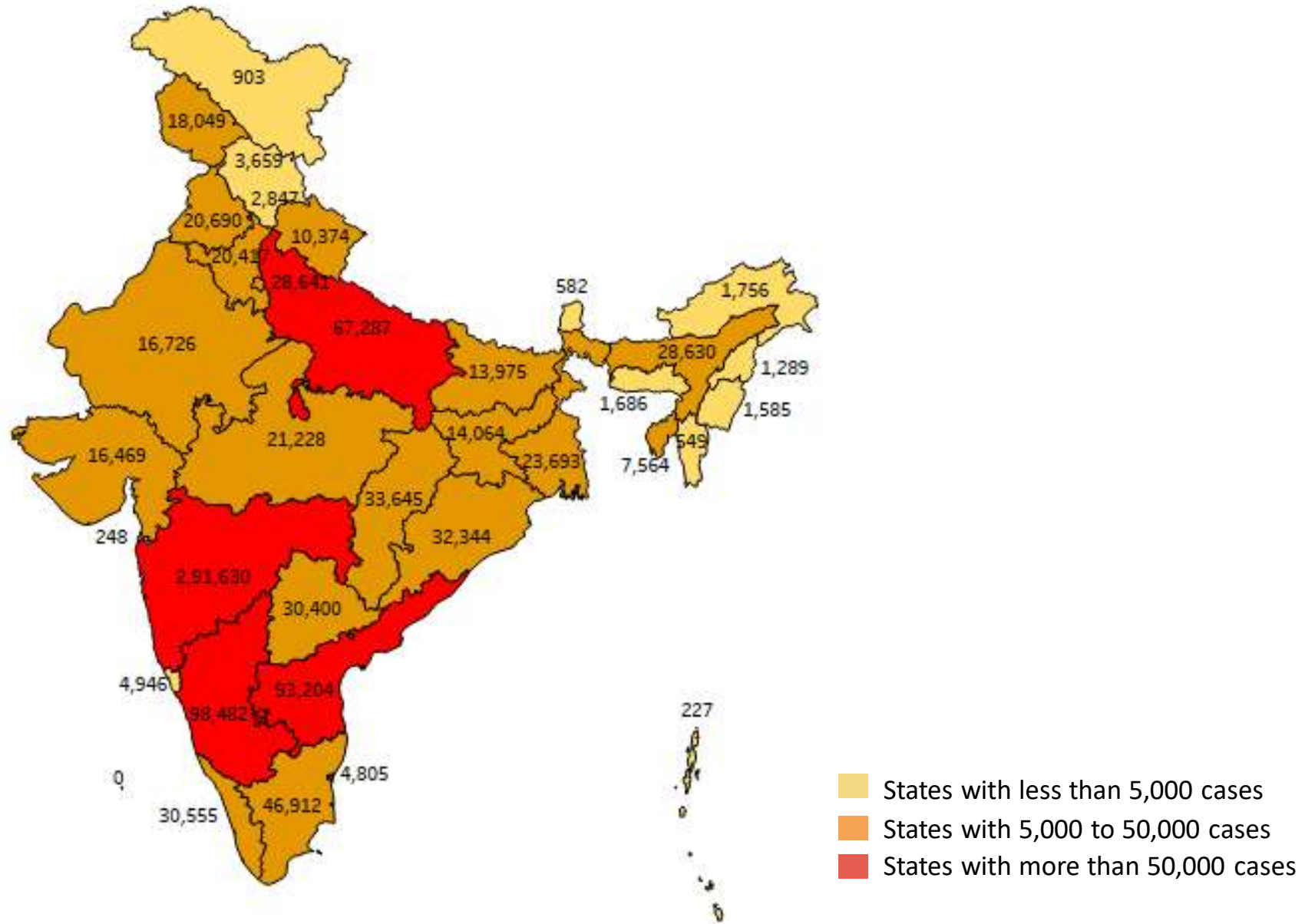

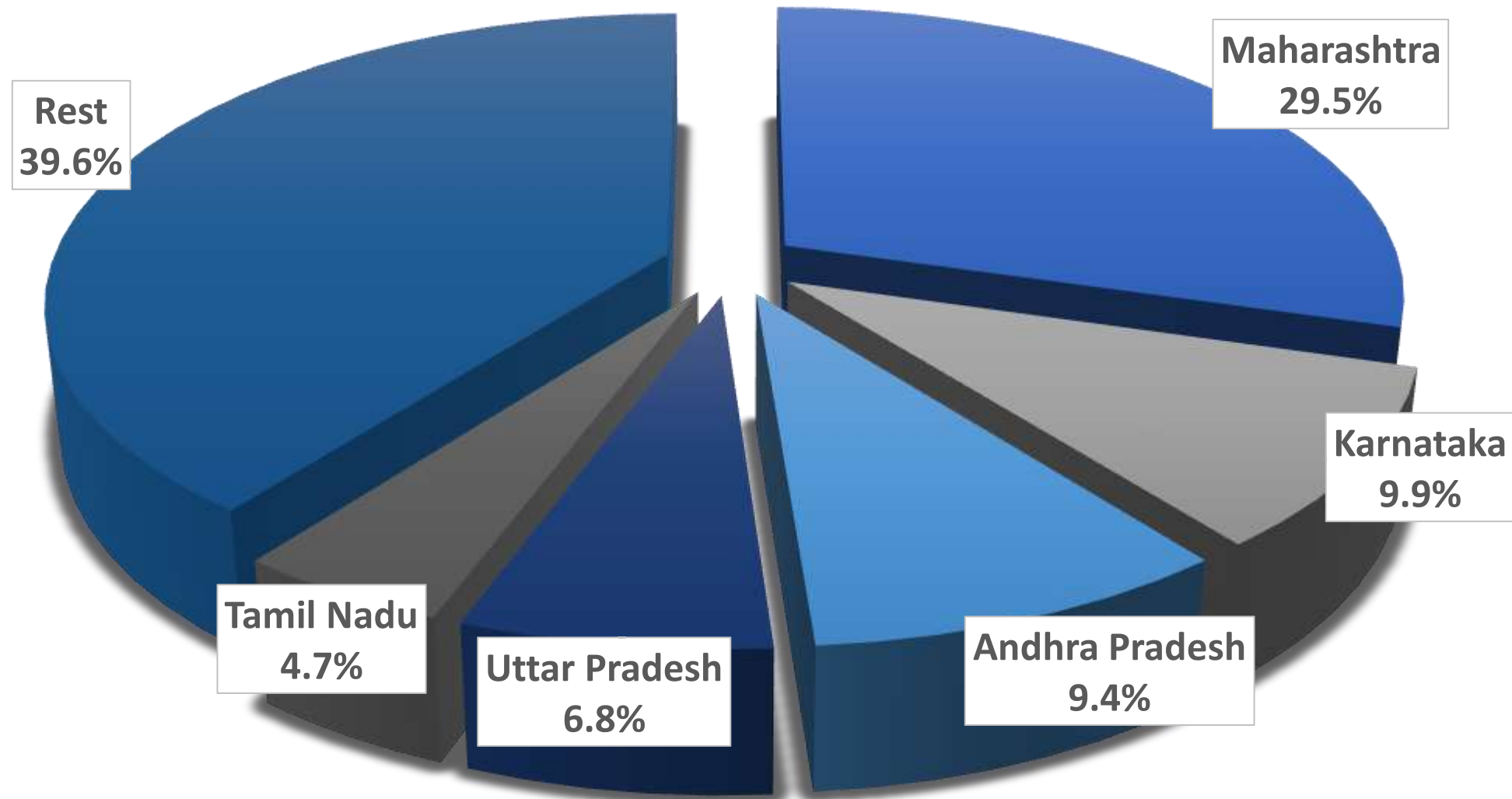
Major highlights this week

- More than **5.8 crore tests** conducted so far
- More than **76 lakh tests** conducted in the last week

