- Purpose of the science festival is to engage common people of the country to celebrate the achievements and advancements of India's Science & Technology and project it globally.
- It was decided that one of the departments of Ministry of Science and Technology and Earth Sciences will organize this festival annually, along with the cooperation of other departments of ministries and the VIBHA.
- Since its inception, the IISF has emerged as a unique platform for integration of science and people from the various strata of society.
