
More than 10 lakh youths have been provided skill development training and employment and employment opportunities during last about 6 years through employment oriented skill development schemes such as "Usttad", "Garib Nawaz Self Employment Scheme", "Seekho aur Kamao", "Nai Manzil" etc. More than 50 per cent beneficiaries are girls.

Thousands of Health Care Assistants, who have been trained under skill development programme of Minority Affairs Ministry, are assisting in treatment and well-being of Corona patients. In the coming days, Minority youths will be provided employment & employment opportunities on large scale through training in different trades such as Health Assistant, Hospitality Assistant, Swadeshi Senani, Tax Facilitator, Carpenter, Tailoring etc.

During last about 6 years, Modi Government has developed socio-economic-educational and employment oriented infrastructure across the country in Minority concentrated areas. These projects include:

Educational Empowerment

More than 3 crore 80 lakh students from 6 notified Minority communities — Parsi, Jain, Buddhist, Sikh, Christian and Muslim- have been provided pre-matric, post-matric, merit-cum-means, Begum Hazrat Mahal Girls Scholarships during last 6 years.

More than 50 per cent beneficiaries of scholarship schemes are girl students.

Efforts of Modi Government towards educational empowerment of Minorities have shown results on ground level. School drop out rate of Muslim girls which was earlier 72 per cent, has come down to 32 per cent. Our commitment is to bring it down to zero per cent in the coming days.

Utilisation of Waqf Properties

Geo tagging and digitisation of Waqf properties across the country has ensured utilisation of waqf properties for welfare of the society. Digitization and Geo Tagging has also helped in curbing the menace of waqf mafia.

For the first time since Independence, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi led Government is providing 100 per cent funding to develop schools, colleges, hospitals, community hall and other basic infrastructure on Waqf land under Pradhanmantri Jan Vikas Karykram (PMJVK) for weaker sections and needy especially girls in those backward areas which had been deprived of these basic facilities.

- About 6 lakh 52,000 registered waqf properties are there.
- Digitisation of all the state waqf boards has been completed.
- GIS/GPS Mapping of more than 95 per cent waqf properties has been completed.
- All the 32 state waqf boards have been provided video conferencing facilities.