Only 4 states with more than 50,000 cases

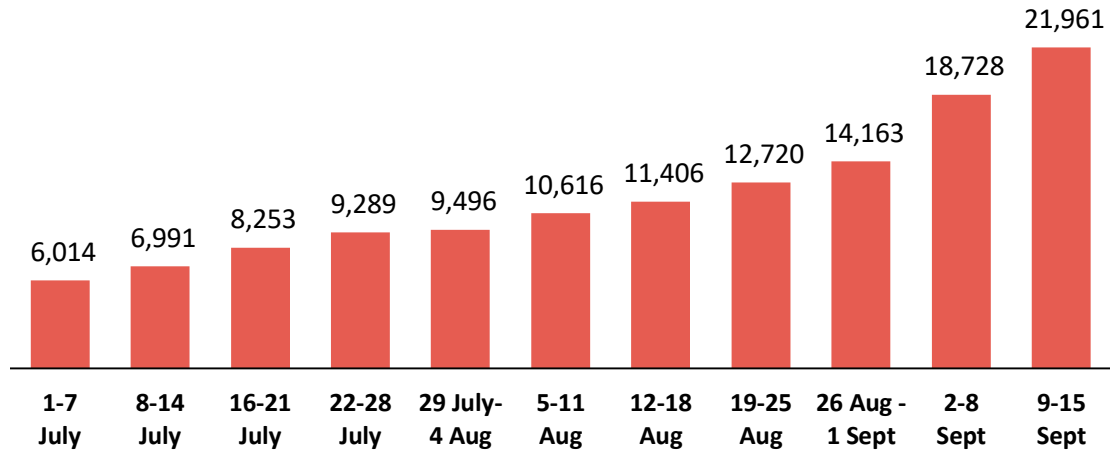


5 states account for 60% of total active cases in the country

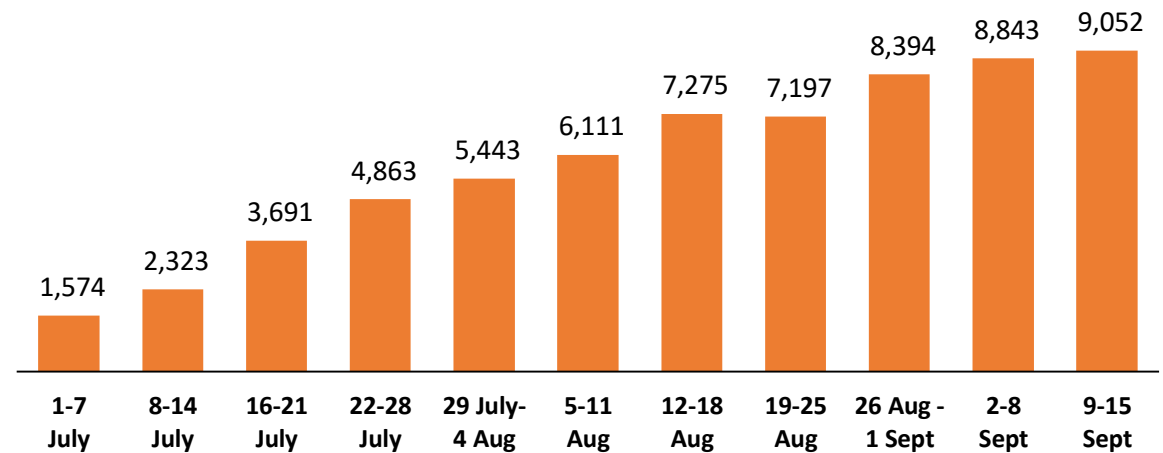


Daily average new cases in top 5 states (week on week basis)

