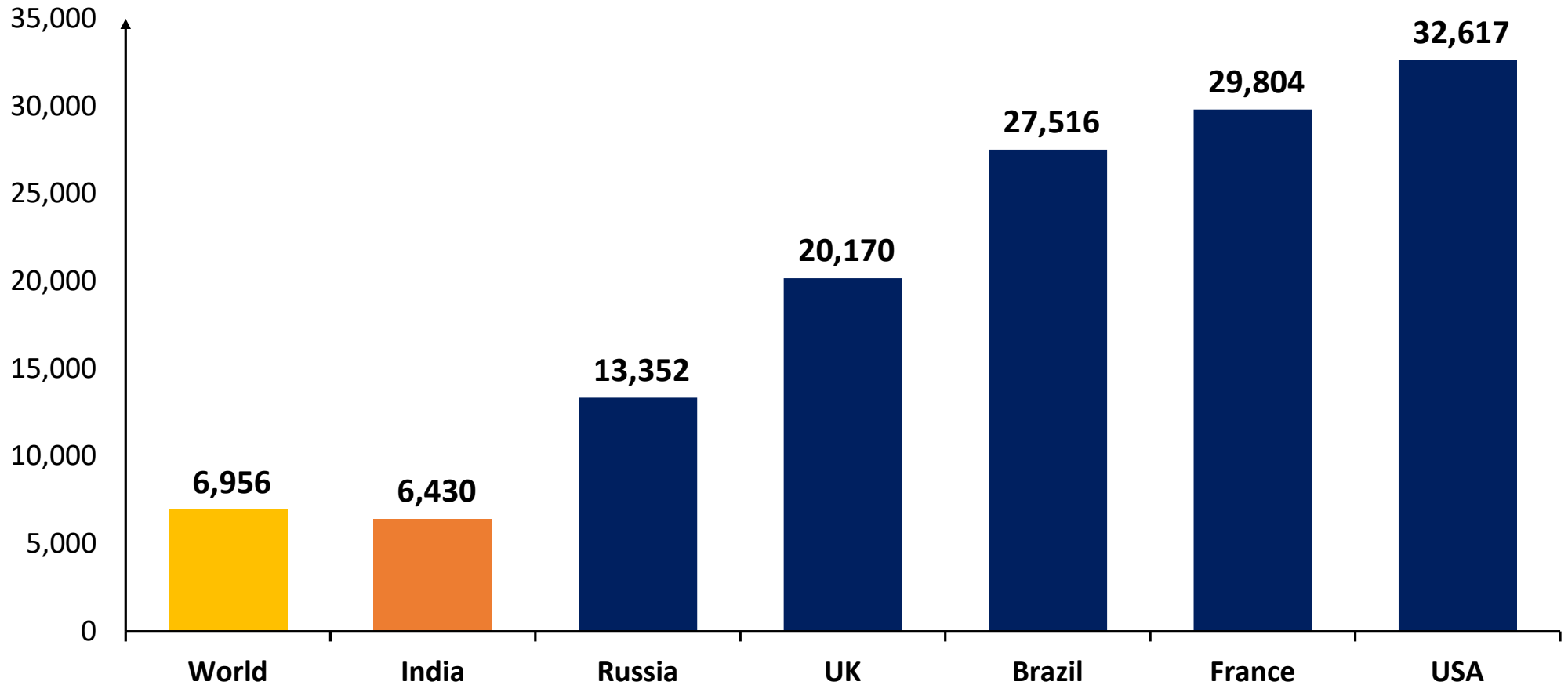

Major highlights this week

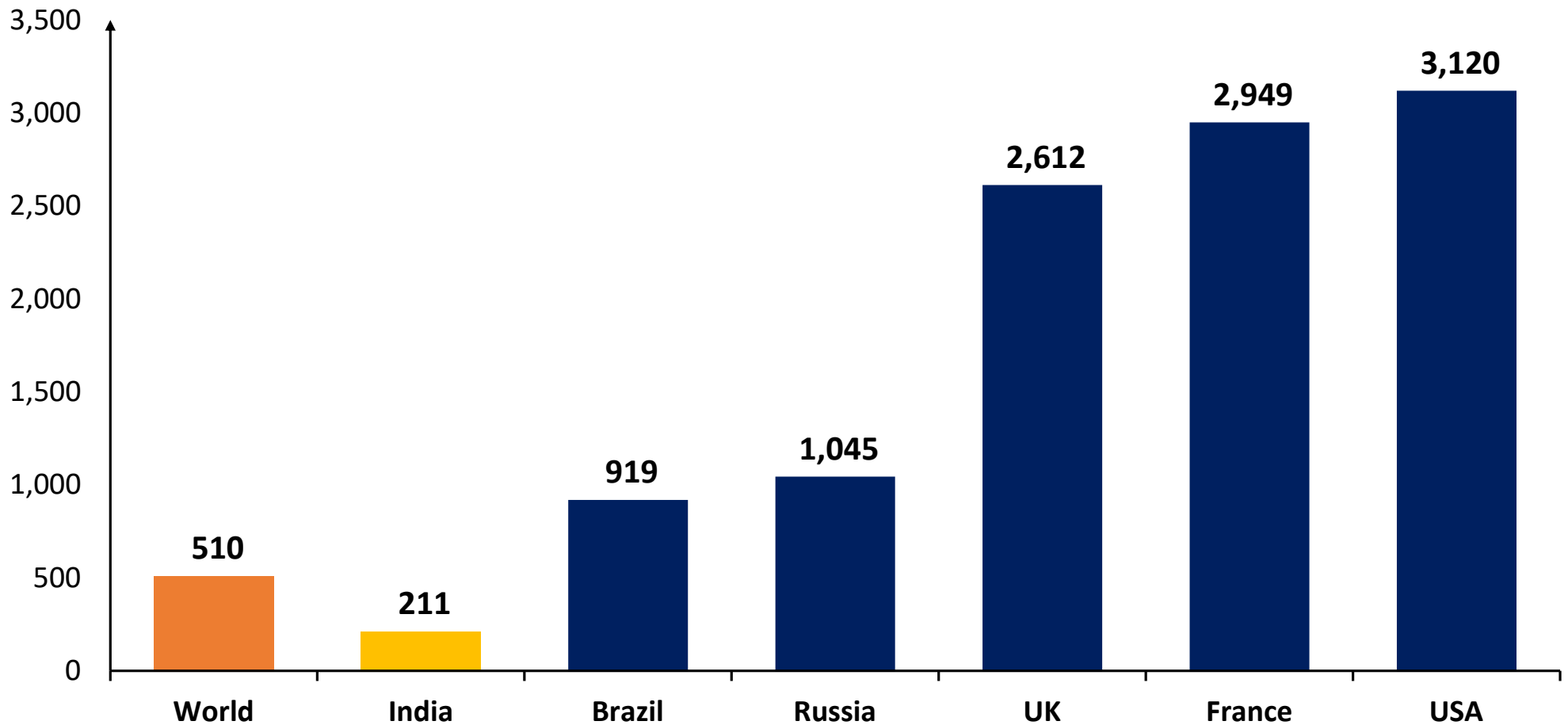
- Recovered cases cross **82.9 lakhs**
- Recovery rate more than **93%**
- Average **46,701** cases recovered daily in the last week
- Average **40,365** new cases were reported daily in the last week
- More than **12.65 crore tests** conducted
- Cumulative positivity rate, **7.01%**
- Daily positivity rate in the last week, **4.1%**

