





Deaths per million population – Amongst the lowest in the world




Rise in daily new cases continues




Daily deaths: Increasing trend reported









Central Teams deployed in Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh and Punjab

- Central Government has constituted **50 high level multi-disciplinary public health teams** and deployed them to **districts** reporting surge in cases and mortality in Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh and Punjab.
- 30 districts of Maharashtra, 11 districts of Chhattisgarh and 9 districts of Punjab.
- Assist the State Health Department and local authorities in COVID-19 surveillance, control and containment measures.
- Teams will submit daily reports on five aspects including
 - o **Testing**;
 - o **Contact Tracing** including Surveillance & Containment;
 - o **Hospital infrastructure** including ICU, ventilator & oxygen beds;
 - o Enforcement of **COVID Appropriate Behavior**;
 - o COVID Vaccination





Global Comparison: Daily rate of doses administered