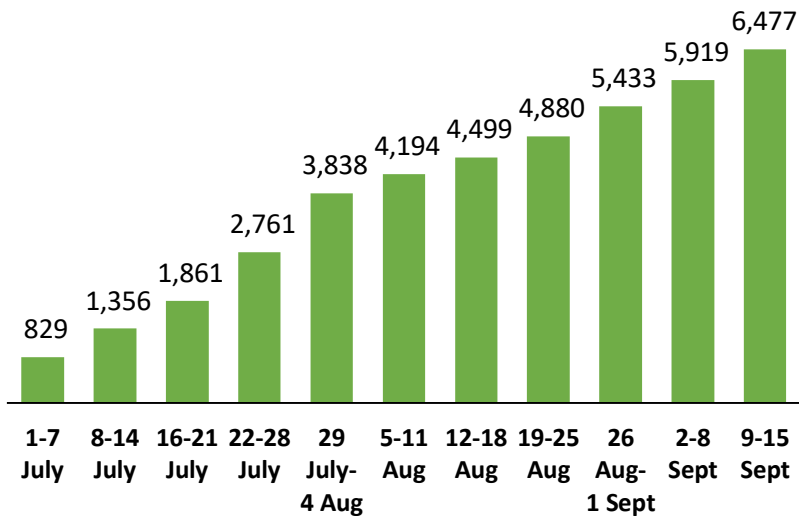

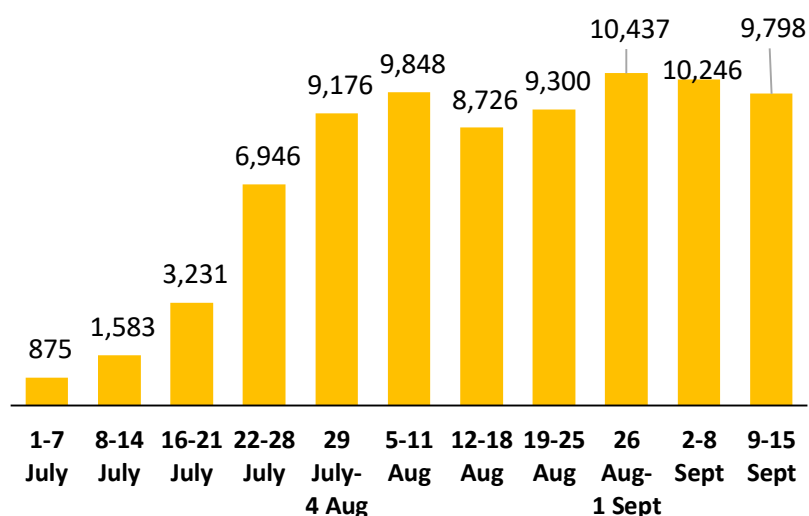

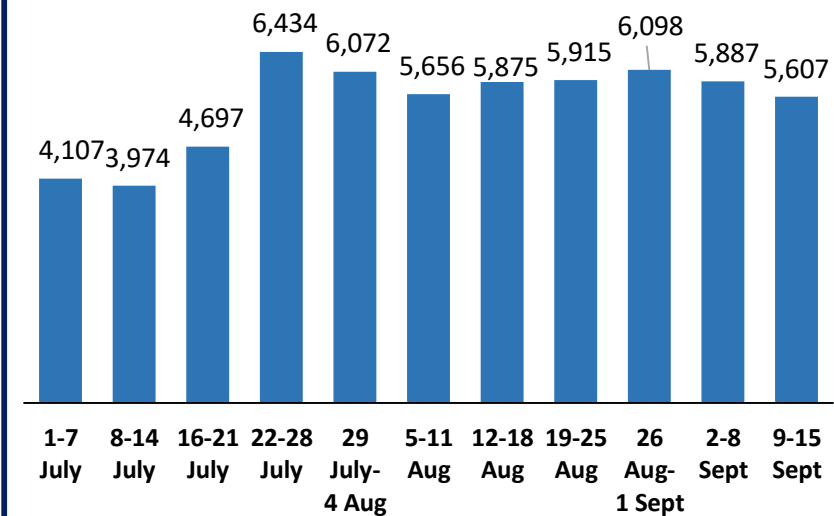

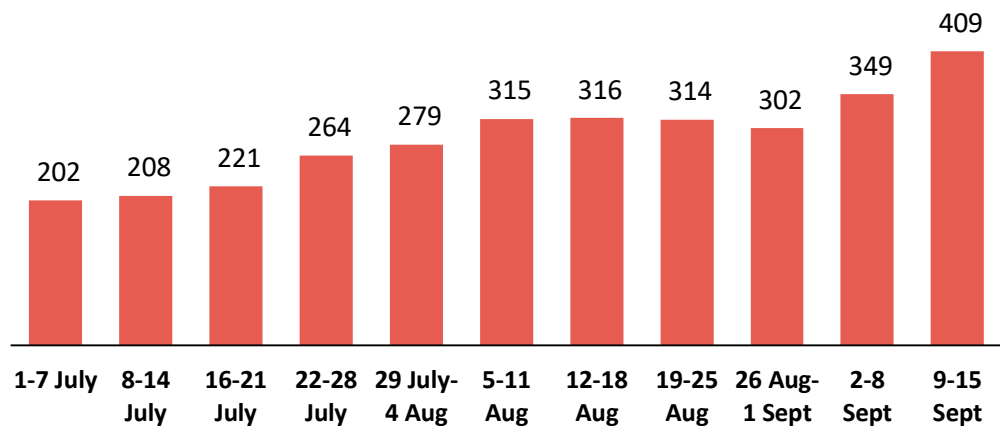

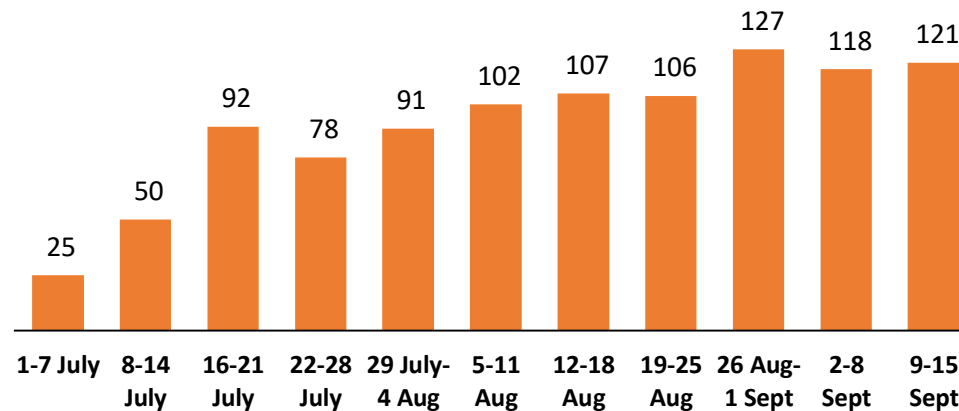


Daily average deaths in top 5 states (week on week basis)

