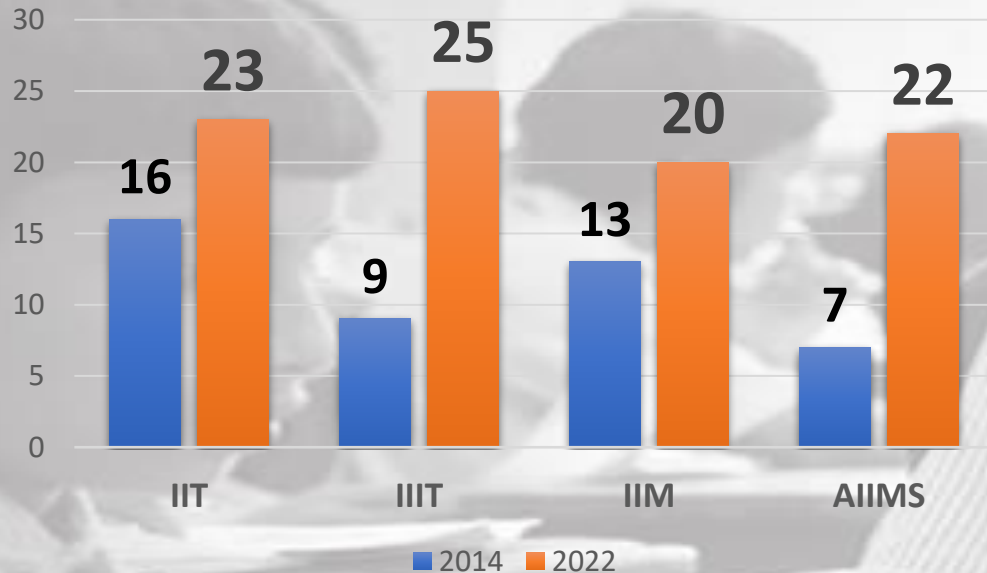

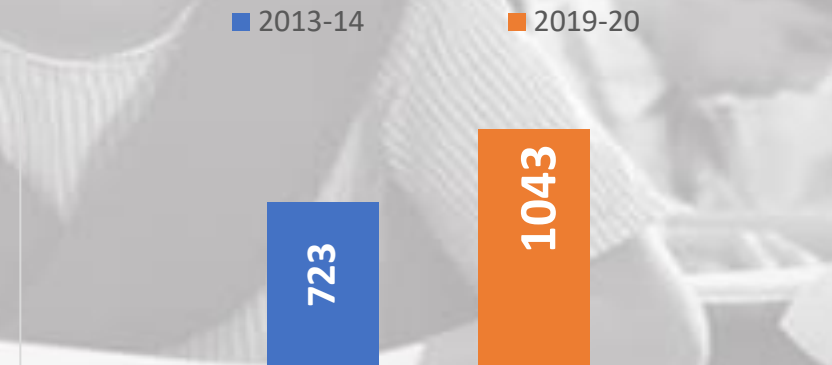


Total Expenditure