Cases per Million Population - Amongst the Lowest in the World



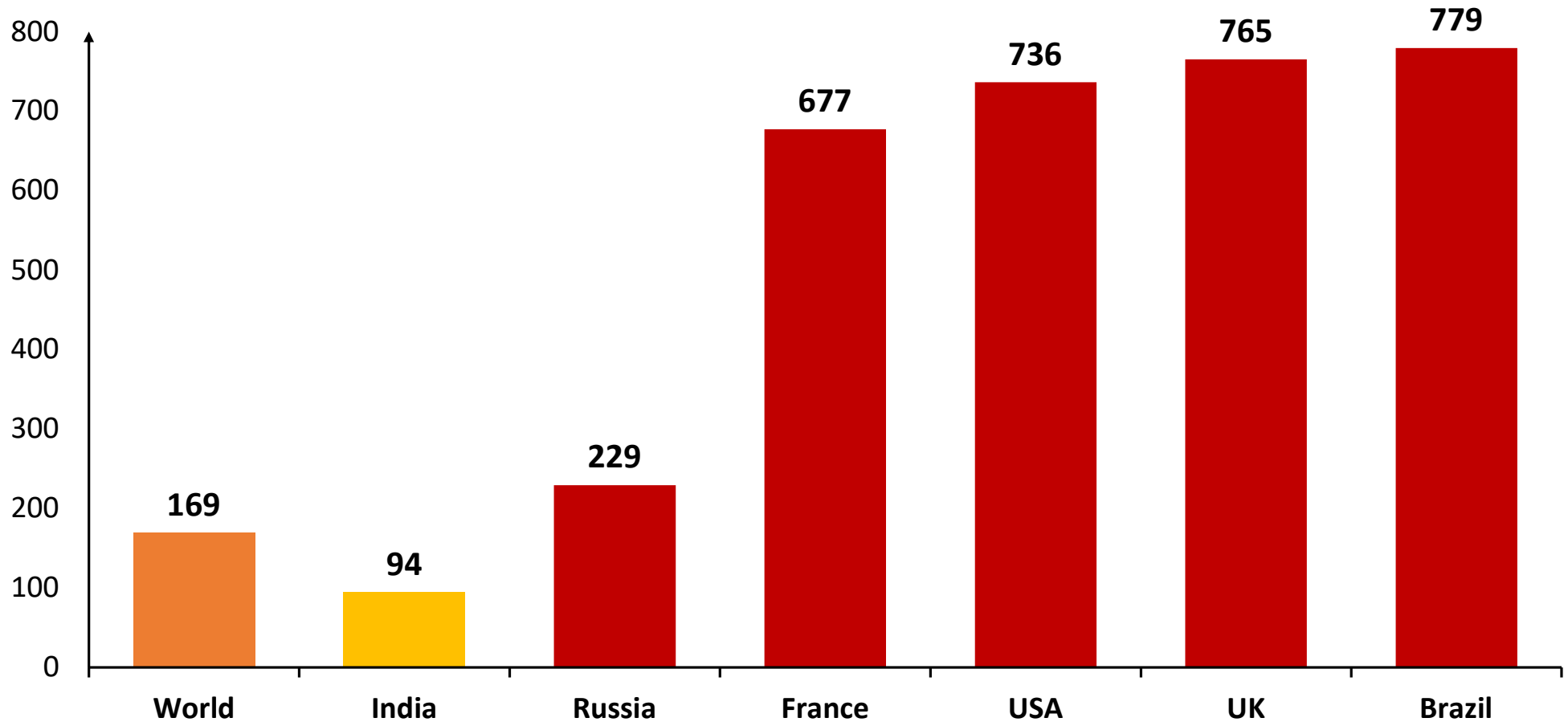

New cases per million population reported in the last 7 days