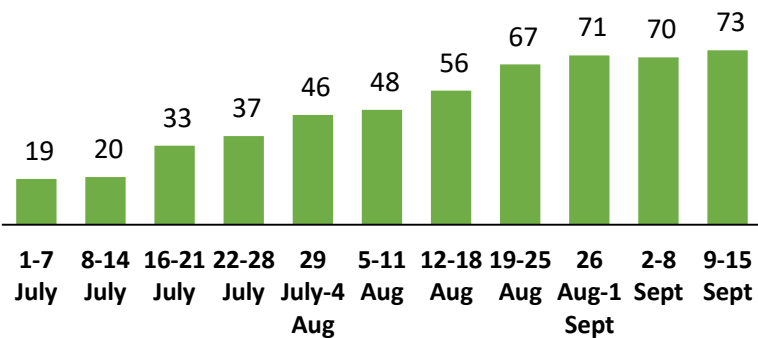

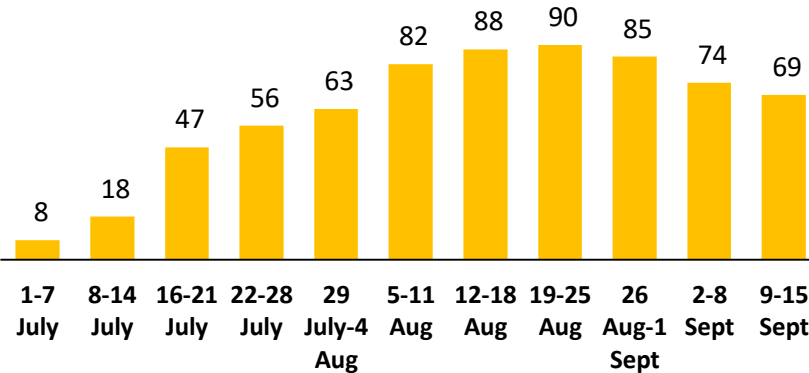

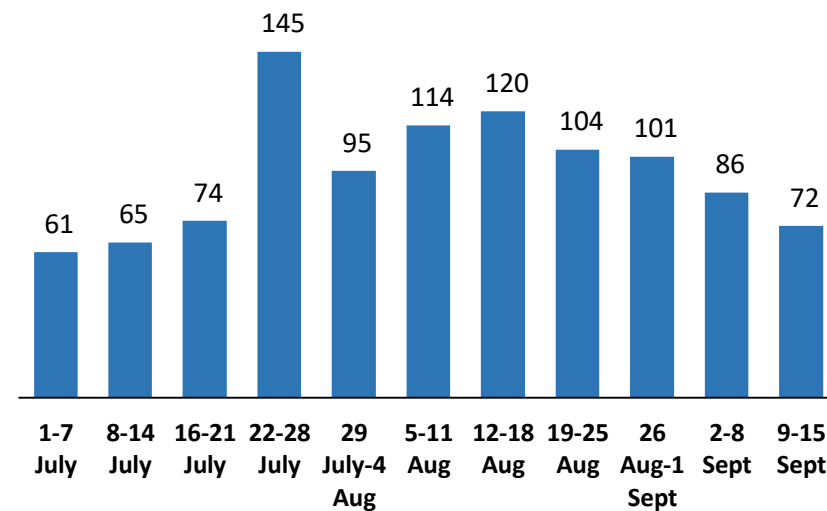

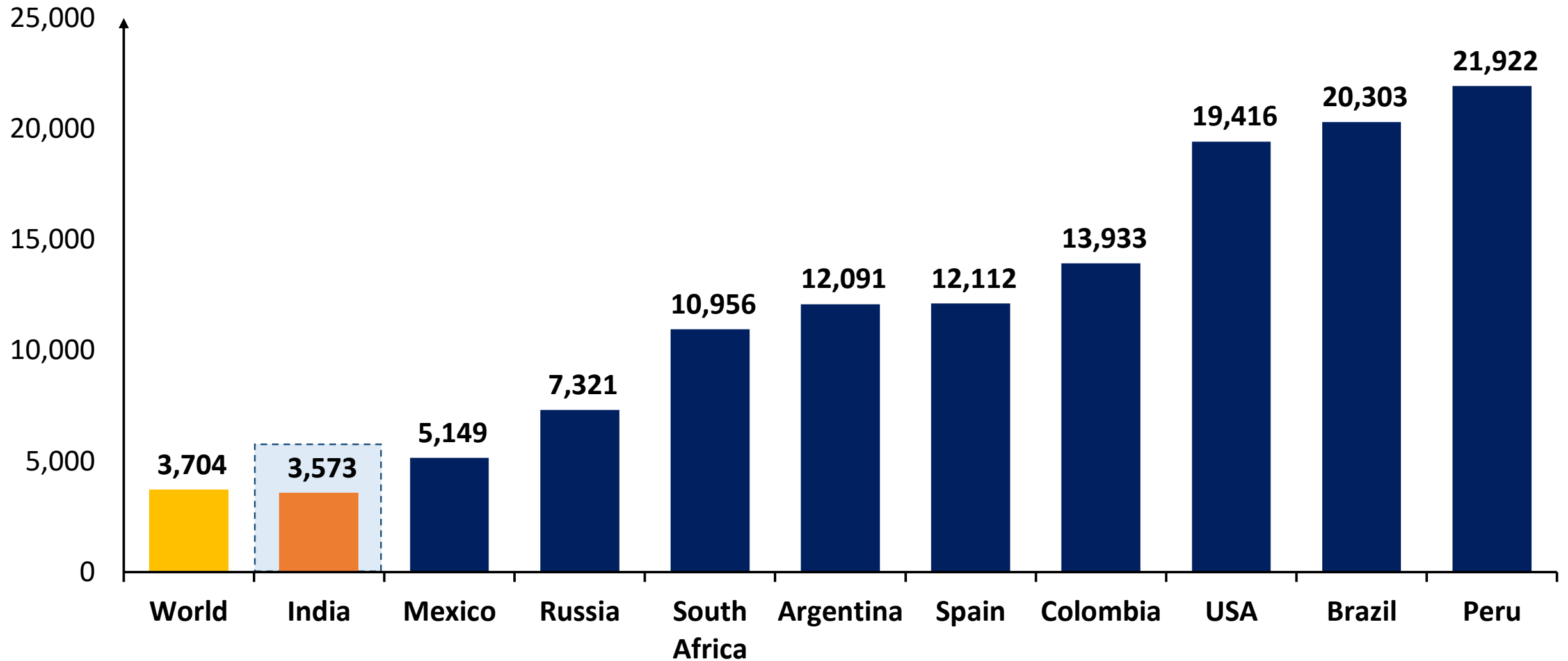

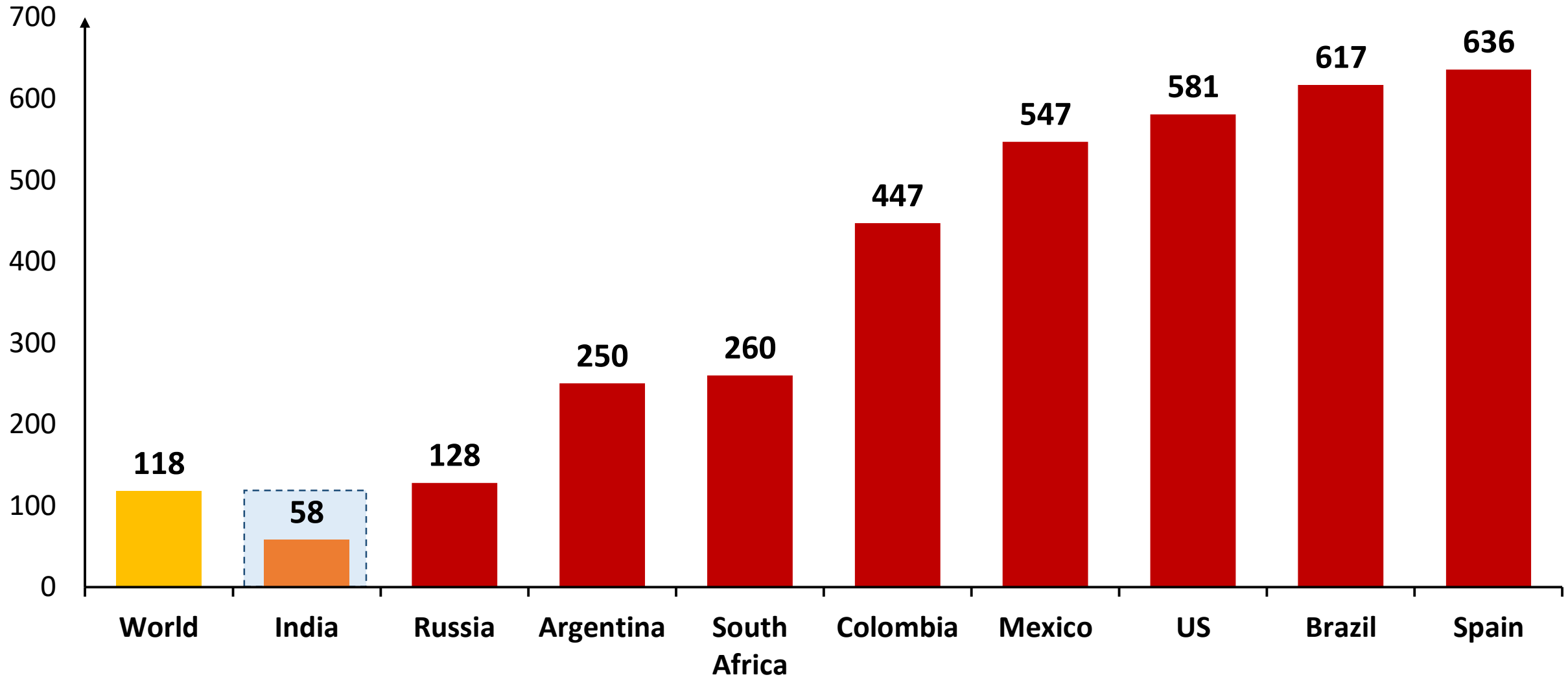


