04 July (Day 1): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy falls** at isolated places very likely over Konkan & Goa; **Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls** at isolated places over Gujarat State; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Maharashtra, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Coastal Karnataka and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over North Haryana, West Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Marathwada, Telangana, Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** very likely at a few places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi; **with lightning & gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** likely at a few places over East Uttar Pradesh and at isolated places over West Uttar Pradesh and East Rajasthan; **with lightning** at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Gujarat State, Marathwada, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalseema and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

♦ **Thunderstorm/Duststorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** very likely at isolated places over West Rajasthan.

♦ **Heat Wave Condition** very likely at some pockets over West Rajasthan.

♦ **Strong Wind** (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) very likely over Southwest, Westcentral Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra coast and (speed reaching 45-55 kmph) very likely over Eastcentral Arabian Sea, along & off Gujarat Coast and Central Bay of Bengal. **Squally Weather** (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) over Northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Kerala- Karnataka- Goa Coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.

05 July (Day 2): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy falls** at isolated places very likely over Gujarat State; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and Konkan & Goa and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, West Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan, East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra, Coastal Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** very likely at a few places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi; **with lightning & gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** likely at a few places over Uttar Pradesh; **with lightning** at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Gujarat State, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalseema and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

♦ **Thunderstorm/Duststorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** very likely at isolated places over West Rajasthan.

♦ **Strong Wind** (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) very likely over Southwest & Central Arabian Sea and along & off Gujarat-Maharashtra coast **Squally Weather** (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) over Westcentral Bay of Bengal, Northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Kerala- Karnataka- Goa Coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.

06 July (Day 3): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy falls** at isolated places very likely over Saurashtra & Kutch; **heavy to very heavy rainfall with Extremely heavy falls** at isolated places over Gujarat Region and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** very likely at a few places over West Uttar Pradesh and at isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and East Uttar Pradesh; **with lightning** at isolated places over Rajasthan, Bihar, Jharkhand, Ggetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Rayalseema.

♦ **Strong Wind** (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) very likely over Southwest & Central Arabian Sea and along & off Gujarat coast. (speed reaching 45-55 kmph) over Northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra Coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.

07 July (Day 4): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall with Extremely heavy falls** at isolated places likely over Saurashtra & Kutch; **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Gujarat Region and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub- Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Konkan & Goa and Coastal Karnataka.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** likely at a few places over West Uttar Pradesh and at isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and East Uttar Pradesh; **with lightning** at isolated places over Rajasthan, Bihar, Jharkhand and Ggetic West Bengal.

♦ **Strong Wind** (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) very likely over Northeast, Southwest & Westcentral Arabian Sea and along & off Gujarat coast. (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) over Eastcentral Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.

08 July (Day 5): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Saurashtra & Kutch and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Bihar, Sub- Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat Region, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Coastal & South Interior Karnataka.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places over Bihar, Jharkhand and Ggetic West Bengal.




