




Major highlights this week

 - Daily positivity rate 3.7%


Cases per Million Population - Amongst the Lowest in the World




Deaths per Million Population - Amongst the Lowest in the World




Number of recovered patients cross 76 lakhs




Continuous decline in average daily new deaths for last 7 weeks




Continuous decline in average daily new cases for last 7 weeks

- iGOT is an online cloud-based capacity building platform of DoPT to deliver role specific content.
- iGOT delivers appropriate training material simultaneously to unlimited number of learners, agnostic of location, at the time and place of their choice.
- iGOT has been extensively utilised in training COVID warriors and in reaching out to the last mile.






Integrated Government Online Training (iGOT) Platform

- Training materials/guidelines on MoHFW website have been converted into online modules and uploaded on iGOT platform.
- As of today (28.10.2020), more than **29.29 lakh unit of courses** have been enrolled into by **13.60 lakh unique users** from **729 districts**, of which **19.13 lakh unit courses** have been completed.
- Top **50 districts with highest course completions** are from Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Maharashtra, Kerala, West Bengal and Chandigarh
- Total 56 modules, 196 training videos and 133 training documents have been uploaded on iGOT portal.
 - These include videos for Basics of COVID, Clinical Management including Intensive Care, Isolation Facility, Frontline Workers, Infection Prevention & Control, Psycho – Social care, etc.