Cases per million population - amongst the lowest in the world



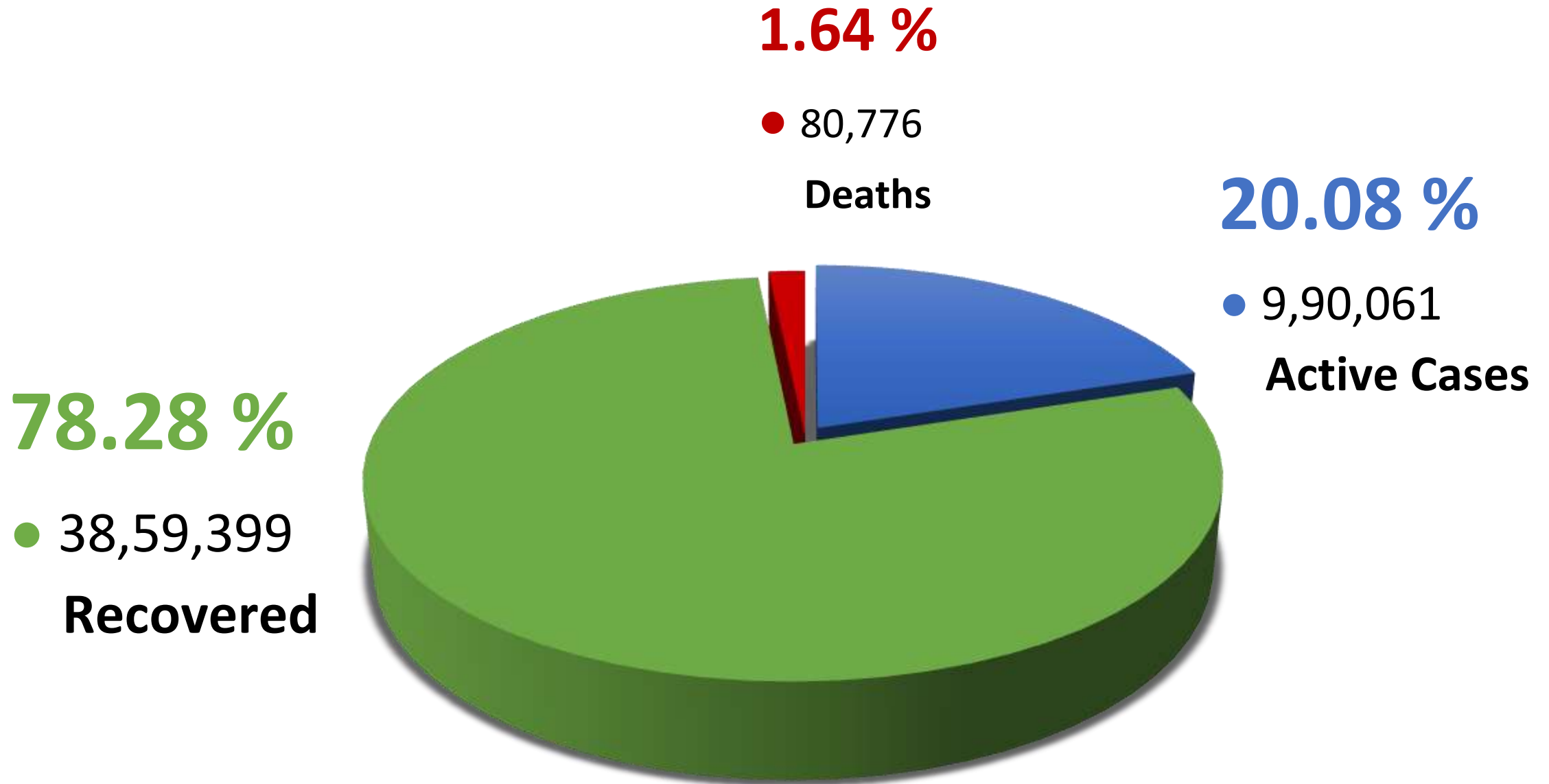
Cases per million (population) in US & Brazil is 5 & 6 times respectively their corresponding figure in India.