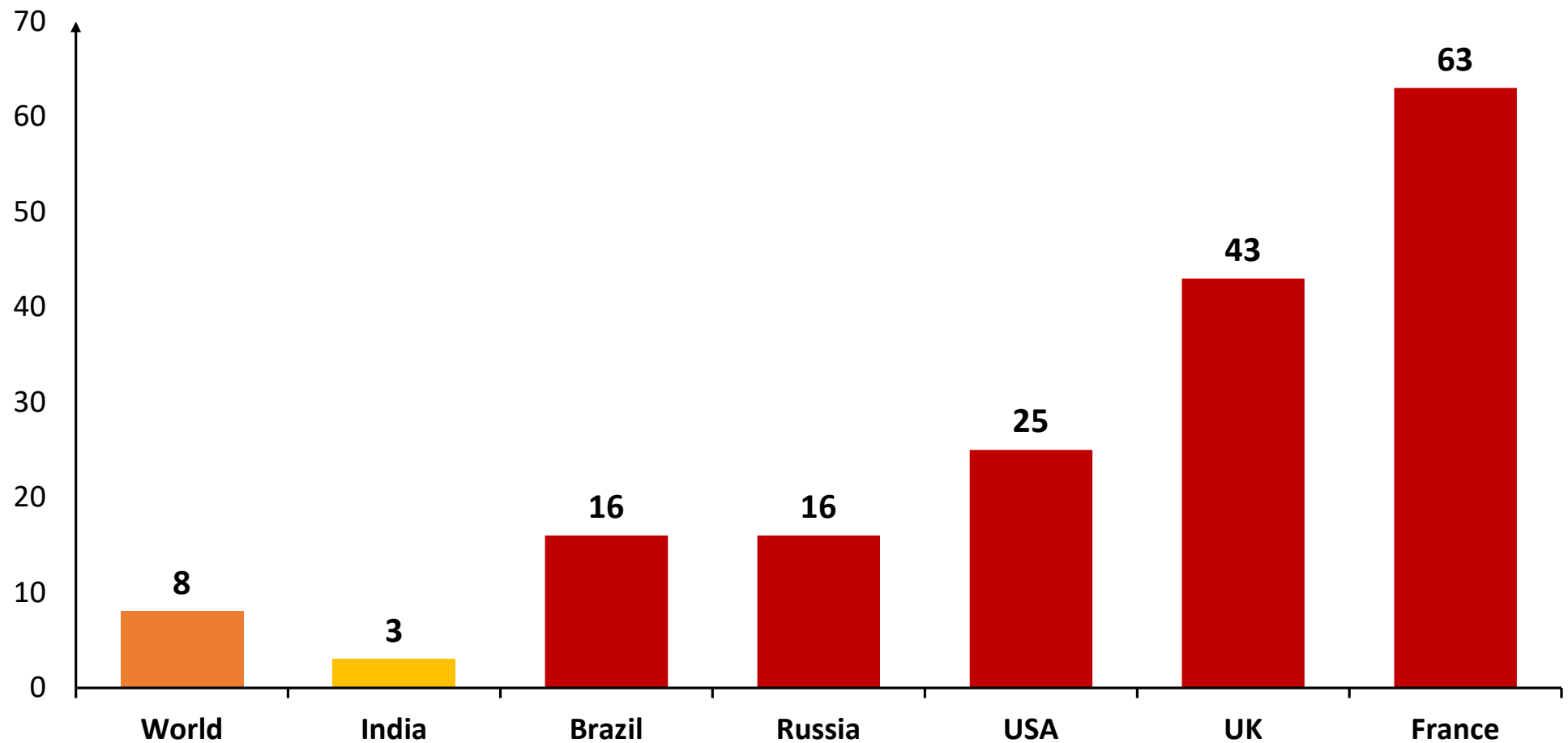

Deaths per Million Population - Amongst the Lowest in the World



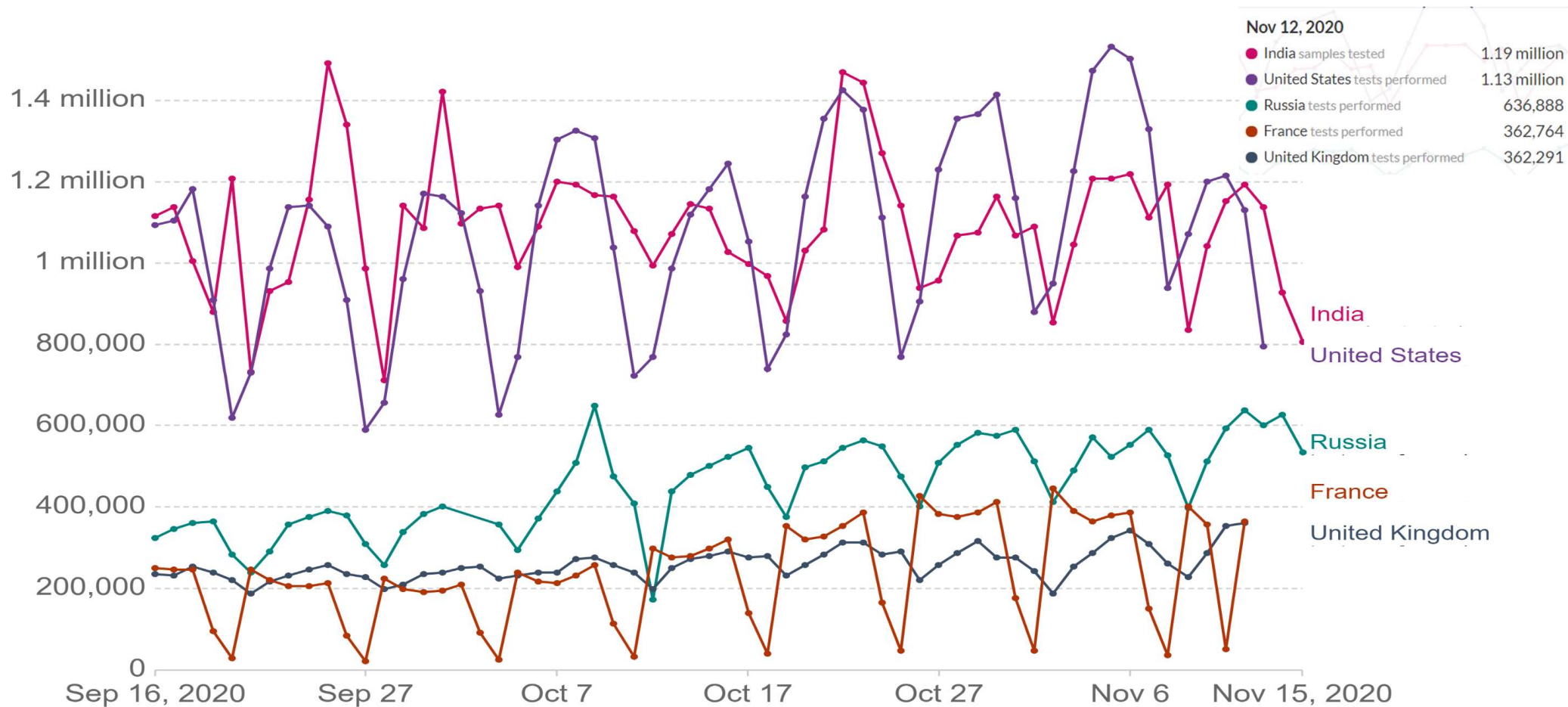

