02 July (Day 1): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places very likely over Assam & Meghalaya; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Bihar, Arunachal Pradesh, Konkan & Goa and Coastal Karnataka and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, East Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

- ♦ **Heat wave conditions** in isolated pockets very likely over West Rajasthan.
- ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning very likely at a few places over Bihar and at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
- Strong Wind (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) very likely over Southwest & Westcentral Arabian Sea. Squally Weather (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) likely over Southeast & Eastcentral Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra-Goa- Karnataka coasts and Lakshadweep. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.

03 July (Day 2): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places very likely over and Konkan & Goa; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Bihar, Assam & Meghalaya, Madhya Maharashtra and Coastal Karnataka and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, East Uttar Pradesh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand, Odisha, Uttarakhand, Marathwada, Telangana, Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

- ♦ **Heat wave conditions** in isolated pockets very likely over West Rajasthan.
- ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning very likely at a few places over Bihar and at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadween.
- Strong Wind (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) very likely over Southwest & Westcentral Arabian Sea. Squally Weather (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) likely over Southeast & Eastcentral Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra-Goa- Karnataka coasts and Lakshadweep. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.

04 July (Day 3): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places very likely over Konkan & Goa; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places very likely over Gujarat Region and Madhya Maharashtra; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Saurashtra & Kutch and Coastal Karnataka and heavy rainfall at isolated places over West Uttar Pradesh, West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, South Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

- ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning very likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Jharkhand, Bihar, Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
- ♦ Thunderstorm/Duststorm accompanied with lightning very likely at isolated places over West Rajasthan.
- Strong Wind (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) very likely over Southwest & Westcentral Arabian Sea and (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) likely over Eastcentral Arabian Sea and along & off Gujarat-Maharashtra coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.

05 July (Day 4): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places likely over Gujarat Region; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, Saurashtra & Kutch and Konkan & Goa and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, West Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and Madhya Maharashtra.

- ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan and Jharkhand.
- ♦ Thunderstorm/Duststorm accompanied with lightning likely at isolated places over West Rajasthan.
- ◆ Strong Wind (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) likely over Southwest & Central Arabian Sea and (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) along & off Gujarat-Maharashtra coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.




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06 July (Day 5): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over Gujarat State and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra and Konkan & Goa.



- ◆ Strong Wind (speed reaching 50-60 kmph) likely over Southwest, Central & Northeast Arabian Sea and (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) along & off Gujarat-Maharashtra coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.
