The National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) launched by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, in January, 2019 identified 122 cities for suitable interventions for improvement of air quality. The Programme aligns with the "International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies" on 7th September, 2020 as adopted by the United Nations General Assembly.

The Program focuses on multi-sectoral sources of pollution including power plants, industries, vehicles, open burning of waste, construction & demolition activities etc and suitable interventions aiming towards a clean air environment.


