

- More than 6.5 crore tests conducted, 12 lakh tests on a single day


India has the highest recovered cases in the world




% Share in total cases

Exponential increase in testing infrastructure




Cases per million population - amongst the lowest in the world




Cases per million (population) in US & Brazil is 5 times their corresponding figure in India.

Deaths per million population - amongst the lowest in the world




Deaths per million (population) in Brazil & UK is 10 times higher, respectively, as compared to India


Recovery rate crosses milestone of 80%




New recoveries have exceeded new cases in the last 4 days



Less than one-fifth of total cases are active





Average daily new cases for top 7 states (week on week basis)