Doubled since 2013-14

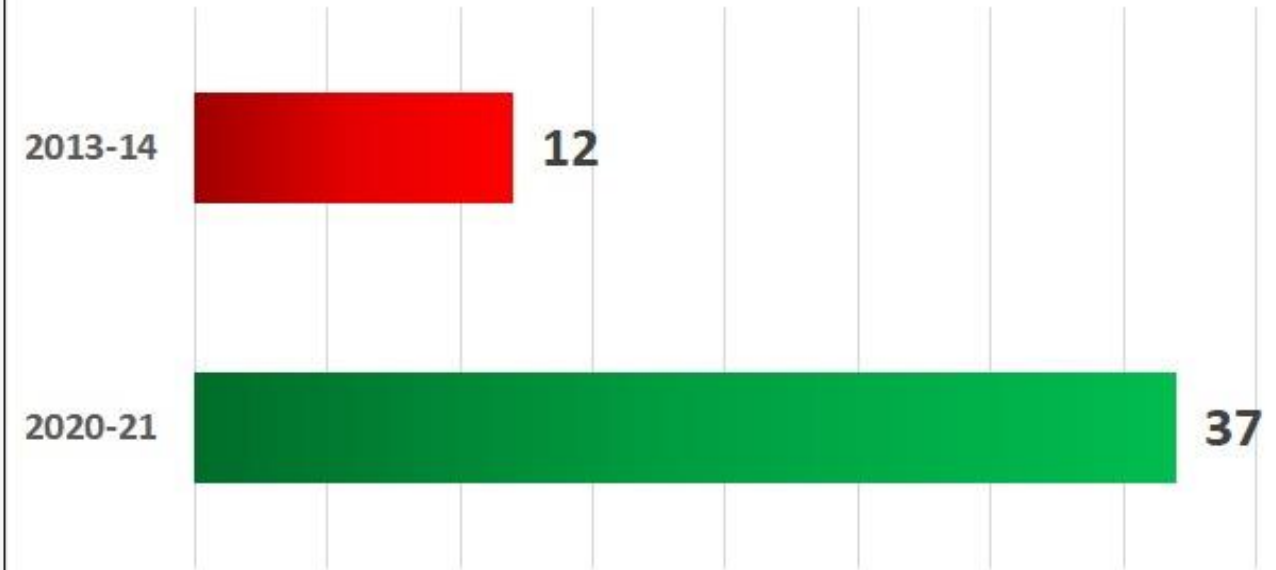

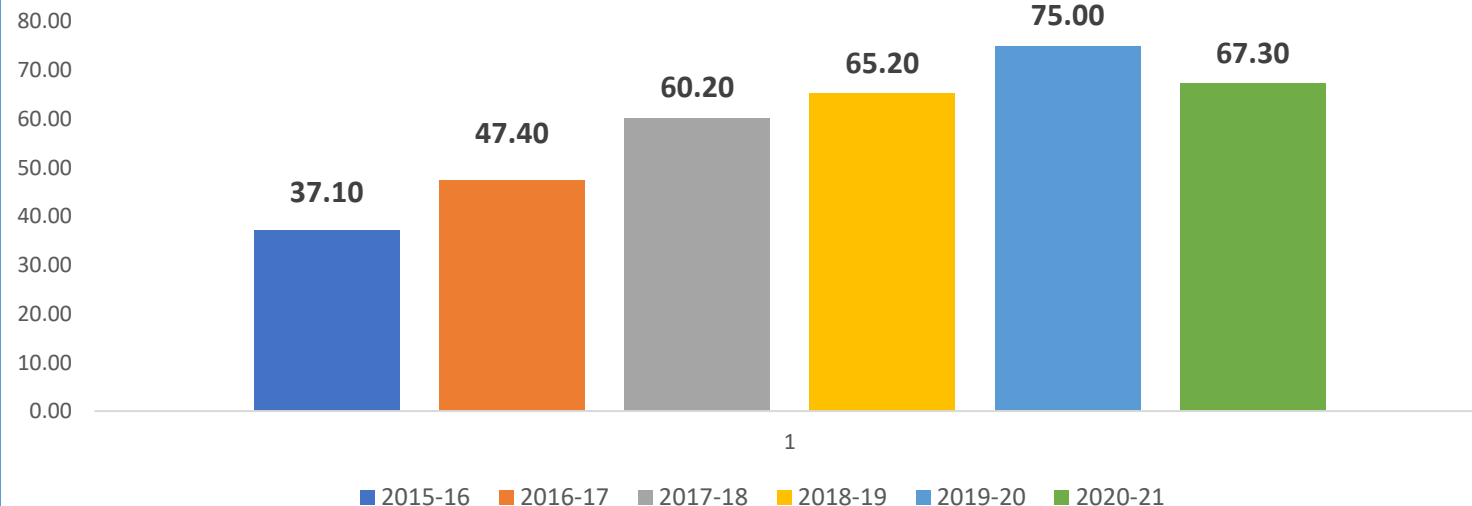