Deaths per million population - amongst the lowest in the world

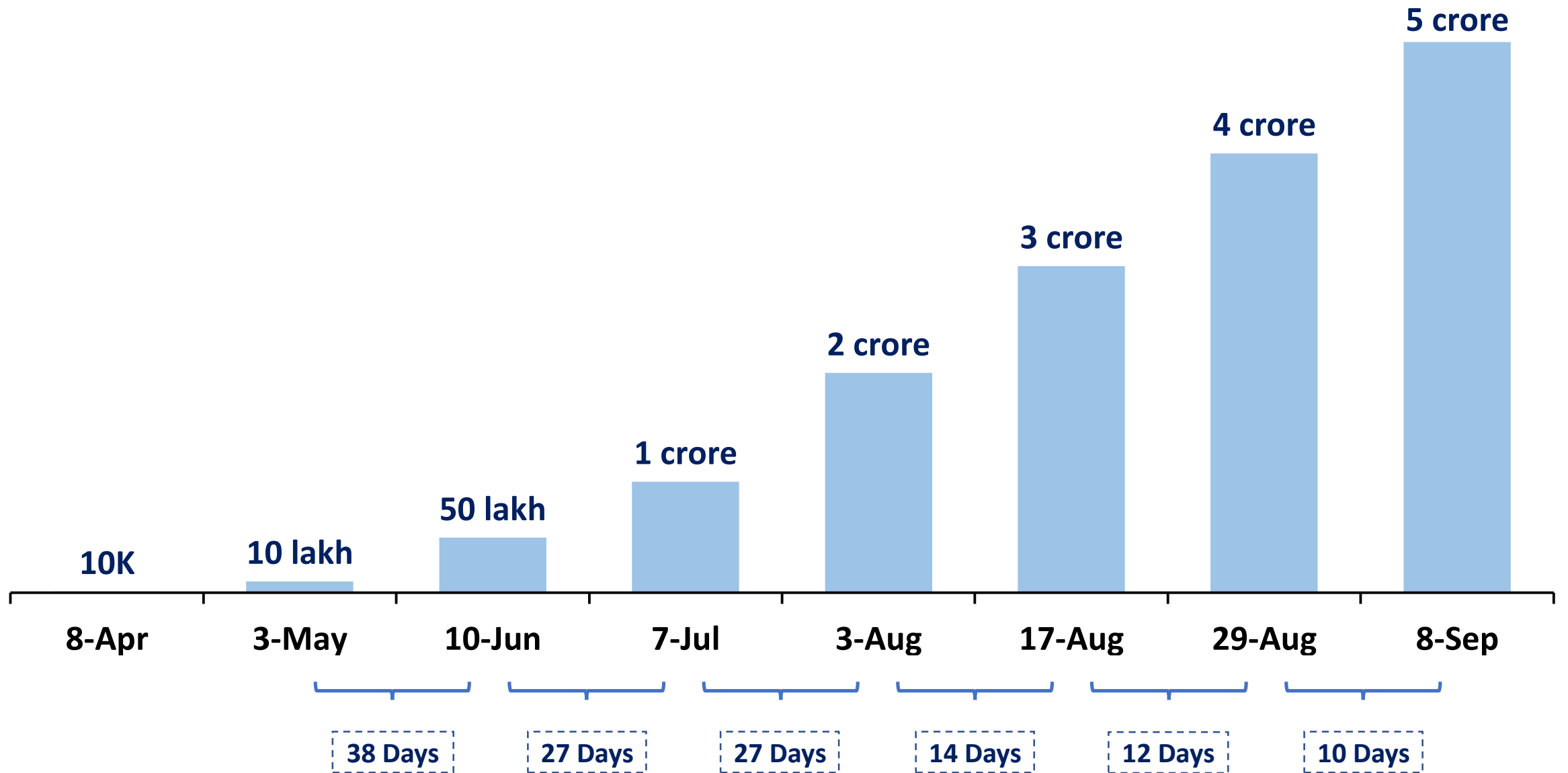


Deaths per million (population) in Brazil & Spain is 11 times higher, respectively, as compared to India