New deaths per million population reported in the last 7 days



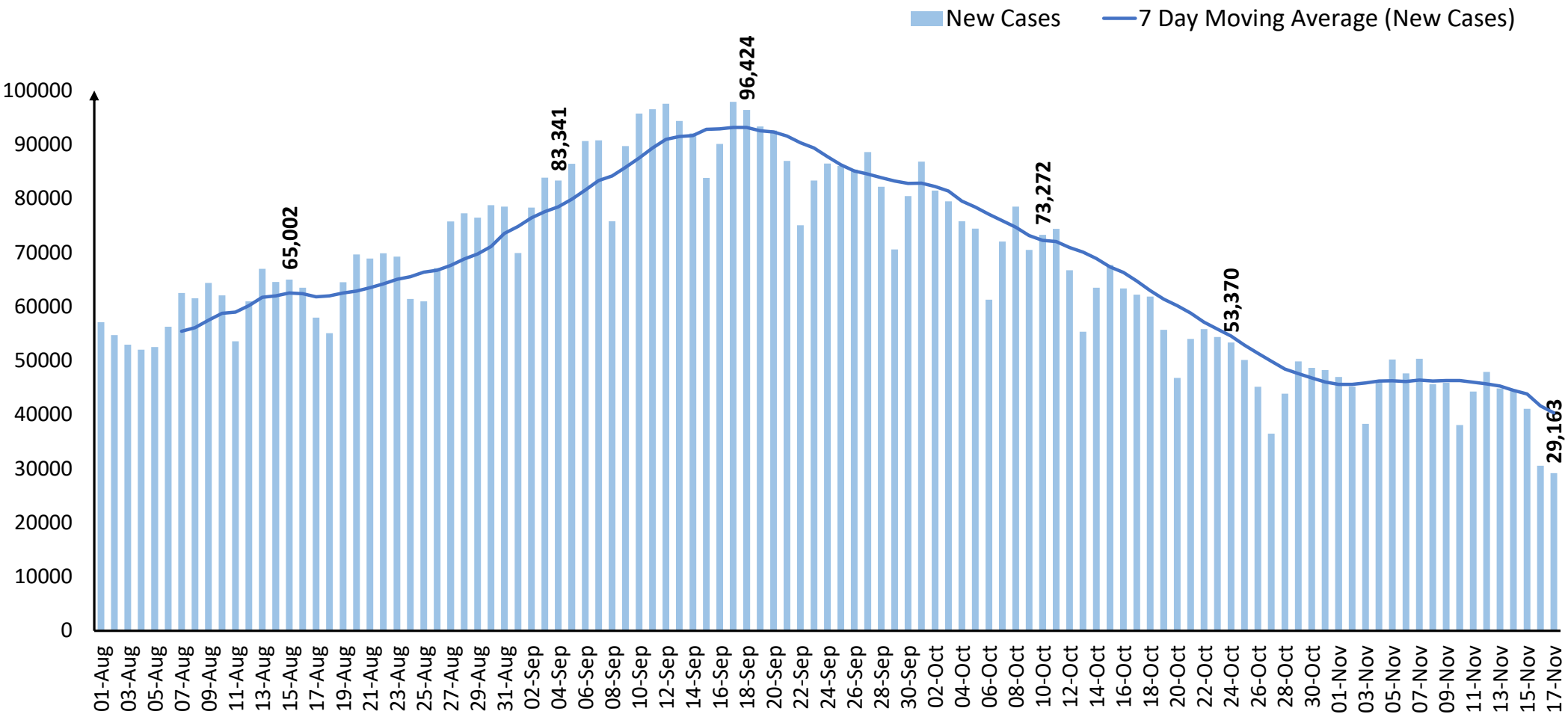

Daily tests conducted by the countries

