

Major Highlights this week


- More than 5 crore tests conducted so far
- More than 10 lakh tests conducted daily in the week
- Recovered patients more than 33 lakhs
- Highest single day recovery 73,642 has been recorded
- Case Fatality Rate continuously declining

Cases per million (population) in Brazil & US are 6 times their corresponding figure in India.


Test per million population continuously increasing



Tests Per Million Population


21 States/UTs performing more tests per million than national

Average Daily Tests Conducted (Week wise)




Progressively Rising Recovered Cases



Increasing gap between active and recovered cases




Deaths per Million Population - Amongst the Lowest in the World




Deaths per million (population) in Brazil & Spain are 11 & 12 times higher, respectively, as compared to India

Case Fatality Rate below 2% and is continuously declining




5 states account for 62% of total active cases in the country




As on 8th Sept

14 states / UTs have less than 5,000 active cases




5 most affected states account for \sim 70% of total deaths in the country