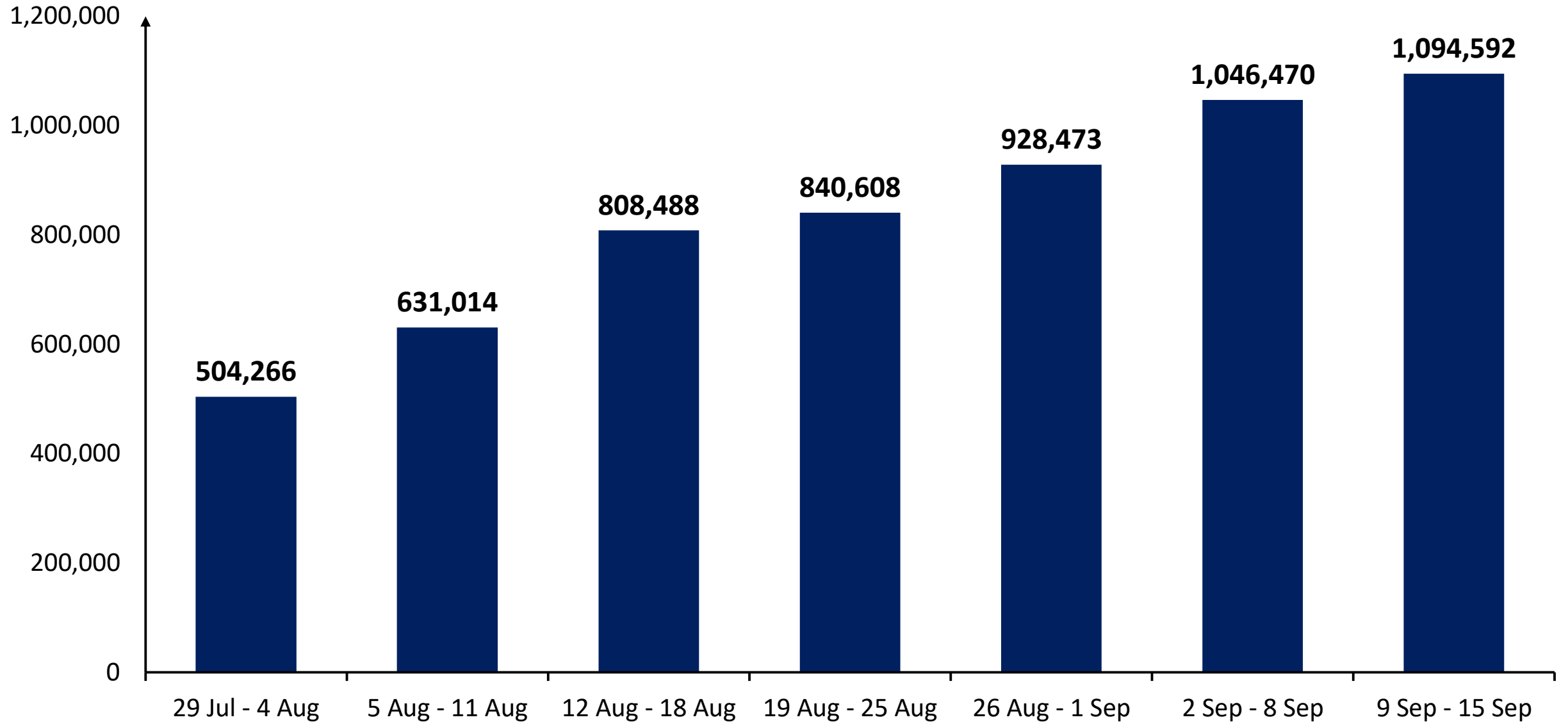
Only one-fifth (20%) of total cases are active