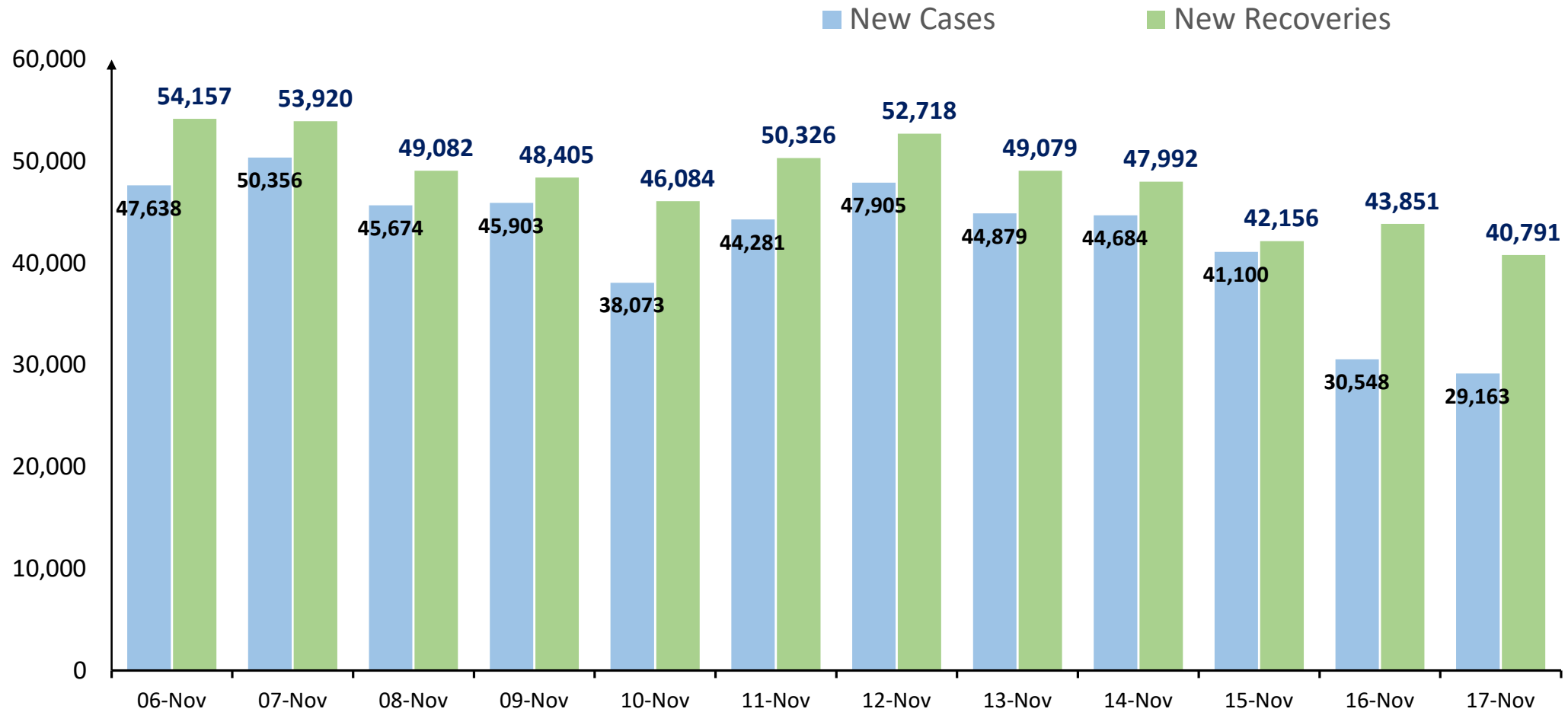

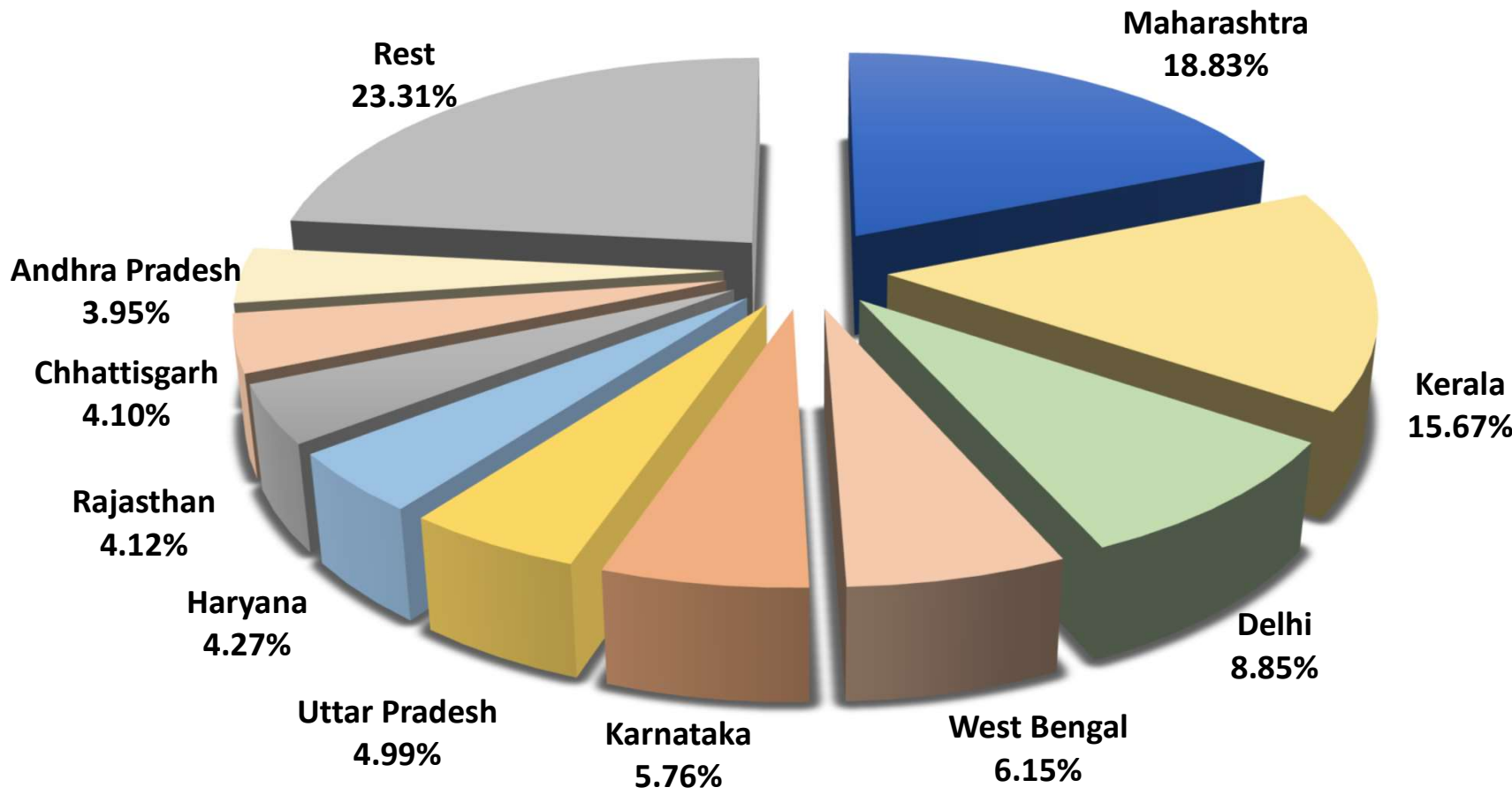
Daily new cases continues to decline



New recoveries have exceeded