortic Stenosis, dilated ascending aorta with aortic arch, aortic root and annulus. The patient was advised and underwent successful Aortic valve replacement surgery (Bental procedure) and Aortic Arch Replacement Surgery in March 2019. He recovered uneventfully and was discharged in a stable & satisfactory condition from the hospital.

Success Story: Husain is the head of his family from Chhindwara district of Madhya Pradesh. Few months ago, he suffered from severe pain in his heart. After that he was taken to the District Hospital, Chhindwara where the doctor suggested him to undergo heart surgery costing around Rs 2.7 lakhs. Hussain is a butcher by profession and did not have the required money. With the help of Ayushman Mitra at the hospital, he received the information about AB-PMJAY and got his Golden Card made. He then went to Chirayu Medical College & Hospital- Bhopal. He underwent surgery there with the help of PM-JAY golden card without of any cost. He was satisfied with the treatment given to him and is stable now.

Interest Area : Mr Vitsu loves working with his hands- fixing things like mechanical works for cars and fixing, repairing electronics.

Medical Case Summary: Patient had complaints of throat pain and difficulty in swallowing for 6 months. Biopsy from nasopharynx was done. The biopsy report revealed squamous cell carcinoma of oropharynx, stage IV B. He underwent chemotherapy followed by concurrent chemo – radiation.

Success Story: The beneficiary was diagnosed of carcinoma oropharynx and was referred for treatment outside the State. Due to financial constraints, he opted to take treatment within the State. He came to know about the PM-JAY scheme through his doctor in Christian Institute Health Sciences & Research (CIHSR), Nagaland. Without PM-JAY, it would have been almost impossible for him to undergo prescribed treatment and to arrange the amount required for the treatment.

24. STATE: Puducherry

Medical Case Summary: The patient had severe pain in her abdomen for the past one year without much relief from medicines advised by one hospital. She was finally diagnosed to have Cholelithiasis. She was admitted for the treatment at a PM-JAY empaneled hospital. She successfully underwent Laproscopic Cholecystectomy.

Success Story: Sathiya, her husband, an elder daughter and two sons live in thatched house. Sathiya's financial condition is heart-wrenching. Her daughter is the lone bread winner and they struggle to make both ends meet. Around 2 months ago, she suffered from terrible abdominal pain and travelled 40 kms to reach JIPMER for the treatment. She was examined and diagnosed of gall stones and was advised surgery to remove it. On her way back from the hospital, she was thinking about the financial burden that her treatment would bring to the family. Her family tried to provide whatever best they could to help her pain ease, but getting the surgery done seemed like a distant dream. It was only when they got to know about PM-JAY and her family's eligibility to enroll, that without any delay they immediately shifted Sathiya to a private hospital and got her operated. She is now hale and healthy.

25. STATE: Punjab

Medical Case Summary: He suffered from high risk head injury and developed haematoma in his brain. He underwent CT scan at the Civil hospital in Pathankot and was referred to a private hospital for further treatment.

Success Story: Mohit suffered from a serious head injury while playing with his friends. He was rushed to the nearest Civil Hospital, as the family was unable to afford expensive treatment. After the CT scan, head injury was confirmed, and the civil hospital referred him to Raj multispecialty hospital. The family of the patient was afraid & had lost hope due to high expenditure of the treatment and their poor financial condition. But then they came to know about their eligibility & free of cost treatment under PM-JAY scheme from the hospital Arogya Mitra. This scheme came as a ray of hope for the family. They are thankful to the hospital as well as the govt. Now their child is safe and doing well after the surgery.

Medical Case Summary: Mr. Niranjan Jangid, a resident of Karauli district of Rajasthan came to the government hospital about a month ago with chest pain. Angiography investigation revealed that there was a single vessel blockage in his heart and angioplasty with one stent was advised to the patient. But due to financial constraints the patient decided to return to his village.

After reaching the village, he came to know about Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana announced by the Prime Minister, through his family members. The family members took him to Narayana Multispeciality Hospital in Jaipur, where his angioplasty was successfully done by experienced doctors without having to spend any money for his treatment under the scheme.

Success Story: Niranjan is a carpenter by profession. His family did not have adequate funds for the expensive treatment that was prescribed to him by the doctor. The family was considering various options of arranging money – selling house, borrowing etc. since the doctors had informed them that delay in treatment could be fatal. As the family got to know about PM-JAY, they were able to avail free treatment and save life of Niranjan.