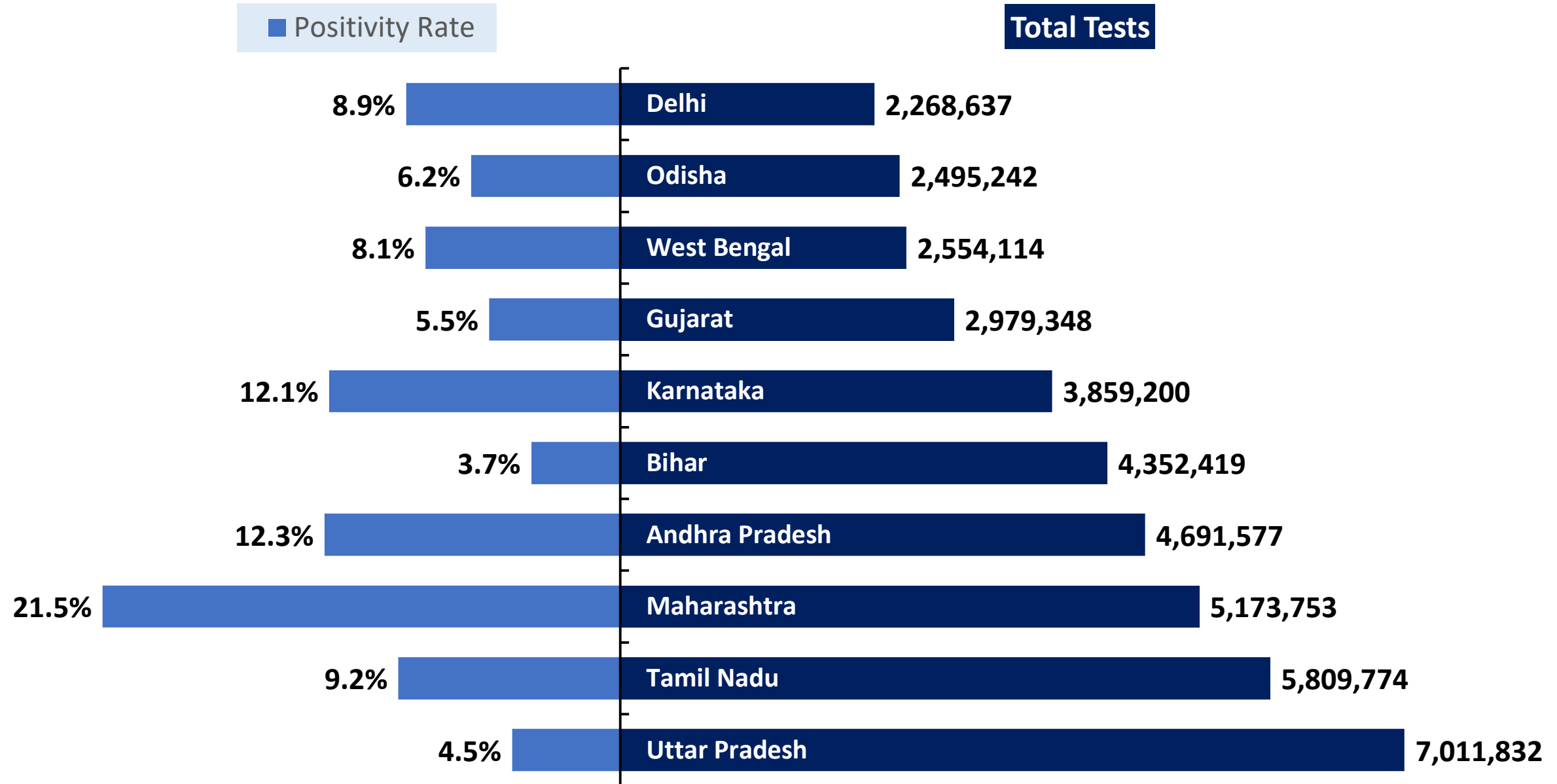
Progressive Rise in Testing



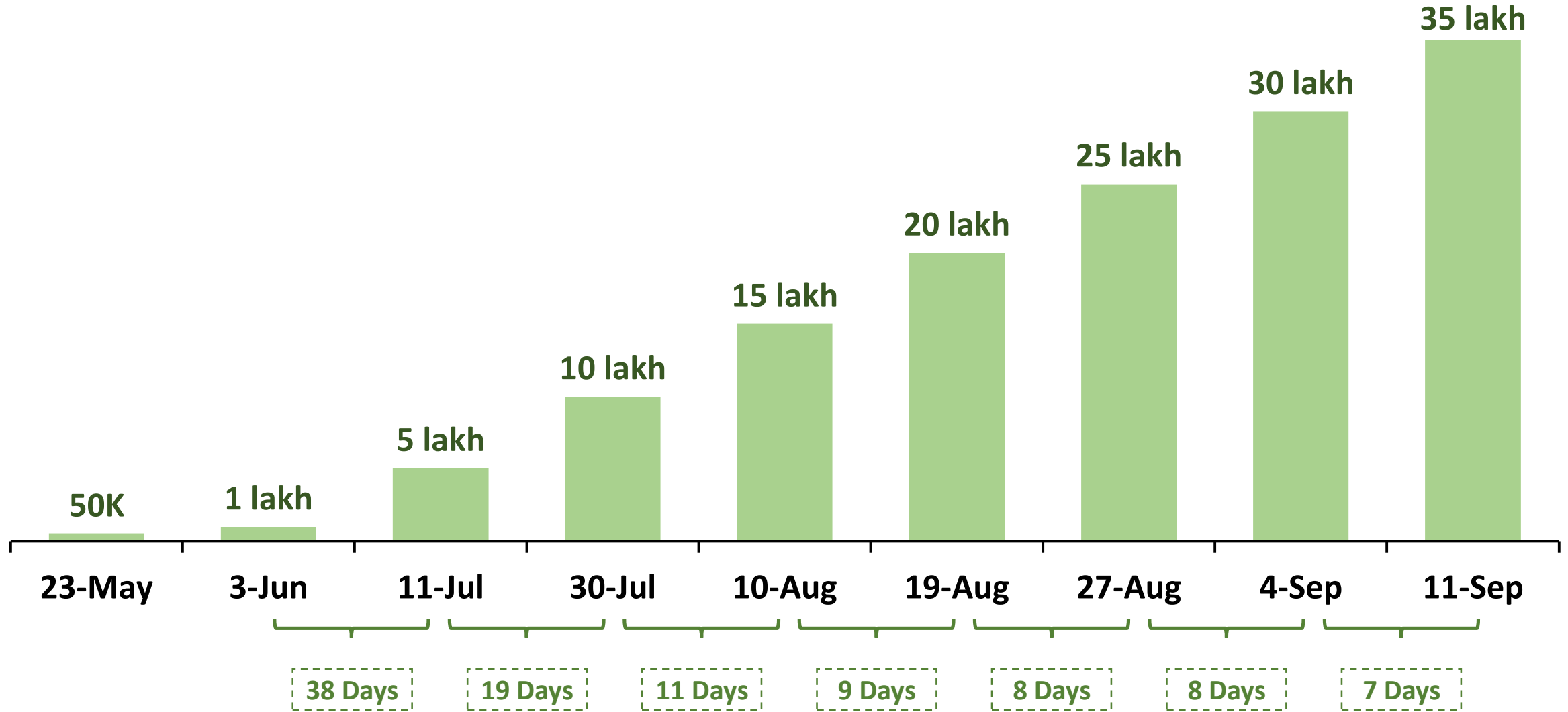
Average Daily Tests Conducted (Week wise)