new cases continuously in the last 45 days



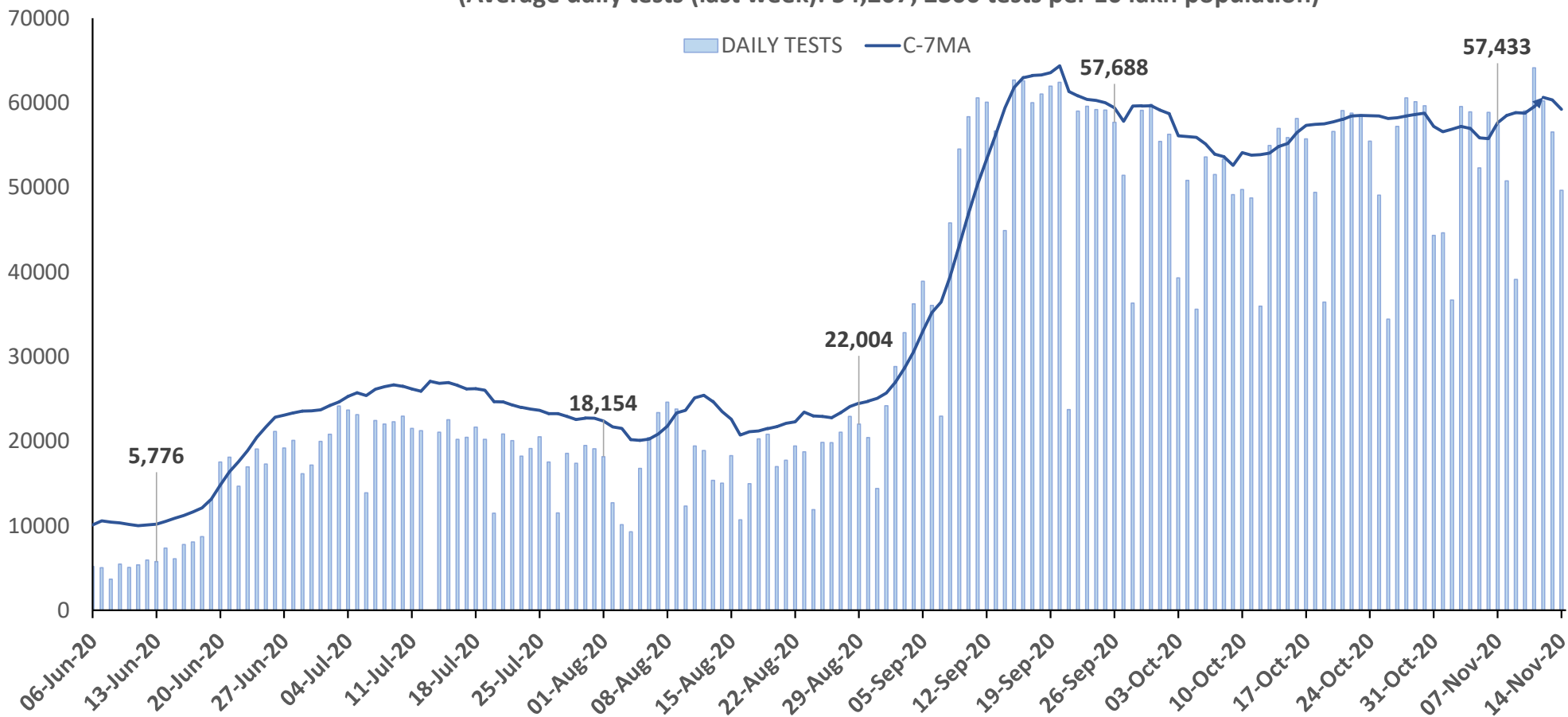
10 States account for 76.7% of total active cases in the country