Medical Case Summary: Tulasha Subba was diagnosed with 21% total body surface area (TBSA) flame burn on Bilateral Lower limb. She has a history of Diabetes Mellitus, Hypertension and HbsAg+. She was initially examined and referred from the Gyalshing District Hospital, West Sikkim. She was admitted in the burns ward and underwent dressing followed by split thickness skin grafting. During her hospital stay she developed flexion contractures of both lower limbs for which skin traction was applied. Her wounds healed well, and she was able to stand and walk with support.

Success Story: Tulasha Subba from Hee Bermiok in West Sikkim belonged to a poor family and suffered from serious burns due to an accident. As a result, she was referred from the Gyalshing District Hospital, West Sikkim to STNM Hospital, Sikkim for further treatment. She was informed about PM-JAY scheme and her entitlement for free benefits. She was admitted in the hospital for treatment for 94 days. Thereafter, upon full recovery, she was discharged from the hospital.

Success Story: Palanisamy was suffering from chest pain and visited Bharthani Heart and Maternity hospital, where investigations confirmed a double vessel disease for which he was prescribed angioplasty (PTCA) and stenting to Right Coronary Artery (RCA) and Left Marginal Artery (Obtuse Marginal Artery). Since the family was not financially prepared for this, discovery of PM-JAY came as a big relief and he underwent free surgery.

29. STATE: Tripura

Post examination, he was diagnosed with pseudophakia and secondary glaucoma in both eyes, status post vitreoretinal surgery of both eyes. He underwent Silicon oil removal in left eye & silicon oil insertion in right eye, under local anesthesia. His hospital stay was uneventful and was discharged in a satisfactory condition.

Success Story: Bhandari's son was aware of PM-JAY and called on the National Call Centre to enquire if disorders of the kind Bhandari was suffering were covered. As soon as he got know about the eligibility, Bhandari was admitted to Sankardeva Nethralaya, Guwahati in Assam and underwent a complex surgery successfully with ease, at no cost.

Medical Case Summary: Mr. Sartaj was diagnosed of CaRMT. CT Scan indicated 4.8cmx3.6cm mass involving left buccal mucosa extending to RMT. He underwent composite resection with reconstruction in February 2019 by radiotherapy under AB-PMJAY.

Success Story: Sartaj is a native of Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh and was diagnosed with mouth cancer (Retro Molar Trigone), a rare and aggressive malignancy which tends to spread very rapidly to different parts of the body. Sartaj was unaware about the disease until he started having severe pain and difficulty in swallowing. Diagnosis of cancer came as a shock to him and his family members who looked upon him for their livelihood. He decided not to get treated and live with the disease as the cost of treatment was beyond his reach. His symptoms were being managed by a local doctor which was futile because he got no relief. The disease was progressing and so were the symptoms. One day he was about to leave for work when a health worker accredited social health activist (ASHA) came to their house with a letter and a card of Ayushman Bharat and informed him about the benefits of the letter and the ongoing scheme. She also assured him that she will get him the best treatment possible through this scheme.

31. STATE: Jammu & Kashmir

Medical Case Summary: Patient had suffered from severe pain in bilateral lumbar region. Doctor advised certain blood tests, ECG and X-ray (KUB). The X-ray showed Bilateral Renal Calculus with struck up Urethral stone with Right lower Ureteric Calculus (Bladder stone, Ureteric stone and Kidney stone). Patient underwent Cystourethroscopy with Cyst lithotripsy with Ureteric stone removal with lithotripsy followed by Right side PCNL with Antegrade DJ Stenting under GA. The procedure was successful, and the patient was discharged from the hospital in a stable condition with advice to follow-up after a week.

Success Story: Mustafa Khan, a 41-year-old man from Akhnoor, Jammu is a small farmer who grows rice, pulses, wheat - anything that the land will take and the weather will allow. He is the only single earning person in his family having two small kids and a widow mother. Apart from farming, there is no other source of income for his family and this is why he had been ignoring his health. But upon finding out about PM-JAY, he went to a local nursing home where the doctor performed certain investigations and informed that he is having stones in his ureter and would need immediate treatment to relieve him from pain. After spending two days in Triveni Nursing Home Hospital, Mustafa underwent surgery to remove the stone and didn't have to pay a penny for his treatment, investigations and medications.