Delhi – Status Update

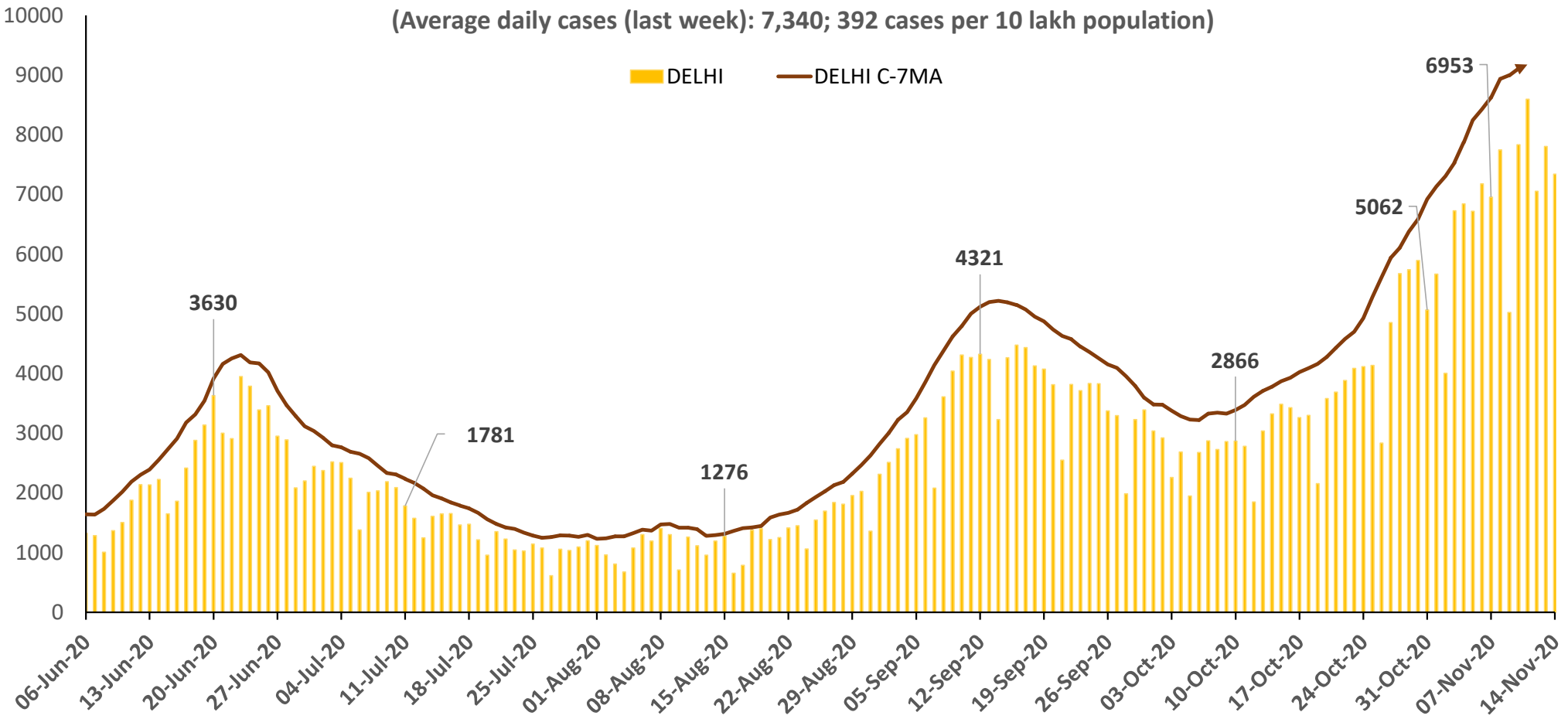
Daily tests conducted in Delhi

(Average daily tests (last week): 54,207; 2300 tests per 10 lakh population)



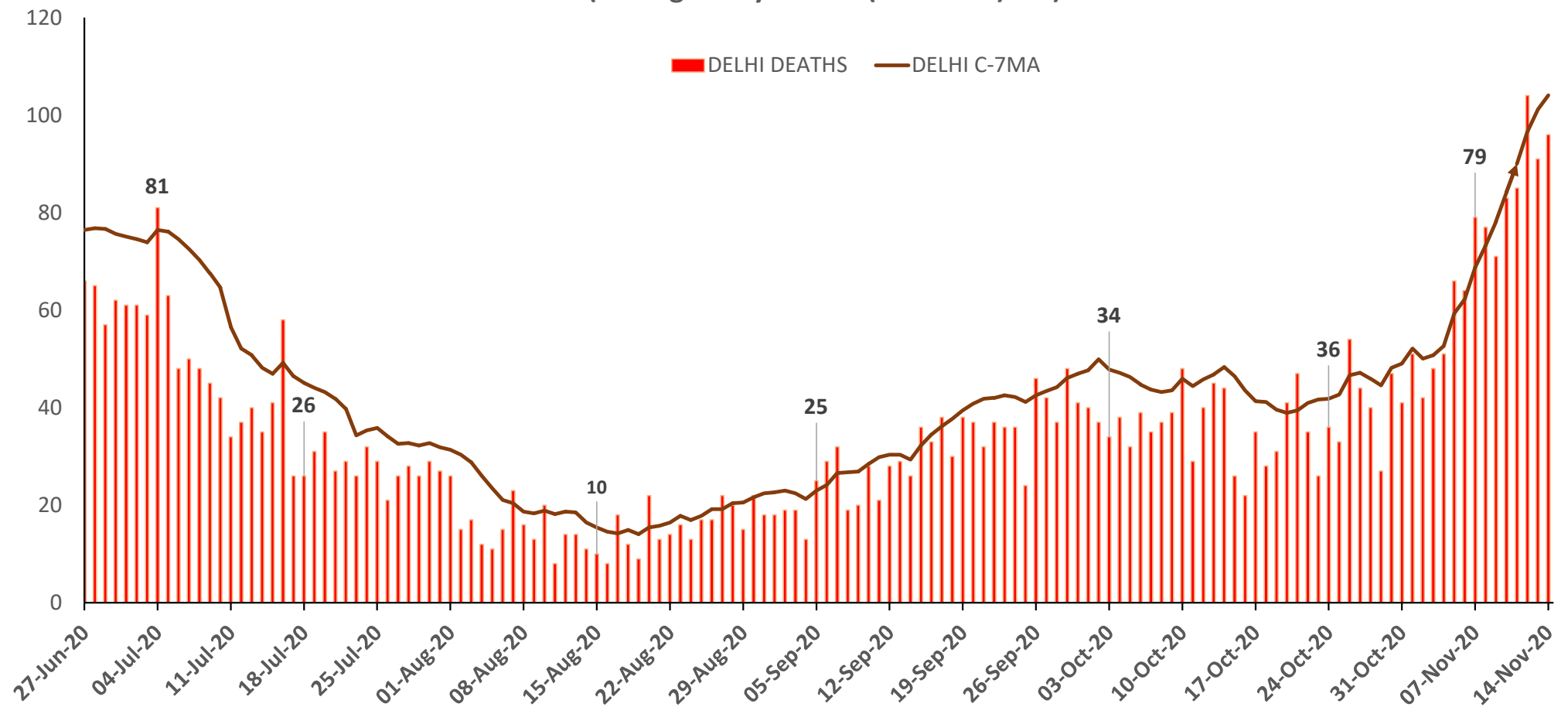
Daily new confirmed cases in Delhi

Urgent Actions

- **Increase in overall beds, including ICU beds**
- **Double testing to 1.0-1.2 lakh per day; right mix of RTPCR and Antigen tests**
- **Strengthen and augment home care support**
- **Mobilize doctors / nurses**
- **Enforce quarantine of contacts**
- **Enforce containment zone SOPs**
- **Covid appropriate behaviour**
